OFFICE ORDER

In accordance with the MoEF & CC Notifications dated 14.01.2025, 08.10.2025, and 25.11.2025, projects requiring prior Environmental Clearance (EC) have been exempted from obtaining a separate Consent to Establish (CTE). The following procedure and fee structure shall be implemented for streamlining the EC and the CTE processes through the PARIVESH Portal:

1. Fee Structure effective from 01.02.2026:

The following fee structure, equivalent to CTE fees, is adopted for projects applying for EC on the PARIVESH Portal after 01.02.2026. The CTE fee shall be based on the gestation/completion period mentioned by the Project Proponent and in its absence for a period of 3 years for projects other than Housing, Commercial, Office Complexes, IT, Infrastructure, and Town Development and for 3 years or 5 years for Housing, Commercial, Office Complexes including IT & Infrastructure and Town Development projects based on the total built-up area as detailed under:

Total Buildup Area (Sq.m)	Requisite Fee Duration
<1,00,000	Fees equivalent to 3 Years of CTE charges
>1,00,000	Fees equivalent to 5 Years of CTE charges

Adjustment for Extended Duration: At the time of applying for Consent to Operate (CTO), if the duration between the date of CTE fee payment and the date of CTO application exceeds the duration specified above, the balance CTE fees for the extended period shall be applicable and the same shall be paid by the Project Proponent/Unit.

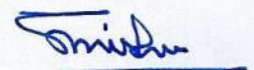
2. Operational Instructions

- **Designated Date:** This new workflow is mandatory for all applicable proposals accepted on the PARIVESH portal w.e.f. 01.02.2026.
- **Fee Demand:** Upon receipt of an Environmental Clearance (EC) or (Terms of Reference) ToR proposal, the EIA Cell shall raise a demand note on the PARIVESH Portal within 7 days.

- **Payment Verification:** The EIA Cell to verify payment receipts in consultation with the DPCC Accounts section. After obtaining confirmation from Accounts Section, the officer shall update information about receipt of fees at PARIVESH portal to enable the comment submission module. If discrepancies are found, they must be flagged immediately on the PARIVESH Portal.
- **Uploading comments/suggestions of DPCC & Inspection:** The EIA Cell to upload comments/environmental safeguards on the portal within 30 days (where ToR is applicable) or 15 days (where ToR is not applicable) from the date of fee receipt upload. Inspection may be carried out by the Cell officials, if required, to provide comments/suggestions.

Final decision regarding the incorporation of DPCC inputs/suggestions in the EC will be taken by UTLEAC and UTLEIAA.
