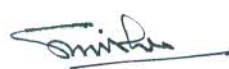

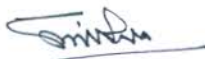

General Work /Duties / Instructions for Functioning of various Zones / Cells mentioned in the above Table:

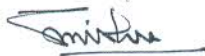
The following General Works / Duties shall be looked after/performed by the officers deputed in various Zones (**Zone I to IX**) mentioned in the Table and Instructions as given below shall be followed for proper functioning of the Zones:

1. The concerned officials in the Zones will deal with the applications of Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate/ Renewal of Consent to Operate under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, as amended to date and also deal with the applications of Authorization under the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Trans Boundary Movement) Rules, 2008, and applications of Registration under the Plastic Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011, as amended to date and implement these Acts and Rules in their respective Zones.
2. The concerned officials in the Zones will also implement the Bio Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998, as amended to date, and process the applications for Authorization under the said Rules and applications for Consent to Establish/Consent to Operate/Renewal of Consent to Operate under the said Air & Water Acts received from the Health Care Establishments.



3. The Office Order F.No.DPCC/(3)(7)(2)/Admin-06 / 9095- 9103 Dated **06.03.2012** stands superseded and Office Order F.No.DPCC/(3)(7)(2)/Admn-06/ 9086-9094 Dated **06.03.2012** stands partially modified as follows:

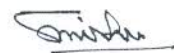
- (i) **There shall be following categories of industries which shall be dealt at 4 different levels as enumerated below:**
- a) Green Category of Industries.
 - b) Orange Category of Industries where there is no requirement of Emission Control System (ECS) / Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP)/ Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and where there is requirement of Emission Control System (ECS) or Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP).
 - c) Orange Category of Industries of potentially highly polluting industries, which require installation of the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) or Emission Control System (ECS) along with Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP).
 - d) Orange category of Industries where Environmental Clearance is required or the case is of STPs of DJB, CETPs, Thermal Power Plants, Municipal Solid Waste /Waste to Energy Plants or units having STP capacity 100 KLD or above.
- (ii) **Consent to Establish, Consent to Operate and Renewal of Consent to Operate under Green category will be decided by the concerned EE (CDC) of the Zone. Mandatory inspections within one year of grant of Consent to Operate/Renewal of Consent to Operate and once in every 3 years thereafter will be conducted w.r.t. these units.**
- (iii) **Consent to Establish, Consent to Operate and Renewal of Consent to Operate/Authorizations under HWM Rules under Orange category of industries as per category 3(i)(b) as above will be decided by the Screening Committee consisting of SEEs and EEs of the Zones. Mandatory inspections within 6 months of grant of Consent to Operate / Renewal of Consent to Operate and once in every two years thereafter will be conducted w.r.t. these units and these cases will be categorized as 2(b) category by the aforesaid Screening Committee for the purpose of software need.**
- (iv) **The applications of Consent to Establish/Consent to Operate, Renewal of Consent to Operate under Water Act 1974/Air Act 1981 and authorizations under Hazardous Waste Rules 2008 for the cases of potentially highly polluting industries as per category 3(i)(c) as above will be decided by the committee consisting of SEEs and EEs of the Zones and headed by Member Secretary, DPCC and such cases will be categorized as 2(c) category for the purpose of software need. All the cases decided by the above committee shall be inspected mandatorily within 3 months of grant of Consent / Authorization and once in every year thereafter.**
- (v) **Cases of Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under Hazardous Waste Rules /MSW Rules etc. pertaining to 3(i)(d) above shall be decided by the Committee headed by Chairman, DPCC as mentioned in the Office Order F.No.DPCC/(3)(7)(2)/Admn 06/9086 - 9094 Dated 06.03.2012 and these cases shall be categorized as 2(d) by the Screening Committee consisting of SEEs and EEs of the Zones.**
4. **Applications for Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Waste Rules etc. received from the units operating from the areas notified for redevelopment under MPD - 2021 shall be dealt as per the Office Order F.No.DPCC/(3)(7)(2)/Admin-06/38366 to 38381 Dated 19.06.2013.**
5. **For Health Care Establishments having bed strength up to 9 beds, the Authorization under the BMW Rules will be decided at the level of EEs (CDC).**
6. **For Health Care Establishments having bed strength of 10 to 49 beds, the Consent and Authorization under the BMW Rules will be decided at the level of SEE/ SEEs (CDC).**



7. For Health Care Establishments having bed strength of 50 to 199 beds, the Consent and Authorization under the BMW Rules will be decided by the following committee:
- Member Secretary, DPCC.
 - Dr. T.K. Joshi, Head, Centre for Occupational and Environmental Health (COEH).
 - Medical Superintendent, Aruna Asaf Ali Hospital.
 - Concerned Sr. Env. Engineers.
 - Concerned Env. Engineers.
8. For Health Care Establishments having bed strength of 200 and above and Transporters and Operators of Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facilities(CBWTFs),the Consent and Authorization under the BMW Rules will be decided by the following committee:
- Chairman, DPCC.
 - Member Secretary, DPCC.
 - Dr. T.K. Joshi, Head, Centre for Occupational and Environmental Health (COEH).
 - Medical Superintendent, G B Pant Hospital.
 - Concerned Sr. Env. Engineers.
 - Concerned Env. Engineers.
 - Dr.Chetna Harzai, Scientist, Deptt.of Environment, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
9. Inspections shall be conducted with the approval of the Chairman / Member Secretary, DPCC or as per the decision taken by the above mentioned Committees or as mentioned in this office order at S.No.3 above.
10. Public Complaints shall be attended as per the Office Order dated 27.01.2012.
11. All Zones will implement the other Pollution Control Laws/ Notification etc. issued by MOEF, Delhi Govt. etc from time to time , as applicable.
12. Legal cell shall be responsible for attending and following up all court cases including timely filling of Affidavits in consultation with the concerned cell/zones.
13. IT Cell shall look after the IT needs of DPCC and shall help ensure trouble free maintenance of the DPCC website under the supervision of MS, DPCC and shall also initiate necessary timely action for required changes / updation in the software etc in view of the aforementioned zone wise distribution of work among officials and online records of DPCC.

Chairman /Member Secretary, DPCC may assign any other work to any official depending on the exigencies of the situation.

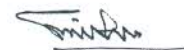
