Subject: Direction for Closure u/s 33(A) of Water Act,
 amended to date & Direction for imposition of Environmental Compensation.

Sir,

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 in respect of Union Territory of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee. And whereas, the whole Union Territory of Delhi has been declared as an Air Pollution Control area, under sub section (I) of section 19 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 vide notification no. GSR 106 (E) dated 20.02.1987.

And whereas, it is mandatory provision under section 21/22 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall establish or operate any industrial plant in air pollution control area.

And whereas, it is mandatory provisions u/s 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 that no person without the previous consent of DPCC shall Establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process or any treatment and disposal system an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent in to a stream or on land.

And whereas, a Civil Suit CS SCJ 458/2024 Titled as "Kailash Bhartia Vs Uttarakhand Bhojnalaya has been filed in Karkardooma District Court regarding operation of Illegal and unauthorized Dhaba namely Uttarakhand Bhojnalaya at plot No. 5 Old No. 422 Flat No. 1, Gali No. 1, Shanti Marg, Mandawali, Delhi-110091, which is causing air and water pollution as well as safety issues to the plaintiff and nearby other locality members.

And whereas, to ascertain the facts mentioned in the prayer an inspection of the said site was carried out by DPCC officials on 10.03.2025 & during inspection following observations were made:-

1. Unit found operational & engaged in the activity of restaurant (take away).
2. Unit found operating without any license from DPCC.
3. ETP/OGT not found installed.
4. Channelization system provided but exit of stack of chimney is provided in drain.

And whereas, activity carried out by the addressee unit falls under Orange category as per DPCC categorization, and as per the extant policy of DPCC dated 30.03.2022, you shall be liable to pay Environmental Compensation (EC) amount of Rs. 7,50,000/-

(Rupees Seven Lakh fifty thousand only) to DPCC in the form of DD in favour of DPCC.

And whereas, DPCC issued Show Cause Notice for Closure and SCN for imposition of EC dated 25.03.2025 to you (the addressee).

And whereas, no EC/response to above mentioned SCN dated 25.03.2025 has been received in this office.

Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred upon it, under the provisions of said acts as amended to date, the DPCC hereby issues the following directions:

1. That you (the addressee) shall close your unit with immediate effect.
2. The proposed Environmental Compensation (EC) of amount Rs. 7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh fifty thousand only) is hereby confirmed/imposed on you. Therefore you are directed to submit EC of amount Rs. 7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh fifty thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft in favour of DPCC within 15 days from the issuance of this direction.
3. That the concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate shall ensure effective closure of the said unit with immediate effect.
4. That the concerned authority in BSES shall disconnect the electricity/power supply of the said unit with immediate effect.
5. That the concerned authority in DJB shall disconnect the water supply connection of the said unit with immediate effect.

This is being issued as per the approval of the Competent Authority, Delhi Pollution Control Committee.
