Subject: Show Cause Notice for Imposition of Environmental Compensation (EC).

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of pollution) Act, 1981 in respect of Union Territory of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee vide notification No. I S.O. 198 (E) dated 15.03.1991.

Whereas, it is mandatory provision under section 21/22 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall Establish an industrial unit in an Air Pollution Control Area of Union Territory of Delhi.

Whereas, it is mandatory provisions under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall Establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process or any treatment and disposal system an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

And whereas, various complaints are received in this office regarding grave issue of Air Pollution and illegal operation of industries in Jawahar Nagar Industrial Area.

And whereas, an inspection was carried out at the premises **M/s Jain Metal, A-30, Jawahar Nagar Ind. Area, Delhi-110094** Owner: Atul Jain on **07.05.2025** and following are the observations:

1. Unit found operational during inspection and found engaged in activity of Light Engineering Works.
2. Unit is not in possession of any license of DPCC.
3. Unit is non-polluting in nature.

And whereas, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal vide orders dated 05.08.2019 & 19.11.2019 in OA No. 601/2018 in the matter of "Mayank Manohar & Paras Singh, Reporter, the Times of India Vs. Govt. of Delhi & Ors." has also directed closure of impermissible industrial units in residential/non-confirming areas of NCT of Delhi and levying Environmental Compensation (EC) for the damage caused by illegal operation keeping in view the 'Polluters Pay Principle'.

And whereas, activity carried out by the addressee unit falls under **White category** as per DPCC categorisation, and as per the extant policy of DPCC dated 30.03.2022, you shall be

liable to pay lumpsum **Environmental Compensation (EC) of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** to DPCC in the form of DD in favour of DPCC.

Now, therefore, you are hereby directed to show cause as to why the **Environmental Compensation (EC) of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** should not be levied upon you (the addressee).

Your reply, (if any) should reach this office within 15 days from the date of issue of this notice. In case of failure, it will be presumed that the addressee has nothing to say in this regard and the aforementioned proposed **EC of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** shall be confirmed without any further reference in this regard.
