Subject: Show Cause Notice for imposition of EC and Show Cause Notice for Closure for violation of Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016 as amended to date - reg.

Whereas, Rule 4 of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date, inter-alia provides that an occupier of a facility shall be responsible for safe and environmentally sound management of hazardous and other wastes generated in the establishment and hazardous and other wastes generated shall be sent or sold to an authorized actual user or shall be disposed of in an authorized disposal facility.

And whereas, as per the rule 6 of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date, every occupier of facility, handling, generation, collection, storage, packaging, transportation, use, treatment, processing, recycling, recovery, pre-processing, co-processing, utilization, offering for sale, transfer or disposal of the hazardous waste and other wastes shall be required to obtain an authorization from State Pollution Control Board (Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC), in case of Delhi).

And whereas, as per the rule 6(5) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date, every occupier authorized under these rules, shall maintain a record of hazardous and other wastes managed by him in Form 3 and prepare and submit to the State Pollution Control Board/Committee, an annual return containing the details specified in Form 4 on or before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.

And whereas, you, M/s Arihant Metal, Plot No. 21, Kh. No. 21/6, Gali No. 10, Ambedkar Vihar, Jawahar Nagar Industrial Area, Delhi-110092 (herein after referred as addressee) are operating your unit at the above said address & engaged in the activity of **Printing Without Trade Effluent Discharge** and generating Hazardous Waste as per Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Trans-boundary Rules), 2016.

And whereas, an inspection of your unit was conducted by the representatives of DPCC on 07.05.2025 and it was found that you are operating your unit without complying with the provisions of Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Trans-boundary Rules), 2016.

And whereas, as per the recommendation of Monitoring Committee in O.A No 804/2017 in the matter of Rajiv Narayan and union of India Ors., the unit which are violating the provision of HOWM Rules, 2016 a penalty of Rs 1,00,000/- for each violation is to be imposed on such defaulting units. Therefore, you (the addressee) shall be liable to pay lumpsum **Environmental Compensation (EC) of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only)** to DPCC in the form of DD in favour of DPCC for violating the provision of HOWM Rules, 2016.

Now, therefore, the Competent Authority in DPCC in exercise of powers conferred upon it u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as amended to date has decided to issue the following proposed directions:

- That you (the addressee) shall close your unit with immediate effect.
- That the concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate shall be directed to take necessary action to ensure effective closure of the said unit with immediate effect.
- That the concerned authority in BSES, Yamuna Power Ltd shall be directed to disconnect the electricity/power supply of the said unit with immediate effect.
- That the concerned authority in DJB shall be directed to disconnect the water supply connection of the said unit with immediate effect.
- That why Environmental Compensation of Rs 1,00,000 /- should not be imposed on you (the addressee).

By way of this notice, you (the addressee) are hereby called upon to Show Cause Notice, as to why the aforesaid proposed Directions should not be confirmed & the Addressee is hereby called upon to show cause as to why the above said Environmental Compensation should not be imposed. The reply, if any, should reach this office within 15 days from the date of issue of this notice. In case of failure, it will be presumed that the addressee has nothing to say in this regard and the aforesaid proposed Directions shall be confirmed and aforesaid proposed Environmental Compensation shall be imposed on you without any further reference to you. This may also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

This is being issued as per the decision of Competent Authority in DPCC.
