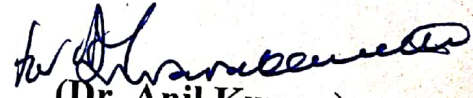

Minutes of the Meeting Taken by Chief Secretary, Govt. of NCT on 05.02.2019 at 5.00 P.M in his conference room at 5th Level , Delhi Secretariat with respect to order dated 16.01.2019 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in OA No. 606/2018 regarding Compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.

A meeting was taken by Chief Secretary, Govt. of NCT of Delhi on 05.02.2019 in his conference room with respect to order dated 16.01.2019 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in OA No. 606/2018 regarding Compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.

Attendance Sheet is enclosed as **Annexure –“A”**.

Representatives from Urban Development Department, Govt. of NCT Delhi, Municipal Corporations, Irrigation & Flood Control Department, Delhi Jal Board, Industries Department, Environment Department, Delhi Pollution Control Committee, DSIIDC, Development Department and other Departments were present in the meeting.

Secretary (Environment) cum Chairman, DPCC briefed about the directions given by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 16.01.2019 in OA No. 606/2018 regarding Compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. Chief Secretary emphasized that the directions given by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the said order are comprehensive & encompassing almost all the issues related to Environmental Pollution and must be complied by concerned departments in a time bound manner and necessary proposals be made by all stakeholders for the meeting of CS with Chairman NGT on 11.03.2019.

Various directions given Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the said order were discussed in the meeting and following directions were given by the Chief Secretary for compliance of the abovementioned order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal:

1. Urban Development Department, Govt. of NCT Delhi and All the Municipal Corporations / Urban Local bodies in NCT of Delhi will submit their point wise compliance status w.r.t Duties and responsibilities mentioned under the following Rules in the Format which shall be prepared and provided by the Environment Department to the concerned Departments/ Corporations so as to have uniformity for compilation of the information:

- (i) The Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- (ii) Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- (iii) Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- (iv) Bio- Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016

All Municipal Corporations / Urban Local bodies /
Environment Deptt.)**

2. Health Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi shall submit their point wise compliance status w.r.t specific provisions under the Bio- Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 in the prescribed format/ table which shall be provided by the Environment Department to have uniformity for compilation of the information.

(Action By: Health Department GNCTD)

3. DPCC shall submit their point wise compliance status w.r.t specific provisions under the abovementioned Rules and specifically in respect of Hospitals/ Nursing Homes/ Health Care Establishments w.r.t Bio- Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.

(Action By: DPCC)

4. State Level Committee headed by Chief Secretary and Special Task Force (STF) in every district of NCT of Delhi having 3 members, one each nominated by District Magistrate, DCP, DPCC and one person to be nominated by the Chairman of the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) shall be constituted as mentioned in the order dated 16.01.2019 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal.

First meeting of the Committee headed by Chief Secretary shall be held before 15.02.2019.

5. A Committee shall be constituted to review the Action Plan of River Rejuvenation Committee constituted by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal which has already been submitted to Central Pollution Control Board, and meeting of said committee be called to review the Action Plan.

6. Regarding status of functioning of Committees constituted in News Item Published in "The Times of India" Authored by Shri Vishwa Mohan Titled "NCAP with Multiple timelines to Clear Air in 102 Cities to be released around August 15" dated 08.10.2018 , further necessary action shall be taken by Environment Department, GNCTD.

7. Meeting shall be called to review the implementation w.r.t "Action Plan for Abatement of Pollution of Critically Polluted Area i.e. Najafgarh Drain Basin Including Okhla, Naraina, Anand Parbat and Wazirpur Industrial Areas of NCT, Delhi" prepared by DPCC and submitted to Central Pollution Control Board.

Status of Action Plan with regard to identification of polluted industrial clusters in O.A. No. 1038/2018, News item published in "The Asian Age" Authored by Sanjay Kaw Titled "CPCB to rank industrial units on pollution levels" dated 13.12.2018 shall be prepared and necessary action shall be taken w.r.t said order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal .

8. DPCC and other concerned Departments shall impose the Environmental Compensation on erring industries/units on the basis of 'Polluter Pays' principle, 'Precautionary principle' and total amount collected from erring industries/units and details of utilization of funds collected shall be compiled and submitted to Environment Deptt. by 15.02.2019.

9. Irrigation & Flood Control Department, all Municipal Corporations, PWD, DJB, DDA and DSIIDC shall ensure that all the drains (Big or Small) in their jurisdiction are linked with appropriate measures (wire nets etc) to ensure stoppage of Municipal Solid and Plastic waste to River Yamuna and Lakes, Water Bodies, Ponds, Marsh lands and Wet lands etc in NCT of Delhi.

(Action By: I& FC Deptt., All Municipal Corporations, PWD, DJB, DDA and DSIIDC)

10. Environment Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi will display on its website and also on the website of DPCC, the progress made on each of the issues mentioned in the abovementioned order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, consistent with directions in some of the earlier order, including the order dated 19.12.2018 in News Item published in "The Hindu" authored by Shri Jacob Koshy Titled "More river stretches are now critically polluted: CPCB (Original Application No. 673/2018).

(Action By: Environment Department GNCTD)

11. Regarding directions given by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal vide Order dated 04.09.2018 in O.A. No. 173 of 2018, Sudarsan Das v. State of West Bengal & Ors., it was informed that the Directions are mainly related to West Bangal and Odisha regarding sand mining.

12. Regarding status of the identification and development of Model Cities and Towns in the State in the first phase which can be replicated later for other cities and towns of the State it was informed that the matter mainly related to States.

13. The performa for compilation of information from local bodies, PWD, IFC & other stakeholders is being emailed separately.
