Office Order

With a view to bring the industrial units operating from the areas notified for redevelopment under MPD-2021, into the ambit of pollution control laws, the following is hereby ordered:

I Following two categories of highly polluting industries, if found operating in Delhi, shall be closed down forthwith by issuing directions to the concerned Deputy Commissioners for their effective closure and, it shall be an on-going process ie whenever any such unit is found operating the direction for its effective closure shall be issued .

- (i) H-Category units as per Master Plan of Delhi 2001.
- (ii) Prohibited/Negative list of industries as per Master Plan 2021.

II The DPCC will accept and process the consent/authorization applications from the permissible orange and green category units located in the areas notified for redevelopment under MPD-2021 which are existing prior to the notification of MPD-2021 i.e. 7th Feb'2007.

III As a proof of their respective date of establishment prior to the notification of MPD-2021 i.e. 7th Feb' 2007 the units shall submit any one of the following documents:

(a) Any order/direction by DPCC	(g) Permanent SSI registration
(b) Municipal Corporation Licence	(h) Excise registration for manufacturing
(c) Registration under factories Act	(i) Drug licence if unit is manufacturing item covered under Drug Act
(d) BIS Licence	(j) Manufactures certificates in case of house hold electrical appliances
(e) Sales Tax Registration of the unit.	(k) Land Line telephone bill in the name of unit.
(f) Income tax return of the industry	(l) Power bill in the name of unit.

IV Consent to establish is not required for the units already existing and operating in these redevelopment areas prior to the date of notification of MPD-2021 i.e. 7th Feb 2007.

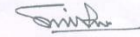
V The condonation fee from the units in these redevelopment areas shall be charged with effect from 7th Feb-2007 i.e. the date of notification of MPD-2021.

VI The consent will be given on year to year basis in these areas without any prejudice to the action to shift these unit to the other industrial areas in case of failure of completion of redevelopment process as envisaged in MPD-2021.

VII In view of provisions of MPD-2021 and Govt. of India Gazette Notification dated 01.05.2012 notifying the regulations and guidelines for redevelopment of the clusters issued by DDA, envisaging that only permissible industry having clearance from DPCC shall be permitted, the following three types of industries shall be encouraged to establish and operate in the redevelopment areas:

- (i) Green Category Industries to promote non-polluting industries in Delhi.
- (ii) Hi- tech Industry as specified in MPD-2021 at clause 7.7 (b) to promote non-polluting industries in Delhi
- (iii) Utilities engaged in waste collection, storage, processing and treatment to tackle city's ever increasing waste.

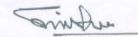
This issues subsequent to the consideration of the matter by the Department of Environment and Forest, Govt. of Delhi and the Department of Industries Govt. of Delhi.
