Subject: Reminder Show Cause Notice in Compliance of the Orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) in OA No. 601/2018 and provisions of Air & Water Acts, issued on 05.05.2022-reg

Whereas, the whole Union Territory of Delhi has been declared as an Air Pollution Control area, under sub section (I) of section 19 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 vide notification no. GSR 106 (E) dated 20.02.1987.

And whereas, it is a mandatory provision under section 21/22 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.

And whereas, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has ordered closure of impermissible industrial units in residential/non-conforming areas of NCT of Delhi vide order dated 07.5.2004 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 4677/1985 apart from monitoring the matter on regular basis.

And whereas, in Hon'ble National Green Tribunal vide orders dated 05.08.2019 & 19.11.2019 in OA No. 601/2018 in the matter of "Mayank Manohar & Paras Singh, Reporter, the Times of India Vs. Govt. of Delhi & Ors." has also directed closure of impermissible industrial units in residential/non-conforming areas of NCT of Delhi and levying Environmental Compensation (EC) for the damage caused by illegal operation keeping in view the 'Polluters Pay Principle'.

And whereas, you M/s Super Luxe Automobiles, S-245, Jwalapuri, Paschim Vihar Delhi-110087 (hereinafter referred as addressee unit) were engaged in the activity of Car detailing (Polishing, Ceramic coating, Dry Cleaning etc.) in a non-conforming area.

And whereas, an inspection was conducted by DPCC officials on 12.04.2022.

And whereas, you, the addressee unit, were found engaged in the activity of Car detailing (Polishing, Ceramic coating, Dry Cleaning etc.) in non-conformity to MPD-2021 and found violating the environment norms.

And whereas, in view of Hon'ble NGT direction/orders and violation, Competent Authority of DPCC by invoking the 'polluter pays' principle had decided to levy Environmental Compensation (EC) of **Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Only)** on you, the addressee unit, for causing damage to the environment. Therefore SCN dated **05.05.2022** (copy enclosed) was issued to you, the addressee,

And whereas, you, the addressee unit, have neither submitted any reply nor deposited the EC till date.

And whereas, case of your unit was placed before the competent Authority in Delhi Pollution Control Committee and it has been decided to issue a reminder Show Cause Notice to give one more opportunity to submit your reply.

Now, by way of this reminder notice, you, the addressee, are hereby once again called upon to **Show Cause** as to why the above Environmental Compensation (EC) should not be confirmed. The reply, if any, should reach to this office (at **ISBT Building, 4th & 5th Floor, GT Karnal Rd, Kashmere Gate, New Delhi, Delhi 110006** and/or at cmc6dpcc2025@gmail.com) within 15 days from the date of issue of this notice. In case of failure, it will be presumed that the addressee has nothing to say in this regard and the aforementioned proposed Environmental Compensation (EC) shall be confirmed. This may again also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

This issues as per the approval of the Competent Authority, Delhi Pollution Control Committee.
