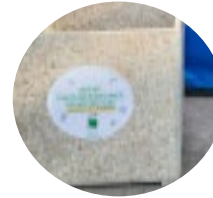

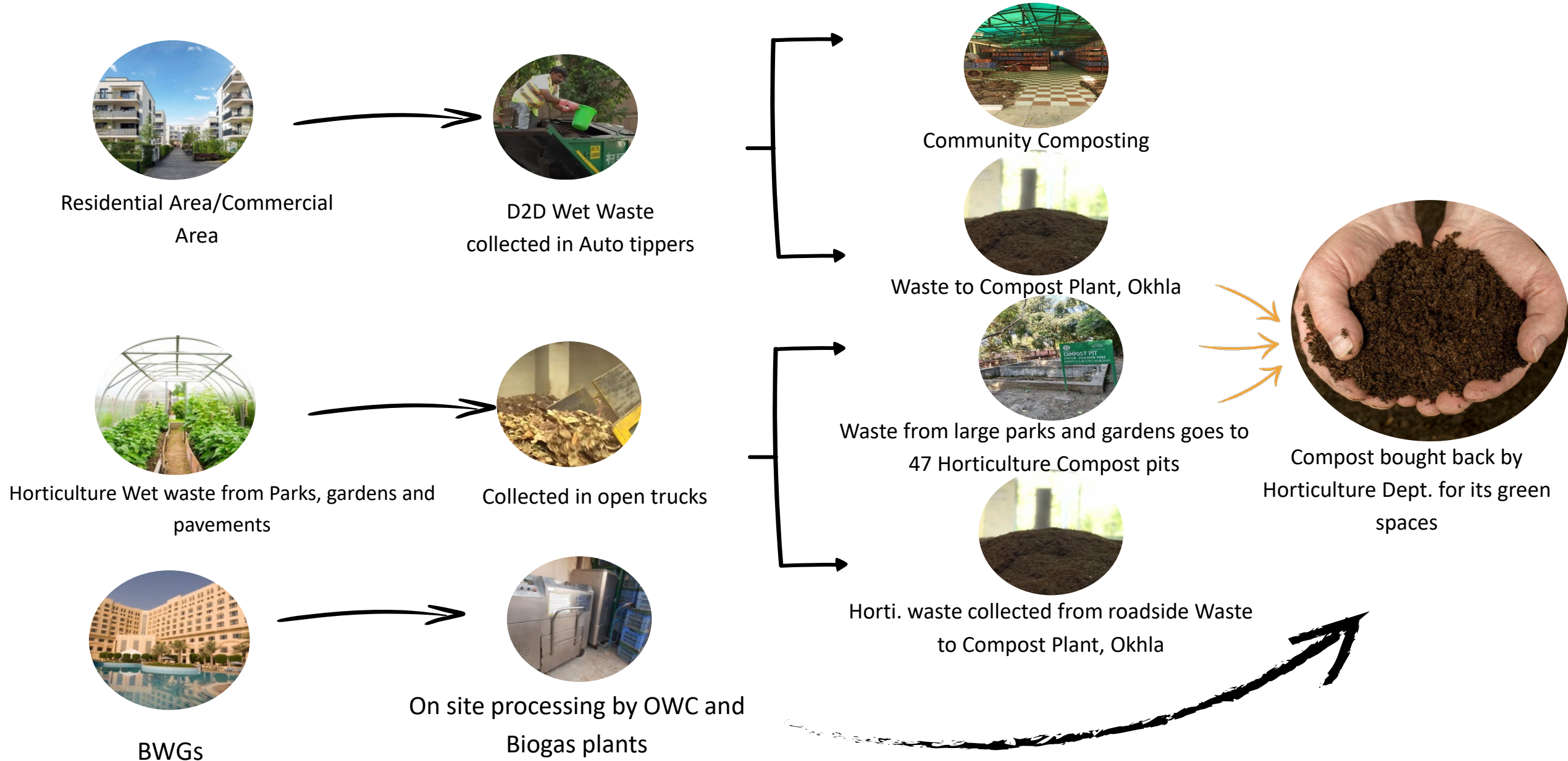

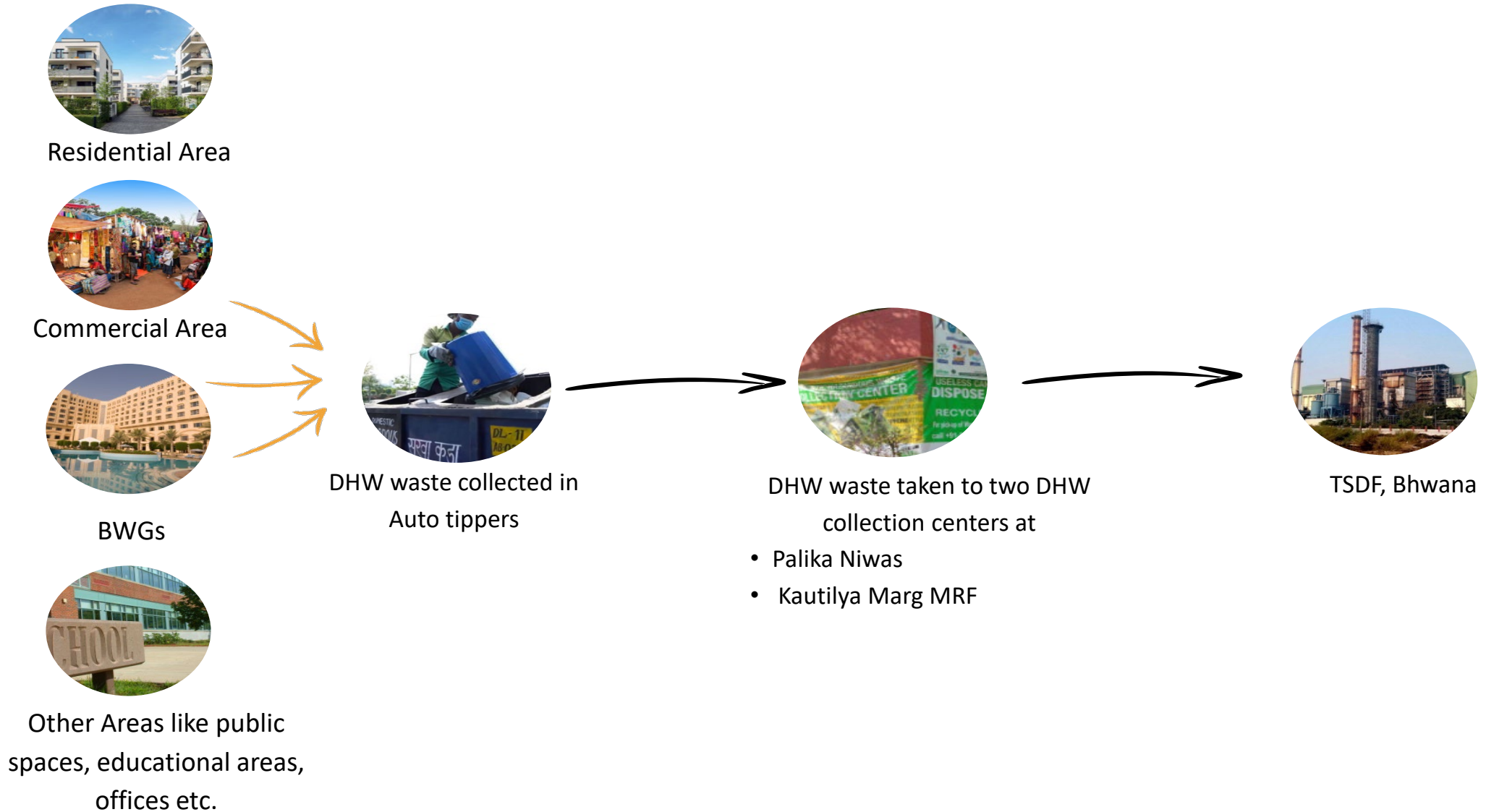

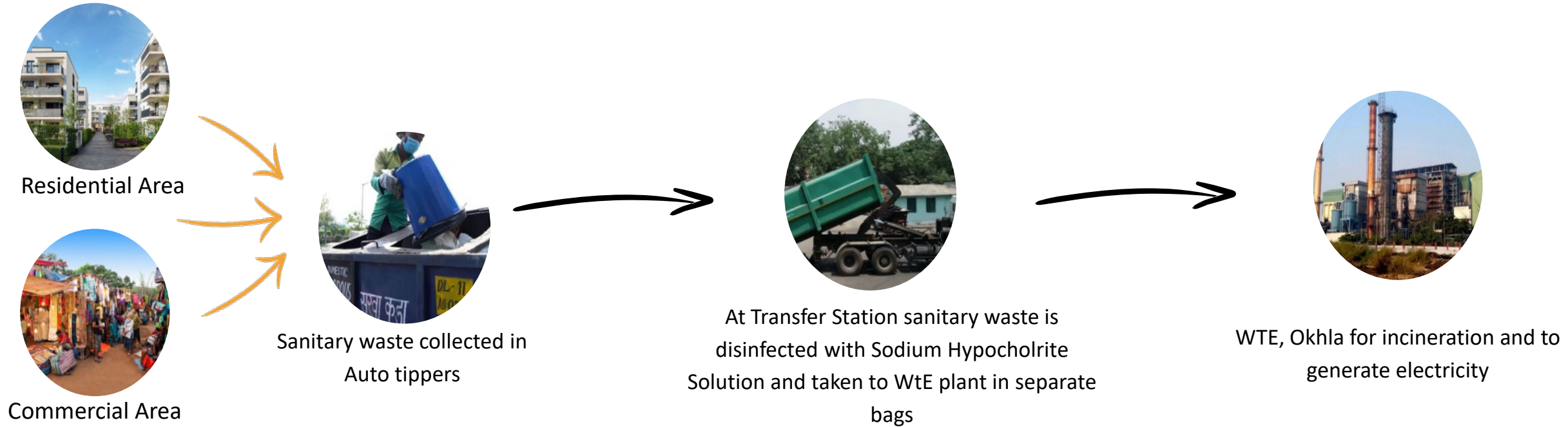
# Wet Waste Processing Cycle

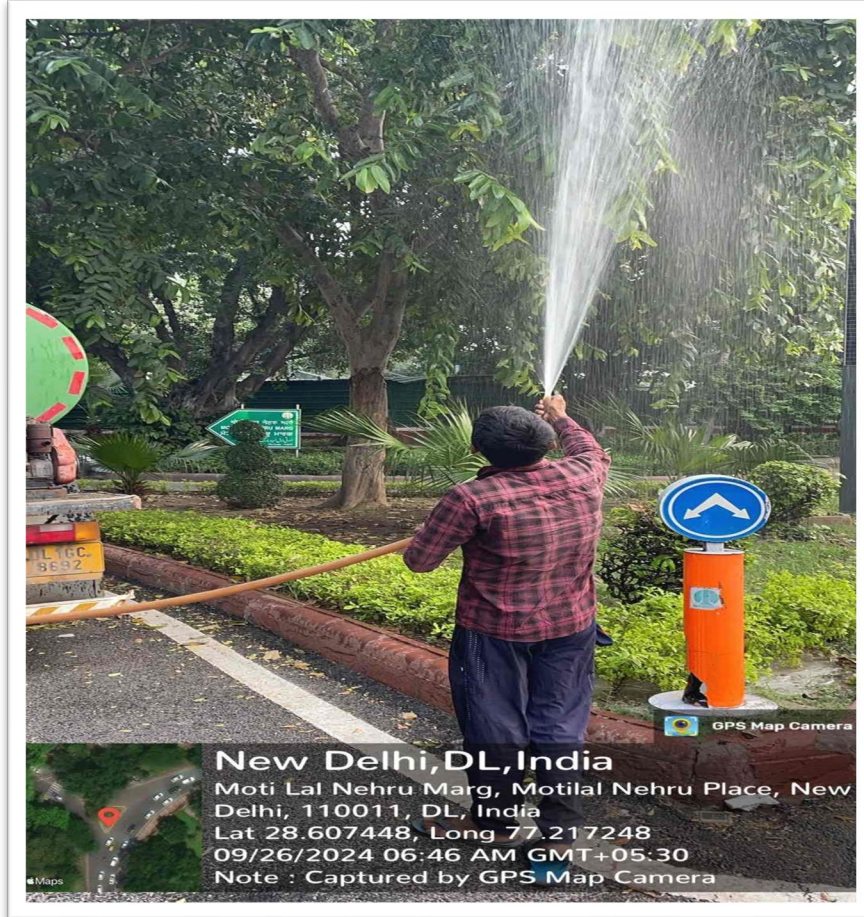
