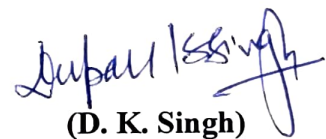
MINUTES OF MEETING

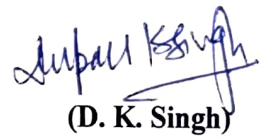

Minutes of the Meeting of State Level Committee headed by Chief Secretary held on 22.12.2020 at 03.00 P.M through Video Conferencing to review the action taken w.r.t. the orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in O.A. No. 606/2018 regarding Compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.

The meeting was taken by Addl. Chief Secretary (Env. & Forest) on behalf of Chief Secretary, GNCTD.

Officers from various Organizations including Urban Development Deptt., GNCTD [Addl. Chief Secretary (UD)], Pr. Secy (Env.) Cum Chairman, DPCC, Municipal Corporations (Addl. Commissioners of SDMC & North DMC and Commissioner EDMC), NDMC (Secy, NDMC), Revenue Department, Health (Spl. Secy), Delhi Jal Board (CEO, DJB), DSIIDC [SE (Env.)], Environment Deptt., Member Secretary, Delhi Pollution Control Committee and other Departments attended the meeting.

Addl. Chief Secretary (Env. & Forest) welcomed the participants and asked all the concerned Departments (Municipal Corporations/Local Bodies), DDA, DSIIDC etc. to take the issues related to Municipal Solid Waste Management seriously for compliance of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and orders of the Hon'ble NGT in O.A. No. 606/2018. He stressed upon the need and importance of the segregation of waste at source and informed that most of the timelines mentioned in the said Rules / NGT orders have already been expired / jumped. Action Plan with timelines is required to be submitted by all the Local Bodies / Municipal Corporations. Representatives of Municipal Corporations / Local Bodies & other Departments / Organizations were invited to inform regarding their compliance status w.r.t said Rules and orders of the Hon'ble NGT in the said matter.

Pr. Secretary (Env.) - Cum - Chairman, DPCC and Member Secretary, DPCC briefed about the issues for review in the meeting, informed that there is slow progress in various projects related to MSW Processing & Disposal and lack of compliance w.r.t Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. Fire incidents at Ghazipur & Bhalaswa was also pointed out. Latest order dated 14.12.2020 of Hon'ble NGT in OA No. 606/2018 was also briefed. It was informed that as per the said order, the Hon'ble NGT will primarily deal with the issues of Solid Waste Management only and appearance of the Chief Secretary, Delhi has been deferred till further Orders subject to the condition that the monitoring at the level of Chief Secretary may continue, as directed earlier. Quarterly compliance reports are to be filed with CPCB.

Addl. Commissioner of SDMC, Sh. Ramesh Verma informed that in SDMC area there are 104 wards. Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) generation is about 3600 TPD and about 50% (1800 TPD) of the said quantity is being processed & disposed through the existing Solid Waste Processing Facilities in their area. Rest of the MSW, i.e., about 1800 TPD is being disposed in the Okhla Dump site. Door to Door collection is 100%, segregation in three Model Wards is 82 to 100% (100% in all 3 Model Wards to be achieved by January, 2021), 100% segregation will be achieved in another 13 Wards by March, 2021, in rest 43 Wards segregation is to be achieved by June, 2021. There is one Waste to Energy Plant of 1950 TPD and one centralized Compost Plant of 200 TPD capacity both at Okhla which are being used by SDMC, NDMC & DCB for disposal of their combustible municipal waste and bio-degradable municipal waste respectively. 4 Bio-methanation Plants of 5 TPD each were to be installed & 3 have already been commissioned. 4 Decentralised Composter Plants of 1 TPD each were to be installed & 3 plants have already been commissioned. Besides these plants there is one proposed Bio-gas plant of 100 TPD at Nangli/Goyla Dairy. It was also informed that presently 10 Trommels are operational and more than 3 Lakh MT of Legacy Waste has been processed / Bio-mined at Okhla Dumpsite. SDMC will process / bio-mine 100% of Legacy Waste at Okhla Dump site by March, 2023.

Addl. Commissioner of North DMC, Ms. Swati informed that in North DMC area there are 104 wards. Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) generation is about 4500 TPD and about 2300 TPD of MSW is being processed & disposed through the existing Solid Waste Processing Facilities (Waste to Energy Plant, Compost Plant and Engineered SLF at Bawana) in their area. Rest of the MSW, i.e., about 2200 TPD (50 % is Bio-degradable & rest 50 % is Non Bio-degradable) is being disposed in the Bhalaswa Dump site. For processing & disposal of this 2200 TPD of MSW North DMC is going to sign a MoU with Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) for Waste to Energy Plant etc. at Ranikhera. Door to Door collection is 100%, segregation in three Model Wards is about 80%. 100% segregation will be achieved in 31 Wards by March, 2021 including 3 Model Wards. For segregation at source , campaign has been launched involving RWAs for awareness among the residents of the Societies. There is one Waste to Energy Plant of 1300 TPD & one compost plant of 750 TPD in the Integrated MSW Facility at Bawana which is being used by North DMC for disposal of their combustible municipal waste and biodegradable waste respectively. 4 Bio-methanation Plants of 5 TPD each were to be installed & 2 have already been commissioned. 6 Decentralised Composter Plants of 1 TPD each were to be installed & 3 plants have already been commissioned. It was also informed that North DMC has installed 21 Trommels for Processing / Bio-mining of the Legacy Waste at Bhalaswa out of which 15 Trommels are operational and about 10.6 Lakh MT of Legacy Waste has been processed / bio-mined. 25 % of the Legacy Waste at Bhalaswa will be processed / bio-mined by April, 2021, 50% by October, 2021 & 100% by June, 2022. Regarding Fire Incident at Bhalaswa Dumpsite, it was informed that due to measures taken by North DMC, fire incidents have been reduced & only two fire incidents occurred in the year 2020-2021. For control of dust, Anti-Smog Gun has also been provided at the Bhalaswa Dump site besides other measures taken (sprinkling of water through 4 water tankers).

East DMC & Other Local Bodies were also asked to submit their Compliance Status & Information as provided above by SDMC & North DMC to DPCC at the earliest.

After detailed deliberations following decisions were taken :-

- (i) All the concerned Municipal Corporations / Local Bodies / Departments shall submit their Compliance Status & requisite Information provided during the meeting in writing to DPCC at the earliest.
- (ii) Organic bio-degradable MSW (which is about 50% of the total MSW) should be either disposed through Composting or Bio-methanation (as far as possible) instead of incineration & dumping at the dump sites in Delhi.
- (iii) 50% of the Legacy Waste at the three Dump sites (at Ghazipur, Bhalaswa & Okhla) should be processed / biomined by 31.03.2021 & 100% by June, 2022 and concerned Municipal Corporations to submit Action Plan along with timelines to UD Dept. & DPCC in this regard, at the earliest.

Information in the prescribed Format / Template of CPCB regarding Solid Waste Management for the Quarter, October to December, 2020 shall be provided by all the Municipal Corporations / Local Bodies to DPCC [through email at Email Id: dpcc.wmc2.delhi@gmail.com , hard copy of the same is also required to be submitted] at the earliest & latest by 20.01.2021.
