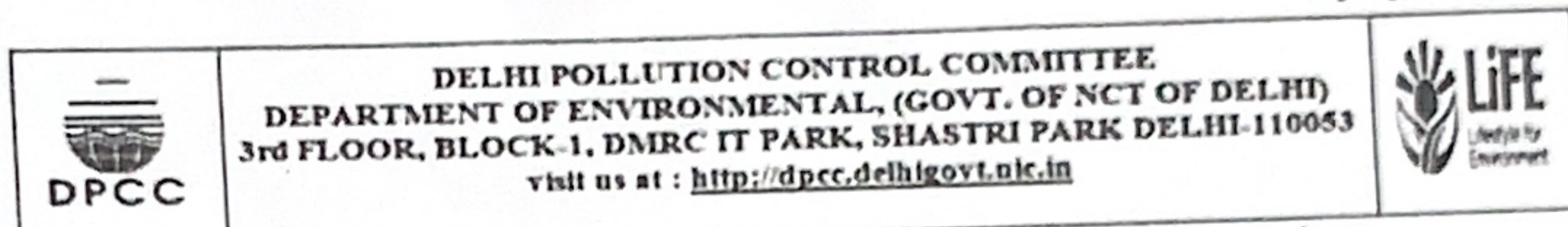

Sub: Direction for Imposition of Environmental Damage Compensation (EDC)-reg.

Whereas, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal vide orders dated 05.08.2019 & 19.11.2019 in OA No. 601/2018 in the matter of "Mayank Manohar & Paras Singh, Reporter, the Times of India Vs. Govt. of Delhi & Ors." has also directed closure of impermissible industrial units in residential/ non-confirming areas of NCT of Delhi and levying Environmental Compensation (EC) for the damage caused by illegal operation keeping in view the 'Polluters Pay Principle'.

And whereas, in compliance with the DPCC Office Order dated 30.09.2022, DPCC officials inspected your unit M/s Mahalaxmi Industries, Plot No. 6 Chander Vihar, Allah Colony, Mandawali, Delhi-110092 on 01.11.2022.

And whereas, during inspection, it was observed that you were operating in the residential/non-confirming area without obtaining license/consent from any government/ regulating body and engaged in the activity of "Manufacturing of vehicle silencer using dies without casting".

And whereas, activity carried out by the addressee falls under White category and as per the Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) EC policy dated 30.03.2022, DPCC issued Show Cause Notice dated 29.12.2022 for Imposition of Environmental Damage Compensation (EDC) of amount Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty thousand only) to you (the addressee).

And whereas, no reply in this regard has been received in this office till date.

Now therefore, as decided by the Competent Authority, DPCC said Environmental Damage Compensation (EDC) of amount Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) is hereby confirmed upon you. You are therefore, hereby directed to deposit said Environmental Damage Compensation of amount Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "Delhi Pollution Control Committee" within 15 days of the issuance of this order failing which the Revenue Department shall be asked to recover EDC as arrears of land revenue.

This is being issued with the approval of the Competent Authority, DPCC .
