Subject: Letter for obtaining Consent under Orange category from DPCC and compliance of provisions of Air and Water Acts-reg.

This is with reference to the inspection conducted on 04.07.2025 by DPCC officials of the unit M/s Café West Delhi (Prop. Sh. Haridesh Kumar Sharma, and Sh. Pankaj Kapoor), operating from Shop Nos. 04, 05, 07, 08, 09, 10, and 11, Ground Floor, C.S.C., Sub District Center, Hari Nagar, West Delhi – 110064 (hereinafter referred to as the "addressee").

During the inspection, the following observations were made:

- The addressee unit was found operational in the activity of a Restaurant, with a seating capacity ranging from 50 to 60 seats with kitchen.
- The unit was found operating without a valid Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO) under Water & Air Act, from DPCC.
- Oil and Grease Trap (OGT) was found not installed to the kitchen sink. Unit owner had informed that it was removed for repair purpose.
- The unit has obtained MCD license under the "Take Away" category for Shop No. 9, 10 & 11, which is valid up to 31.03.2028.
- The unit has converted the open area in front of its 07 shops into a seating area and now operating as a cafe/restaurant without proper approval from the Municipal Corporation.
- The kitchen chimney/channelization system installed was not provided upto adequate height.

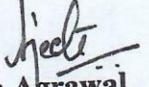
The case of the unit was processed and Competent Authority in DPCC has decided to ask the unit to :

1. Apply for **Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO)** in DPCC (please visit <https://dpccocmms.nic.in/>).
2. Install proper **Oil and Grease Trap cum settling Tank** for holding the effluent arising from kitchen and washing activities for at least 4 hours duration.
3. Properly channelize the fugitive emissions including emissions from cooking & kitchen operations by providing proper ducting / hood arrangement and proper exhaust system and **emissions shall be discharged at least 2 meter above the roof of the building and properly handle, manage and dispose the solid waste generated and comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, as amended to**

date, the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended to date and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, as amended to date and Rules made there under.

The addressee unit is directed to submit the point wise compliances report of above points at ISBT Building, 4th & 5th Floor, Kashmere Gate, New Delhi, Delhi 110006 and/or at cmc6-del@delhi.gov.in within 15 days from the date of service of this letter, failing which it shall be presumed that it has nothing to say in this regard and further necessary actions may be initiated against the addressee unit as per law.

This issues as per the approval of the Competent Authority, Delhi Pollution Control Committee.
