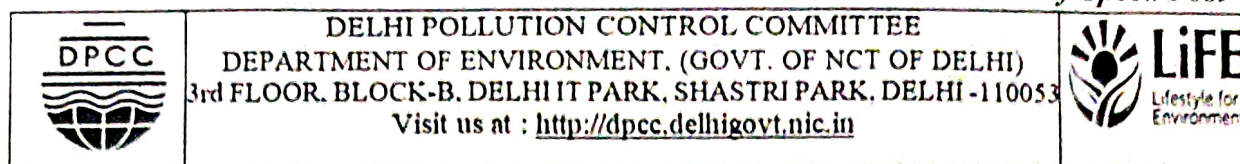

Subject: Show Cause Notice for Closure Directions u/s 33(A) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended to date.

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 in respect of Union Territory of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee.

And whereas, it is a mandatory provision under u/s 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process or any treatment and disposal system an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

And whereas, you **M/s LARK INDUSTRIES K-30, GROUND FLOOR, UDYOG NAGAR INDUSTRIAL AREA, DELHI - 110041** (herein after referred as addressee unit) engaged in the activity of **Plating - Nickel and Chrome Plating**.

And whereas, during the 7th round of annual inspections of Gross Polluting Industries (GPIs) 2023-24, a joint inspection was conducted by third party i.e. IIT Delhi and DPCC officials on **30.08.2024** and you, the addressee, were found locked. The same situation was observed during the previous inspection dated 01.02.2023, indicating that the unit is not operational at present.

Now therefore, in view of the above, the Competent Authority in DPCC, in exercise of powers conferred upon Delhi Pollution Control Committee, u/s 33(A) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended to date, has proposed to issue the following directions:

1. That you (the addressee unit) shall **stop all the operations and close your unit** with immediate effect.
2. That the concerned authority in BSES shall **disconnect the electricity/power supply** of the said addressee unit with immediate effect.
3. That the concerned authority in DJB shall **disconnect the water supply connection** to the said addressee unit with immediate effect.
4. That the concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) shall take necessary action to ensure the **effective closure of the said addressee unit** with immediate effect.

Hence, by way of this notice, you are hereby issued this **Show Cause Notice (SCN)** as to why the aforesaid proposed directions should not be confirmed. Your reply should reach this office within 15 days from date of service of this notice, failing which it shall be assumed that you have nothing to say in this regard and the Competent Authority of DPCC shall initiate action as proposed above. This may also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

This is being issued as per the approval of the Competent Authority, DPCC.
