- (1) Both Asst. Law Officer shall report to Member Secretary. In addition to above work distribution, officials shall discharge the duties with respect to any work assigned as per requirement from time to time, by senior officers.
- (2) All Cells in DPCC will provide the inputs like parawise comments on the petition/ Original Application/ suits etc. to the Legal Cell on the matters so that advocates can be briefed properly and expeditiously.
- (3) Filling of affidavits effectively and timely will be responsibility of legal cell.
- (4) The efforts and the intention of Legal Cell should be to control pollution in Delhi rather than to victimize or harass any unit with threats of prosecution.
- (5) Legal Cell will compile and track the proceedings of all court cases on daily basis.

- (6) As per the provisions of Civil Procedure Code, Written statement is to be filed within a period of 30 days; therefore all cells would be required provide the inputs within 2 weeks to legal cell.
- (7) With respect to filling of the affidavits/ Written Statements/Replies in civil cases of various Courts and Appellate Authorities the following procedure may be adhered to and concerned officers are hereby authorized accordingly:
- For the cases of Appellate Authorities, concerned JEE/ AEE shall swear the status reports.
 - For the cases of Lower Court, concerned JEE/ AEE, in-charge of the subdivision of that particular cell shall swear the written statements.
 - For the cases of High Court concerned branch Incharge (AD/SEE/EE), shall swear the affidavits.
 - For the cases of Supreme Court of India Member Secretary/ Chairperson or any other officer authorized by them in any specific case, shall swear the affidavits.

In case of non-availability of the above designated officers the Link Officer/Next Higher Officer shall swear the status reports/ written Statements/ affidavits.

(8) This order comes into effect immediately.
