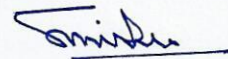

**A Summary Statement on Progress made by Municipal Authorities in respect of Implementation of Schedule III of Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016, in the Financial Year 2024 - 2025.**

**Implementation of Schedule III of C & D Waste Management Rules, 2016, in Delhi:**

Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) & Delhi Cantonment Board (DCB)] in Delhi are responsible for the management of Construction and Demolition Waste in Delhi as per the provisions of Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016, including Schedule III of said Rules in their areas of jurisdiction.

**In Schedule-III, Timeframe for Planning and Implementation** of Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 is mentioned. Delhi is having population of more than 20 Million and Status w.r.t. Compliance Criteria mentioned in Schedule-III is briefed in following table:

Collected C&D Waste is transported to the existing C&D Waste Processing / Recycling Facilities / Plants in Delhi. The capacity of 05 C&D Waste processing / Recycling Facilities / Plants in Delhi in 2024- 2025 was 5150 TPD and brief is given in **Table 1.**

In these C & D Waste Processing Facilities , Paver Blocks, Kerb Stones, CC Bricks, Aggregates, Granular Sub-Base (GSB), Sand and Soil of BIS standards are being produced out of the C&D waste which is further used in the infrastructure projects, thus fresh requirement of natural resources is minimized.



As per the Annual Reports submitted by the above-mentioned Local Bodies and C & D Waste Processing Facilities in Delhi, total 6156.1 TPD of Construction and Demolition Waste (C&D Waste) is generated in Delhi. Separate collection and transport infrastructure for C&D Waste has been set up under which the C&D Waste is collected at 132 designated sites identified by the MCD, NDMC & DCB and briefed in Table-2:

# DCB reused 155 MT (0.43 TPD) C & D Waste in its ongoing maintenance work and about 85 MT (0.23 TPD) C & D Waste was disposed by filling in low lying areas and rest 452 MT (1.2 TPD) was sent to C & D Waste Processing Facility at Shastri Park.

**Note:**

1. **MCD** - Collected C & D Waste is transported to the C & D Waste Processing Facilities at Bakkarwala Village, Shastri Park, Ranikhera and Jahangirpuri (Burari) for Processing / Recycling.
2. **NDMC & DCB** - Collected C & D Waste is transported to the C & D Waste Processing Facility at Shastri Park for Processing / Recycling.
3. **DMRC** (Delhi Metro Rail Corporation) was having its own 150 TPD C & D Waste Processing Facility at Ranikhera (Mundka) for processing of C & D Waste of DMRC / Delhi Metro at this facility through M/s Indo Enviro Integrated Solutions Private Limited.
4. \$ C & D Waste is also used / disposed off at the three Dumpsites (Okhla, Ghazipur & Bhalaswa) and this is not included in the waste disposal from C & D Plants.

Now there are four C & D Waste Processing Facilities of 5000 TPD capacity since April, 2025 and proposed C & D Waste Processing Facility of 1000 TPD capacity at Okhla Dumpsite will enhance the capacity upto 6000 TPD by December, 2026 and almost the entire C&D waste generated in Delhi (6156.1 TPD) will be managed properly in a scientific manner.

Department of Urban Development, Govt. of NCT of Delhi has already issued Order Dated 06.07.2016 (Copy of Letter enclosed as **Annexure- "A"**) regarding use of Recycled Products from C&D Waste including following measures to be taken for compliance by all Municipal / Local Govt. Bodies in Delhi, Public Works Department, Irrigation & Flood Control, DSIIDC, DJB & Departments and Organizations of GNCTD involved in Construction/Maintenance of Civil Works:

(i) A minimum of 2% of C&D Recycled Products shall be used for building works.

(ii) 10% of C&D Products shall be used for Road works.

(iii) Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in Delhi shall mandate 5% use of C&D recycled products for nonstructural application by all, including private individuals. This condition shall be introduced by modifications in byelaws if necessary, & by including the same condition in the building plan approval.

(iv) Compliance of these conditions shall be verified and certified by the concerned Executive Engineer before verifying and certifying the bills for payments in any such contract.

(v) Intimation of the action taken/compliance report.

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Govt. of India (MoHUA) fixes the target for every financial year for use of Construction and Demolition recycled materials by various Departments. MoHUA had fixed the target of 16.015 Lakh MT for use of Construction and Demolition recycled materials by various Departments in the Year 2024-2025. Copy of Office Memorandum dated 21.08.2024 of MoHUA is at **Annexure- "E"**

Annual Off Take Target of C&D Waste Recycled Products for year 2025-2026 is at **Annexure- "F"**

Earlier Directions u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 were issued by DPCC on 14.01.2020 and 09.02.2021 to various Govt. Departments / Agencies for expediting & maximizing the utilization of C&D Waste Recycled Materials Products of the C & D Waste Processing Facilities operating in Delhi in their projects to meet the targets fixed by MoHUA. DO Letters were also issued by Secy (Env.) Cum Chairman, DPCC to NHAI, NBCC, CPWD, DDA etc. for increasing the lifting/ off-take of C&D Recycled Materials to meet the targets set by MoHUA. A letter dated 23.08.2024 was issued by DPCC seeking Action Taken Report from the concerned Departments/ Agencies w.r.t said Directions issued on 14.01.2020 & 09.02.2021.

Inspections of C & D Waste Processing Facilities were carried out by DPCC from time to time and deficiencies observed during the inspections were communicated to the C & D Waste Processing Facilities for taking rectification measures.

In the Financial Year 2024-2025 in respect of then existing 05 C & D Waste Processing Facilities [at Bakkarwala, Shastri Park, Ranikhera, Burari & Mundka (DMRC Plant)], Total C&D Waste Intake was about 12.40171 Lakh MT [ 3397.73 TPD i.e 66 % of Total Installed Capacity of then existing all Five Plants i.e 5150 TPD]. Total C&D Waste Processed was about 12.08416 Lakh MT [ 3310.73 TPD i.e 97.44 % of C&D Waste Received] and Total Off-take of C & D Recycled Products by Govt. Departments & Private Parties was about 7.28361 Lakh MT [1995.51 TPD i.e 60.27 % of Total C & D Recycled Products from all Five Plants in Delhi].

Status of Offtake of C & D Recycled Products by the Govt. Departments & Private Parties during the Financial Year 2024 – 2025 is at **Annexure- "G"**.

In Writ Petition (C) No. 13029 of 1985 titled "M.C. Mehta vs. Union of India & Ors. Hon'ble Supreme Court is monitoring various issues related to air pollution including C & D Waste Management in NCT of Delhi and given various directions including following vide order dated 24.04.2025 :

*"....7. There is another important issue flagged by the learned Amicus Curiae. She has rightly submitted that the activity of recycling the product from the construction and dust waste must be incentivized. Her submission is that the rate of GST should be reduced to minimum or ideally zero. We direct the Union of India to consider this aspect by placing it before the appropriate authority. We recommend that this activity needs to be incentivized which will help the cause of environment protection.....".*



Besides above information, other information provided by the Local Bodies (MCD, NDMC & DCB) in Form III regarding Construction and Demolition Waste Management in their areas in Delhi is briefed below:

### **1. Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD)**

C & D Waste generation is 2190000 MT in 2024-2025 (6000 TPD) out of which 5000 TPD is collected per day. Around 240 TPD of C & D Waste was disposed off at Okhla Dumpsite from November 2023 to May 2024. This C & D Waste does not include the waste disposal from above mentioned C & D Waste

Processing Facilities, MCD has 106 No. of C & D Waste Local Dumping Sites for the general public. Malba from these points are lifted on regular basis by the C & D Contractors / Concessionaires. Bulk Generators / Contractors are required to dump Malba or Debris at C & D Waste Processing Plants and Dumpsite directly. Lifting of C & D Waste from the Local Dumping Sites is done by mechanical means. Transportation of C & D Waste is being done through contract and 10 Trucks, and 2 JCBs are deployed for each C&D Waste Processing Facilities.

For improving C & D Waste management, all Zones are taking action to improve collection, transportation and storage of C&D waste at designated points along with sensitization programs at a mass level of general public for safe disposal of malba. Bakkarwala Plant Operator installed trommel for mixed C&D waste screening and filter press for sludge control. In the C & D Waste Processing Facilities both Dry & Wet integrated technology is being used and these plants are in operation on PPP basis. Regular removal of encroachments is undertaken by MCD during cleanliness drives. It has been observed that public is mixing C&D waste with solid waste which leads to garbage vulnerable points (GVPs).

About 12 nos. of Municipal Magistrates have been appointed to try offences in relation to littering & causing nuisance, sanitation and public health. Building department, MCD has issued 2701 nos. of challans amounting to Rs. 5,40,96,000/- and out of this Rs. 43,65,000 has been realized during the period April 2024 to March 2025 for non-compliance to construction guidelines.

MCD is monitoring the designated collection sites & C & D Waste disposal through its 311 App. MCD has made compulsory use of recycled C&D Products in all its construction / civil works

### **2. New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC)**

C & D Waste generation was 11134 MT (30.5 TPD) in 2024-2025. All the C & D Waste generated in NDMC area is collected & lifted on daily basis through 25 Containers / Receptacle of total 10 m<sup>3</sup> capacity and sent to C & D Waste Processing Facility at Shastri Park for its Processing / Recycling. Lifting of C & D Waste is done using mechanical means (JCB, Hook Loader and Auto Tipper). Transportation of C & D Waste is being done through 02 Trucks (open body), 05 Hydraulic Trucks & One JCB. Municipal Magistrate appointed for taking penal action for noncompliance with C & D Waste Management Rules, 2016

### **3. Delhi Cantonment Board (DCB)**

C & D Waste generation was 692 MT ( 1.9 TPD) in 2024-2025. All the C & D Waste generated in DCB area is removed using JCB & Dumpers and collected at the centralized collection centre at Village Jharera from where the waste is transported to the C & D Waste Processing Facility at Shastri Park for its Processing / Recycling. DCB has concluded a contract for lifting of C & D Waste from different locations in Delhi Cantt. About 85 MT of C & D Waste disposed by filling in low lying area. DCB reused 155 MT (0.43 TPD) C & D Waste in its ongoing maintenance work and about 85 MT (0.23 TPD) C & D Waste was disposed by filling in low lying areas and rest 452 MT (1.2 TPD) was sent to C & D Waste Processing Facility at Shastri Park. CCTV have been installed by DCB at vulnerable locations and also directions have been issued to field staff to keep strict vigil over these locations. Field staff keeps regular check and the violators are fined. 03 persons have been fined for unauthorized dumping of C&D Waste in 2024- 2025.

**A Summary Statement on progress made by Municipal Authorities in respect of Implementation of Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 (Details of operational C&D Waste Processing Facilities, C&D Waste Received & Processed and C&D Waste Recycled Products) in the Financial Year 2024-2025.**

As per the Annual Reports submitted by Local Bodies and C&D Waste Processing Facilities, 6156.1 TPD C&D Waste is generated in Delhi. There were 05 Operational C&D Waste Processing Facilities in Delhi in 2024 – 2025 with total installed capacity of 5150 TPD as given in **Table-1**. Besides above facilities, one more facility of 1000TPD is proposed by MCD on 8 Acres Reclaimed land at Okhla Dumpsite. This will cater 2 zones (Central & South) of MCD. Likely date of commissioning is December, 2026.

Local bodies in Delhi (MCD, NDMC and DCB) have identified / selected the site for collection of C&D waste as mentioned in **Table-1** below. It is pertinent to mention that in Delhi due to scarcity of Land and dense population, it is difficult to find / select suitable Land / Site for C&D waste processing facility considering the Schedule-I of the C&D Waste Management Rules, 2016. However, MCD (erstwhile SDMC, EDMC and North DMC) had identified sites for C&D Waste Processing Facilities depending on the availability of Land and site available with DDA.

There were five Construction and Demolition Waste (C & D) Processing Facilities in Delhi in 2024 - 2025 and details are given in following Table:

ORDER

Sub : Use of Recycled Products from Construction & Demolition Waste.

Whereas, Govt. of India accords high priority to Swatchh Bharat and sanitation measures as a tool to synergize dynamic growth & sustainability.

Whereas, in this direction, Govt. has [comprehensively inter-alia revised waste management rules and] notified a new rule, namely Construction and Demolition (C & D) Waste Management Rule, 2016.

Whereas, the major objective of these rules is environmentally sound management of waste, & simultaneously promoting a circular economy through resource recovery and reuse, which in turn is aimed at combating and mitigating climate change phenomenon.

Whereas, Rule 9(1) of the Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 requires the Secretary in-charge of development in State Government to prepare policy w.r.t. management of construction & demolition waste in accordance with the provisions of these rules within one year.

Whereas, the Rule 9(4) of the said rules makes procurement of materials made from Construction and Demolition waste mandatory to a certain percentage (say 10-20%) in municipal and Government contracts subject to strict quality control.

Whereas, one Construction & Demolition Waste Processing plant is already operational in Delhi at Shastri Park (under administrative control of East Delhi Municipal Corporation) & more such proposed plants [at Tikri Kalan, Libaspur (PWD Projects) and at Mundka (DMRC Project)] are under process of being set up in Delhi.

Whereas, the Rule 6, also enlists as duty of Local authority, inter alia at Sl.No.9 to device appropriate measures for management of Construction & Demolition Waste generated including processing facility and for using the recycled products in the best possible manner.



Whereas, an advisory was issued by GNCTD on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2015, mandating use of recycled C & D Waste products in Delhi. An advisory in continuation of the same was also issued on 14.9.2015 by Dy. Secretary (PWD/UD).

GNCTD hereby orders following measures for compliance of all Municipal/Local Govt. bodies in Delhi, Public Works Department, Irrigation & Flood Control, DSIIDC, DJB & departments and Organisations of GNCTD Involved in Construction/Maintenance of Civil Works :

- (1) A minimum of 2% of C&D recycled products shall be used for building works.
- (2) 10% of C&D products shall be used for Road works.
- (3) Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in Delhi shall mandate 5% use of C&D recycled products for non structural application by all, including private Individuals. This condition shall be introduced by modifications in byelaws, if necessary, & by including the same condition in the building plan approval.
- (4) All above conditions, including those mentioned in the office advisory No.23(232)/E-in-C Projects/PWD/2015-16/17902-23 dated 14.9.2015 (adoption of prescribed construction practices, testing the quality of recycled products, installation of on site C&D waste processing plant in redevelopment projects costing more than Rs.500 crores etc.) shall be included in all relevant Civil work tenders i.e. Notice Inviting Tenders, Work Orders & Contract agreements etc. for strict compliance.
- (5) Compliance of these conditions shall be verified and certified by the concerned Executive Engineer before verifying & certifying the bills for payments in any such contract.
- (6) and intimate the action taken/compliance report.

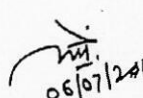

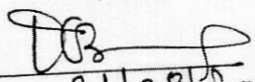

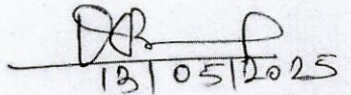

**Minutes of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Director (SBM-III), MoHUA on 02.04.2025 at 04:00 PM, to discuss the fixation of annual off-take target for Construction & Demolition (C&D) Waste Recycled Products for the year 2025-26 in Delhi -NCR**

At the outset, Director SBM -III, MoHUA welcomed all the participants and briefed about the objective of the meeting. He also referred to the Jaipur Declaration, which India adopted at the 12th Regional 3R and Circular Economy Forum in Asia and the Pacific, held in March, 2025, strategies to improve resource efficiency, waste management, and sustainable material consumption by integrating 3R (reduce, reuse, recycle) principles across economic sectors. The chair then asked Ever Enviro/ IEISL to make a presentation.

1. EverEnviro/ IEISL made a power point presentation on the implementation status of the annual off-take of C&D waste recycle products for 2024-2025 wherein it was noted that the total compliance stood at approx. 14%.
2. Emphasizing the importance of annual off-take of C&D waste in Delhi-NCR, it was highlighted that the actual off-take continues to fall significantly short of the targets set by MoHUA. The Chair discussed the reasons for the low off-take in detail with all the stakeholders.
3. Based on the discussions with stakeholders, the Chair finalized the off-take targets for FY 2025-26 on the basis of mutual consensus. The proposed annual targets for various Government Departments/Agencies for the FY 2025-26 are as follows:

Note: The targets have been reduced for the FY 2025-26 to make them more realistic and for the sake of fulfillment of the same.

4. Ever Enviro / IEISL also presented the online portal structure for the Off-take of C&D products viz. [www.cndofftakencr.in](http://www.cndofftakencr.in) and informed that all data would be live from 10.04.2025. MoHUA directed that an online VC meeting will be convened with all the respective Departments for understanding of portal.
5. It was also discussed that MoHUA may take up the matter of movement of vehicles related to C&D (both for bringing waste & taking outgoing recycled products) in city during GRAP-IV stage restrictions along with the permission for the operations of processing plants and Waste to energy plants under necessary pollution control mechanism.
6. Incentivization scheme for private agencies may be issued by the ULBs in Delhi-NCR as mentioned in C&D rules 2016. A draft copy for the same has been shared by Ever Enviro (copy attached) which may be forward to the MCD and other ULBs to provide their input before the issuance of the same.
7. Departments like IGBC, GRIHA & LEEDS may be approached for making necessary changes in existing guidelines regarding C&D waste management and allocate minimum 20 points/ 1 Star rating for usage of C&D recycled products & ensuring processing of C&D waste generated from the project.
8. MoHUA may pursue the issue of GST rates on Recycled C&D Value Added Products sale with GST council.
9. Govt. Departments/ Agencies highlighted various issues related to recycled C&D waste materials/ products including improvement in quality of recycled materials/ products, making available test reports of recycled materials, batch wise test reports of VAPs, better shape of VAPs, supply of RMC from C&D waste recycling plants, pricing issues, advance payments, RMC manufacturing units for the procurement of concrete up to M15 grade etc. MoHUA asked Ever Enviro/ IEISL to look into the issues and address the concern for better market acceptability of the recycled material/ products.
10. Director, MoHUA, has also proposed to keep CBRI in the ambit for providing technical assistance on the use of C&D recycled products and address the issues regarding the use of C&D recycled materials by any Dept. / agency.
