ORDER

Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India while hearing Writ Petition(s) No(s). 13029/1985 in the matter of M.C.Mehta Vs. Union of India & Ors. has passed orders dated 04.11.2019 and 06.11.2019 directing the undersigned to ensure implementation of a number of measures to control various factors which are contributing to the pollution in Delhi such as construction and demolition, open dumping of waste, garbage, unpaved roads/pits, road dust, garbage burning and traffic congestion. In addition, the Hon'ble Court has further directed the undersigned to take care of the hotspots and implement immediate measures for addressing the problem of higher level of air pollution in the identified hotspots.

2. Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has further requested the Monitoring Committee also to look into these aspects and has authorized the Committee to monitor the activities as to whether orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court are appropriately carried out.

3. In pursuance to the above orders, the Monitoring Committee held a meeting on 07.11.2019 in which the HODs/Nodal Officers of the various implementing agencies as Municipal Corporations, DDA, DJB, PWD, Delhi Police, DSIIDC, Department of Industries, NHAI and DPCC were present. After detailed deliberations, the following directions are being passed in consultation with the Monitoring Committee for time bound implementation thereof:-

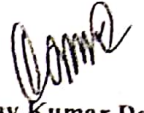

5. Other Compliances:-

- It shall be the responsibility of the above mentioned agencies / officers to ensure that coordinated action is taken to ensure that local sources of pollution as outlined above are completely curbed.
- Systemic efficiency to be so improved so that the complaints noted by the inspecting teams and by the public on Sameer App are obviated.
- Complaints on dumping of C&D waste, garbage burning (if any) received through Sameer App to be liquidated within 2 hours by the concerned agency.
- Detailed reports, along with photography / video record are to be submit to the Monitoring Committee every day with a copy to DPCC.
- Affidavits on the above specific points and in compliance of directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and as per the directions given by the Monitoring Committee in its meeting held on 07.11.219 are to be submitted by each of the agencies to DPCC (Nodal Agency) by 13.11.2019. The action taken date wise should be detailed in the affidavit to be provided by each of the agencies.

- The above directions given in pursuance of the orders dated 04.11.2019 and 06.11.2019 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India are to be complied in its letter and spirit. In case of any non-compliance, the concerned HODs/nodal officer(s) will be held personally responsible and appropriate action will be taken for such negligence.
