Subject: Show Cause Notice (SCN) for Closure Directions u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 read with Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date and Show Cause Notice for Environment Compensation-reg.

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board is the State Board for all the Union Territories to exercise powers and perform functions under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended to date.

And whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, in respect of Union Territory of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) Vide Notification dated 15.03.1991.

And whereas, Rule 4 of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date, inter-alia provides that an occupier of a facility shall be responsible for safe and environmentally sound management of hazardous and other wastes generated in the establishment and hazardous and other wastes generated shall be sent or sold to an authorized actual user or shall be disposed of in an authorized disposal facility.

And whereas, as per the rule 6 of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date, every occupier of facility, handling, generation, collection, storage, packaging, transportation, use, treatment, processing, recycling, recovery, pre-processing, co-processing, utilization, offering for sale, transfer or disposal of the hazardous waste and other wastes shall be required to obtain an authorization from State Pollution Control Board (Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC), in case of Delhi).

And whereas, as per the rule 6(5) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as amended to date, every occupier authorized under these rules, shall maintain a record of hazardous and other wastes managed by him in Form 3 and prepare and submit to the State Pollution Control Board/Committee, an annual return containing the details specified in Form 4 on or before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.

And whereas, you, **M/s Vaishnav Enterprises, H-3, Udyog Nagar, Delhi-110041** (hereinafter referred as addressee unit) are operating your unit at the above said address. An inspection was

carried out by DPCC officials at the addressee unit on **06.06.2025** and the following observations were made:

1. The unit was found engaged in the activity of **Printing on Plastic sheets or like used for packing, wrapping the commodity (50 micron) without Burner.**
2. Unit has not taken any appropriate steps w.r.t handling, storage and disposal of hazardous waste as the unit does not have any appropriate/required agreement with Treatment, Storage, Disposal Facility (TSDF).
3. No leak proof storage container was provided for hazardous waste
4. Form-3, Form-4 & Form-10 for hazardous waste management was not maintained.
5. No display board For Hazardous waste related record/information was installed by the unit.
6. Unit have neither obtained consent under 21/22 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 & 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, nor obtained Authorization under Hazardous Waste Management Rules, 2016 from DPCC.

Now therefore, in view of the above, the Competent Authority in DPCC, in exercise of powers conferred upon Delhi Pollution Control Committee, u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 read with Hazardous & Other Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended to date, has proposed to issue the following directions:

1. That you (the addressee) shall **stop the operations and effectively close the unit** with immediate effect.
2. That Environmental Compensation (EC) of **Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only)** shall be imposed upon the addressee for violating Environmental norms.
3. That the concerned authority in BSES shall **disconnect the electricity supply** to the addressee unit with immediate effect.
4. That the concerned authority in DJB shall **disconnect the water supply** to the addressee unit with immediate effect.
5. That the concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) shall take necessary action to ensure the **effective closure of the addressee unit** with immediate effect.

Hence, by way of this notice, you are hereby issued this **Show Cause Notice (SCN)** as to why the aforesaid proposed directions should not be confirmed upon the addressee unit. Your reply should reach this office within 15 days from date of service of this notice, failing which it shall be assumed that you have nothing to say in this regard and the Competent Authority of DPCC shall initiate action as proposed above. This may also be treated as an opportunity of being heard.

This is being issued with the approval of the Competent Authority, DPCC.
