Subject:- Reminder-Show Cause Notice for imposition of Environmental Compensation (EC) – reg.

Ref: F.No.DPCC/CMC-V/ PWM-SUP Drive/2022/02 dt 21.12.2022

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, as amended to date , in respect of Union Territory of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) vide Notification dated 15.03.1991.

And whereas, the whole Union Territory of Delhi has been declared as an Air Pollution Control area, under sub section (1) of section 19 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended to date, vide Notification of Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India, No. GSR 106 (E) Dated 20.02.1987.

And whereas, as per the mandatory provisions u/s 21/22 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, no person without the previous consent of the State Pollution Control Board (DPCC in case of Delhi) shall establish or operate any industrial plant in an Air Pollution Control Area.

And whereas, as per the mandatory provisions u/s 25/26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, no person without the previous consent of DPCC shall Establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process or any treatment and disposal system or any extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land, bring into use any new or altered outlet for the discharge of sewage or begin to make any new discharge of sewage.

And whereas, an inspection of M/s Prem Enterprises, Pole No. 572-60/14 & 572-60/13, Bijapur, Village Budhpur, Delhi-110036 (hereinafter referred as “the addressee unit”) was conducted by officials of DPCC on 21.12.2022 and found the unit engaged in the activity of import/local purchase and trading of plastic sheet/lamination film roll for storage and sale of plastic sheet and rolls.

And whereas, Show Cause Notice for imposing Environmental Compensation of amount **Rs 3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only)** was issued to the addressee unit vide letter dated 21.12.2022 (copy enclosed) in view of the deficiencies observed during the above said inspection.

And whereas, in response to the above Show Cause Notice, no reply has been received from your end.

And whereas, your case was put up before the Competent Authority in DPCC and it has been decided to issue reminder Show Cause Notice for imposition of Environmental Compensation (EC).

Hence, by way of this notice, the addressee unit is hereby once again given an opportunity to submit reply as to why the proposed Environmental Compensation of **Rs 3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only)** should not be confirmed. The reply should reach to this office within 15 days from date of service of this notice, failing which it shall be assumed that you have nothing to say in this regard and the DPCC shall be free to take action as proposed above. This shall also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

This is being issued as per the approval of Competent Authority, DPCC.

Subject: Show Cause Notice u/s 31 (A) of the Air Act, 1981 / u/s 33(A) of Water Act, 1974 / u/s 5 of EP Act (read with Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended to date and Show Cause Notice for Imposing Environmental Compensation.

Whereas, under the provisions of Air & Water Act it is mandatory to obtain valid consent & to comply with the pollution control norms.

Whereas, under the provision of PWM Rules units are required to apply for registration under PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended till date) and to comply with Rule 4(1)(c). Carry bag made of virgin or recyclable plastic, shall not be less than seventy five microns in thickness with effect from the 30th September, 2021 and one hundred and twenty microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.

Whereas, Plastic sheets or like, which is not an integral part of multi-layered packaging and cover made of plastic sheet used for packaging, wrapping the commodity shall not be less than fifty microns in thickness except where the thickness of such plastic sheet impair the functionality of product.

Whereas, the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 (as amended till date) notified by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, to give thrust on plastic waste minimization, source segregation, recycling and to adopt polluter's pay principle for the sustainability of the waste management system, regulatory frame work for management of plastic waste generated in the country.

Whereas, as per DPCC Office order F.No. DPCC/RDPC/EC/2022/3522-3530 dated 30.03.2022 (pl. refer DPCC website), Environmental Compensation shall be imposed on the defaulting units based on the degree of violations.

And whereas, the team of DPCC officials has inspected the premises of the unit Ms. Prem Enterprises between Gate No. 572-60/14 & 572-60/13 (Lat:- 28-785614° Long:- 77-13715°), Bijapur Village, Budhpur, Delhi-36 (hereinafter referred as the addressee) on 21/12/22 and found operating, engaged in the activity of Warehouse/Godown (for storage of plastic sheet/linen) and observations/violations found are as under:-

- Premises is being used as Warehouse/godown for storage and sale of plastic sheet and rolls.
- Plastic packaging material of less than 50 microns, approx. 20 tonnes found in the premises

And whereas, 20 tonnes kg banned plastic material seized in the above said premises and handed over (supadari) to Sh. Alexander Kulkarni representative of the unit present in the premises

Now, therefore, as decided by the Competent Authority in DPCC in exercise of powers conferred upon it under the provisions of aforesaid Acts as amended to date, hereby issue the following proposed directions:

1. That you (the addressee) shall close your unit with immediate effect.
2. That you (the addressee) shall submit an action plan for disposal of above seized banned plastic material through the recycler registered by DPCC.
3. That the concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate shall be directed to ensure effective closure of the said unit.
4. That the concerned authority in Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited (TPDDL) shall be directed to disconnect the electricity/power supply of the said unit with immediate effect.
5. That the concerned authority in DSIIDC shall be directed to disconnect the water supply connection of the said unit.

In view of observations during inspection, and as decided by the Competent Authority in DPCC, as per the principles of natural justice, you (the addressee) are hereby given an opportunity to Show Cause as to why Environmental Compensation of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rs Three Lakhs Only) should not be imposed on you/ your establishment.

Your reply along with full facts and supporting documentary evidence in this regard should reach to this office within 15 days from date of service of this notice, failing which it shall be assumed that you have nothing to say in this regard and directions & EC amount as proposed above will be confirmed without any further reference in this regard and further action will also be initiated as per law. This shall also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

The addressee unit shall ensure that seized plastic material shall not be removed/tempered/ relocate in any manner without obtaining prior permission from DPCC in this regard.

This is being issued as per the decision taken by the Competent Authority, DPCC.
