REMINDER-I

Subject: Order for confirmation of Environment Damage Compensation (EDC) and submission of compliance report of dust mitigation norms – reg.

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board is the State Board for all the Union Territories to exercise powers and performs functions under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

And whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 in respect of NCT of Delhi-to-Delhi Pollution Control Committee vide Notification No. S.O. 198 (E) dated 15.03.1991.

And whereas, the whole Union Territory of Delhi has been declared as an Air Pollution Control area, under sub section (1) of section 19 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 vide notification no. GSR 106 (E) dated 20.02.1987.

And whereas, Delhi faces grave air pollution particularly in winter season and level of pollutants like Particulate Matter Concentration (PM_{2.5} and PM₁₀) goes much beyond the prescribed standards for Ambient Air Quality.

And whereas, the Commission for Air Quality Management in NCR and adjoining areas has repeatedly taken up the matter relating to air pollution with Government of NCT of Delhi and various organizations and has issued various Directions, Advisories and Orders for effective implementation of measures for abating air pollution in NCR from time to time.

And whereas, an inspection of building construction site at **Mangalam Apartments, Near SDM (Civil Lines), Opposite Shalimar Palace, Laxmi Vihar, Burari, Delhi- 110084** (hereinafter referred as addressee) was conducted by DPCC officials on **04.11.2024** and it was observed that you are violating the Dust mitigation norms.

During said inspection, the observations/deficiencies found are as follows:-

- i. Site found operational and the plot area of the site is approx. 600 sq. m. as informed by the representative.
- ii. Site is not registered on DPCC Dust Portal.
- iii. Dust/Wind breaking walls of appropriate height around the periphery of the construction site are not provided.
- iv. Tarpaulin or green net on scaffolding around the area under construction and the building are not provided.
- v. Loose construction material left uncovered on site.
- vi. Unpaved surface with loose soil left unsprinkled.

And whereas, Directions for stoppage of construction and Show Cause Notice for imposition of Environment Damage Compensation of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) was issued to you vide F. No. DPCC/CFC-VII/Complaints/OnlineGrievancePortals-2/2024/5067-70 dated 14.01.2025 which is levied in view of EC regime approved by the worthy Chairman, DPCC for non-compliance of dust mitigation measures dated 22.10.2024.

And whereas, an order for confirmation of Environment Damage Compensation of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) was issued to you vide F. No. DPCC/CFC-VII/Complaints/OnlineGrievancePortals-2/2024/5634-36 dated 27.03.2025.

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
