Subject: Revocation of Consent to Operate (CTO).

Reference: Consent Order Certificate No.: G-23514 dated 10.05.2022.

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of pollution) Act, 1981 in respect of Union Territory of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee vide notification No. I S.O. 198 (E) dated 15.03.1991.

Whereas, it is mandatory provision under section 21/22 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall Establish an industrial unit in an Air Pollution Control Area of Union Territory of Delhi.

Whereas, it is mandatory provisions under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 that no person without the previous consent of the DPCC shall Establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process or any treatment and disposal system an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

Whereas, as per the provisions under section 27(2) of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the provisions under section 21(4) of Air (Prevention & Control of pollution) Act, 1981 SPCB/PCC may cancel any such consent before the expiry of the period for which it is granted or refuse further consent after such expiry if the conditions subject to which such consent has been granted are not fulfilled.

And whereas, an inspection was carried out at the Ready Mix Concrete Plant M/s Kamdhenu Cement (G) C/o Neeraj Jain, Kh No. 616/2, Village Sabhapur, Delhi-110094 on 04.12.2024. During the inspection, unit found violating dust pollution control measures. During inspection, the unit was wrongly reported to be operating separately in the name of M/s Balaji RMC Plant by unit representative Sh. Rocky Rana.

And whereas, a joint team inspection was again carried out at the same Ready Mix Concrete Plant M/s Kamdhenu Cement (G) C/o Neeraj Jain, Kh No. 616/2, Village Sabhapur, Delhi-110094 on 16.04.2025. During the joint inspection, unit is again found violating dust pollution control measures. During inspection, it was confirmed that the unit is being operated under the name of M/s Kamdhenu Cement (G).

And whereas, your case was considered by the Competent Authority, DPCC and it was decided to issue Closure direction and revocation of Consent to Operate (CTO).

Therefore, by way of this letter, the consent order issued in the name of **M/s Kamdhenu Cement (G) C/o Neeraj Jain, Kh No. 616/2, Village Sabhapur, Delhi-110094** having consent order Certificate No.: G-23514 dated 10.05.2022 with validity up to 18.04.2032 issued for activity "Ready Mix Concrete Plants (without trade effluent discharge)" vide application ID: 7698189 under Green Category, is hereby stand revoked with immediate effect.

Please note that you (the addressee) shall not operate the RMC plant and necessary action shall be initiated as per law if found to be operating without valid consent from DPCC.
