Subject: Reminder Show Cause Notice (SCN) for imposition of Environmental Compensation(EC), issued on 17.06.2022-reg.

Whereas, Delhi is facing air pollution above the prescribed levels and the air quality w.r.t. levels of pollutants like Particulate Matter (PM2.5 & PM10) is deteriorating thereby affecting public health. Activities related to construction and demolition have been identified as one of the major sources of air pollution and continuation of such activities without proper dust pollution control measures aggravate the situation.

And whereas, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in various Orders have directed Government of NCT of Delhi to initiate steps to curb the dust pollution. The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal has passed certain directions for controlling environment pollution in Delhi and also fixed compensation to be paid for violation in terms of the Section 15 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 for polluting the environment.

In pursuance of the directions from Commission for Air Quality Management of NCR Region and adjoining areas and the Chief Secretary, Delhi it is decided that Construction and demolition activity in NCT of Delhi has to be undertaken only after ensuring the Dust Mitigation Measures as prescribed from time to time.

And whereas, copies of the Hon'ble Tribunal orders, MoEF&CC guidelines on the subject and public notice issued are available at the DPCC website "<http://dpcc.delhigovt.nic.in>" for general awareness of the stake holders.

And whereas, you M/s Gaurav Bhasin, Plot No. 27, Road No. 77, West Punjabi Bagh, New Delhi-110026 (hereinafter referred as addressee unit) was found engaged in the activity of construction.

And whereas, an inspection had conducted by DPCC officials on 17.06.2022 and it was found that the aforesaid RMC Plant following discrepancies were observed—

1. Tarpaulin or green-nets on scaffolding around the area under construction were not found.
2. Loose soil or sand or Construction & Demolition waste or any other construction material that causes dust were left uncovered.

3. Unpaved surfaces and areas with loose soil had not been adequately sprinkled with the water to suppress dust.
4. Dust masks were not provided to workers involved in the activity of loading, unloading or debris.
5. PM2.5 & PM10 sensors and video-fencing with remote connectivity were not installed at the project site.
6. Dust mitigation measures were not displayed at the construction site.

And whereas, the project proponent with plot area of 500 sq m or more are required to regulate themselves on the web portal i.e., <https://dustcontroldpcc.delhi.gov.in> and submit self-assessment on the aforesaid portal within 2 days from the date of issuance of this notice.

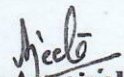
Now therefore, in compliance of the orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal and as per the "Polluter Pays" principle it is proposed to levy/impose Environmental Compensation(EC) of **Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only)** was issued to you, the addressee vide SCN dated **17.06.2022** (copy enclosed) for the deficiencies observed at above said site/ address for causing damage to the environment.

And whereas, you, the addressee unit, have neither submitted any reply nor deposited the EC till date.

And whereas, the case of your unit was placed before the competent Authority in Delhi Pollution Control Committee and it has been decided to issue a reminder Show Cause Notice to give one more opportunity to submit your reply.

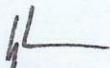
Now, by way of this reminder notice, you, the addressee, are hereby once again called upon to **Show Cause** as to why the above Environmental Compensation (EC) should not be confirmed. The reply, if any, should reach to this office (at **ISBT Building, 4th & 5th Floor, GT Karnal Rd, Kashmere Gate, New Delhi, Delhi 110006** and/or at cmc6dpcc2025@gmail.com) within 15 days from the date of issue of this notice. In case of failure, it will be presumed that the addressee has nothing to say in this regard and the aforementioned proposed Environmental Compensation (EC) shall be confirmed. This may again also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

This issues as per the approval of the Competent Authority, Delhi Pollution Control Committee.

And whereas, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in various orders have directed Government of NCT of Delhi to initiate steps to curb the dust pollution. The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal has passed certain directions for controlling environment pollution in Delhi and also fixed compensation to be paid for violation in term of the Section 15 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 for polluting the environment.

And whereas, during the visit of construction site at ...Plot No. 27, Road No. 77, West Punjabi Bagh, New Delhi-110026 (Front Part) by the team of DPCC officials on 17/06/2022 discrepancies (marked as 'Non-complied' or 'X') observed wrt. dust pollution control guidelines are as under:

And whereas, the project proponent with plot area of 500 sq m or more are required to regulate themselves on the web portal i.e. <https://dustcontroldpcc.delhi.gov.in> and submit self-assessment on the aforesaid portal within 2 days from the date of issuance of this notice.

Now therefore, in compliance of the orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal and as per the "Polluter Pays" principle it is proposed to levy/impose Environmental Compensation (EC) of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only) on the above said project proponent/owner/occupier (hereinafter referred as the addressee) for the deficiencies observed at above said site/ address for damage caused to the environment.

By way of this notice, the you (the addressee) are hereby required to Show Cause as to why the above said Environmental Compensation (EC) should not be imposed on you (the addressee) for non-compliance with the guidelines for dust pollution control and causing damage to the environment.

Your reply (if any) along with supporting documents including photographs of site (i.e. Dust/wind breaking walls of appropriate height/ Tarpaulin or green-net on scaffolding around the area under-construction /building, full cover over construction material and construction debris, etc.), registration on web portal (in case of 500 sq m and above) and rectification measures taken should reach to this office within 02 days from the date of issue of this notice. In case of failure, it will be presumed that you (the addressee) have nothing to say in this regard and the aforementioned EC shall be imposed without any further reference in this regard.
