

Minutes of the 17th meeting of the Committee Constituted for Deciding the Consent under orange Category, held on 11.09.2007 in the Conference Room of Chairman, DPCC.

17th meeting of the Committee constituted for deciding the Consent (under orange Category) was held on 11.09.2007 and following decisions were taken in the meeting ;

Agenda 1 -In cases of Special reference / Miscellaneous cases (8 No.), decision taken is at **Annexure-I**

Agenda 2 – Regarding empanelment of laboratories by DPCC , the report of the Committee constituted for the empanelment of the laboratories was placed before the Committee and after detailed discussions in each case , the committee decided to empanel following laboratories in addition to the existing empanelled laboratories with certain terms & conditions;

- (i) National Physical Laboratory (NPL)
- (ii) National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI) Laboratory at Delhi.
- (iii) Shri Ram Institute of Industrial Research Laboratory –the laboratory will procure aluminums block COD digester and CO, HC analyzer (ARAI approved) within six weeks.

It was also decided that validity period of the following four existing empanelled laboratories i.e.

- (i) Guru Gobind Indrprastha University,
School of Environment Management Delhi
- (ii) National Productivity Council
Environmental Laboratory, Delhi
- (iii) Pollution Control & Biogas Laboratory, IIT Delhi
- (iv) Delhi College of Engineering
Environmental Engineering Laboratory, Delhi

and the aforementioned three new empanelled laboratories will be till 31.03.2009 and a public notice be issued by DPCC laboratory in this regard .

Agenda 3 – 9 High Court Cases, of Wazirpur Ind. Area(6 cases), Rajasthani Udyog Nagar Indl Area (1 case) , SMA Industrial Area (1 case) and SSI Industrial areas (1 case) were taken up by the Committee . It was informed to the

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Committee that Court Orders were available in case of four units & were placed before the Committee. After detailed discussions in each case decision were taken and are given at **Annexure II.**

Agenda 4- Cases of 10 units of Wazirpur Industrial Area which have submitted Bank Guarantees earlier w.r.t decisions taken by the Committee on 29.01.2007, were discussed and the inspection reports of the Committee for Wazirpur Industrial Area, which inspected these units, as decided by the Committee in its meeting on 05.07.2007, were placed before the Committee. Sh. M. Dwarakanath, SSO, Deptt of Env., GNCTD who inspected these units alongwith Mrs. Ajeeta Aggarwal, EE, DPCC, briefed the observations made by the team during the inspections. After detailed discussions decisions were taken in each case and are given at **Annexure III.**

Agenda 5 - Remaining cases of the inspections (of 64 units) carried out by the Committee for Wazirpur Ind. Area after the meeting on 05.07.2007 and 14 cases of units inspected by the said Committee w.r.t list provided by MCD could not be discussed on 11.09.2007 and it was decided that these cases shall be taken up by the Committee in its next meeting scheduled to be held on 17.09.2007 at 6.00 PM.

Agenda 6 – 5 Cases of PGRC were discussed in the meeting and decision taken by the Committee are at **Annexure IV**

Agenda 7 – Regarding representation from Keshav Puram industrial Area CETP Society for units operating without consent, it was decided that PGRC shall issue Show Cause Notice to the units (from the list provided by the said CETP Society) which have not applied for the Consent under the Air & Water Acts, to apply for Consent to establish to DPCC. Show Cause Notice is also to be issued to the units which have not applied for renewal of the consent after the expiry of the earlier granted consent. The matter will be taken up in the meeting of the Committee on 19.09.2007.

Agenda 8 – Regarding amendments to be made in the consent application proforma in view of the decisions taken w.r.t. consent fees, seeking consent to establish application etc., it was decided to be processed on file first with justification and then brought to CMC (Orange) by the Enquiry Counter.

Agenda 9 – Consent to establish cases were placed before the Committee in chronological order, however the Committee could not take up these cases due to paucity of time and it was decided to take up these cases in the meeting of the Committee on 20.09.2007.

Agenda 10 – Regarding amendments in the categorization of activities in view of negative list in MPD 2021, it was decided that matter must be carefully examined with Status Note on the file and then to be put up before the Committee (CMC – Orange).
