by Chairman, DPCC, for deciding applications of Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Waste Rules, for the cases of Orange Category of Industries / Units [Category 2(c)], held on 19.08.2015, in the conference room of Chairman, DPCC, at Delhi Secretariat, IP Estate, Delhi.

Attendance Sheet is enclosed.

Prof. S.K. Gupta & Prof. A.K. Nema of IIT Delhi, could not attend the meeting since they were preoccupied in some urgent work.

Vide Office Order dated 22.09.2014 a Committee headed by Chairman, DPCC, has been constituted to decide 2(c) category cases [Consent and Authorization of Orange Category units].

12<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the aforementioned Committee was held on 19.08.2015 in respect of pending cases of CMC III upto 31.05.2015 and decisions were taken online.

Following are the Minutes of the Meeting:-

Agenda Item No 1: Pending Consent to Establish cases of CMC III under Orange Category upto 31.05.2015 (07 Cases).

Decisions were taken online in 06 cases and software generated list including decisions taken in these cases are at Annexure I.

One Case of M/s S.S. Silverstar Accessories Pvt. Ltd., BA-93, Phase-II, Mangolpuri Industrial Area, New Delhi (ID No. 29697 CTE Dated 28.04.2009) engaged in the activity of Manufacturing of Accessories of the Footwear, could not be taken up for online decision and therefore this case was taken up by the Committee offline. Committee decided to ask the unit to submit either copy of permission for extraction / drawl of ground water from Delhi Jal Board / CGWA or submit evidence along with photographs of discontinuation / sealing of borewell (both prior and after sealing) within one month with copy to Dy. Commissioner (Revenue). Failure to do so, consent shall be refused and concerned Dy. Commissioner shall be asked to take necessary action w.r.t. Notification dated 12.07.2010 for ground water.

Agenda Item No 2: Pending Consent to Operate / Renewal cases of CMC III under Orange Category upto 31.05.2015 (27 Cases).

Decisions were taken online in individual cases and software generated list including decisions taken in these cases are at Annexure II.

One Case of M/s Bagga Link Service Ltd., G.F., 1141/2, Rithala, Delhi (ID No. 9395 CTO Dated 10.11.2014) engaged in the activity of Service Station of Bikes, could not be taken up for online decision and therefore this case was taken up by the Committee offline. Committee decided to put up file administratively.

Since decisions are taken online in individual cases by the Committee and tabular list is generated through software including decisions taken in each case, there is no need of signature of the members of the Committee on such lists. The concerned Ceil may take necessary action w.r.t. decisions taken without waiting for the minutes of the meeting.

If there is any case left out of the aforementioned period, the same shall be put up administratively for further necessary action.

**Table Agenda No 1:- Case of M/s A.P.S. Enterprises Pvt. Ltd., Kh. No 43, Plot No 2-4, New Mandoli Redevelopment Area, Delhi (ID No. 7089 CTO Dated 04.03.2014) engaged in the activity of Aluminium Wire Rod Drawing (without Pickling and Galvanizing).**

The case was taken up by the Committee as decided in the concerned file. As per the report of the Joint inspection Team consisting of officials of DPCC & DSIIDC which conducted inspection of the site of the unit on 12.08.2015. " Said Premises may be considered within the boundaries of New Mandoli Re-development Industrial Area ", the Committee reviewed its earlier decision taken in the meeting on 05.08.2015 regarding issuance of Show Cause Notice for Refusal of Consent and for Closure of Unit and decided to grant Consent to Operate.

**Table Agenda No 2:- Case of M/s T.R. Sawhney Motors Pvt. Ltd., East Gokulpur, Main Wazirabad Road, Delhi (ID No. 8621 CTE Dated 30.07.2014) engaged in the activity of Service Station (Washing, Repairing, Denting & Painting of Cars).**

The case was taken up by the Committee as decided in the concerned file. Matter was discussed and it was informed that the existence of the unit is prior to 01.08.1990. The unit submitted a letter on 04.09.2014 informing that Committee headed by Commissioner of Industries, Govt. of Delhi vide order dated 30.11.2007 decided that area SDM may be directed that the premises of the unit may be de-sealed and may be allowed to continue present activity at the given address. The unit has also informed that as per MPD -2021, at para 15.6.2. " Automobile repair & workshops are allowed in non conforming area on roads of width of 30 meters and above" and said workshop is on main road which is more than 60 meter wide.

The said unit is having provisional License from East Delhi Municipal Corporation ( EDMC) generated on 27.06.2014 valid upto 25.09.2014 for the activity of Automobile workshop for servicing and repair of automobiles and informed that it will submit Permanent License from EDMC after submitting Consent to Establish from DPCC.

In the past, a letter was issued to the unit seeking valid MCD license in order to prove its conformity w.r.t. the provisions of Master Plan however no reply was received and therefore Show Cause Notice for refusal of Consent was issued to the unit on 20.02.2015. The unit has submitted its reply w.r.t said Show Cause Notice on 04.03.2015 & 17.03.2015 and stated the aforementioned things.

The matter was discussed and the Committee decided that a letter be issued to EDMC seeking clarification regarding conformity of the unit w.r.t. MPD-2021 mentioning that if EDMC does not respond / clarify on the aforementioned issue, Consent to Establish shall be granted to the unit.

**Table Agenda No 3 :- Case of M/s Competent Automobiles Company Limited, 895/C-8, Near Jain Mandir Dadabari, Mehrauli, New Delhi-110030 (ID No. 8607 CTE Dated 28.07.2014) engaged in the activity of Repair and Services of Vehicles.**

The case was taken up by the Committee as decided in the concerned file. Matter was discussed and it was informed that the existence of the unit is prior to 01.08.1990. Adhoc License was issued to the unit by MCD in July, 1990 mentioning on the said License " Non Conforming Area " for Service and Repair of Maruti Car.

Earlier Show Cause Notice u/s 33(A) of the Water Act and u/s 31(A) of the Air Act were issued to the unit 21.07.2014 after the inspection 20.06.2014 W.R.T RTI related to said unit. A letter was also issued to Commissioner (MCD) (South) on 21.07.2014 to take necessary action against the unit. Show Cause Notice was issued to the unit by the South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) on 04.08.2014 with the directions to stop running trade / industrial activity i.e. residential purpose only as the MPD-2021 and for sealing of the said premises. The unit had gone to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi which ordered that representative of the petitioner to appear before the Dy. Commissioner ( South Zone) on 25.08.2014 however till the proceedings are disposed of, the directions given in the impugned notice dated 04.08.2014 shall not be given effect to.

In view of the above and as decided earlier, DPCC had issued letter to the unit on 17.10.2014 asking the unit to submit valid MCD license in order to prove its conformity w.r.t. the provisions of Master plan within 30 days however no reply has been received from the unit. Thereafter a letter was issued to Commissioner (MCD) (South) on 10.02.2015 referring the earlier letter of DPCC, said Notice of SDMC & said High Court Order with request to sent the comments and inform about the latest position in the said High Court case and also about status of MCD License in respect of the said Unit. Copy of the said letter was also sent to the unit. However no reply from SDMC & Unit has been received so far.

Order of Hon'ble High Court Dated 20.08.2014 in the matter of M/s Competent Automobiles Company Limited Vs. South Delhi Municipal Corporation was searched online and the same was perused during the meeting.

As per the said order, " Present writ petition and application are disposed of with a direction that the impugned order dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 be treated as a show cause notice. Learned counsel for respondent-Corporation states that documents referred to and relied upon in the Notice dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 shall be furnished to the petitioner within two working days. Petitioner is granted two weeks to file a reply affidavit and the Deputy Commissioner, South Zone, SDMC, is directed to dispose of the said notice after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. To obviate the need for any notice, a representative of the petitioner is directed to appear before the Deputy Commissioner, South Zone, SDMC on 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at 4.00 p.m. However, till the proceedings are disposed of, the directions given in the impugned notice dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 shall not be given effect to.

Accordingly, the application stands disposed of."

After discussions the Committee decided that another letter be issued to the Unit seeking copy of valid MCD license in order to prove its conformity w.r.t. the provisions of Master plan within 30 and SDMC be again asked to inform about the latest position in the said High Court case & valid MCD License, if any issued to the unit. The SDMC be also requested to inform about the Conformity of the Unit w.r.t MPD -2021.

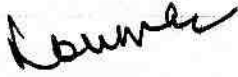

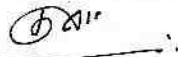
Table Agenda No 4:- Case of M/s Rajender Da Dhaba, AB-9, Shop No 1 and 2, DDA Market, Safdarjung Enclave, New Delhi-29 (ID No. 10706 CTO Dated 05.05.2015) engaged in the activity of Restaurant.

The case was taken up by the Committee as decided in the concerned file. Earlier Directions u/s 31 (A) of Air Act & u/s 33(A) of Water Act were issued to the unit on 29.01.2015 and temporarily revoked for 45 days vide letter dated 23.02.2015. Unit has submitted Adequacy report of ETP issued by M/s Jamia Millia Islamia University and also submitted valid MCD & Delhi Police licenses (valid upto 31.03.2016). The Committee decided to revoke the said Directions u/s 31 (A) of Air Act & u/s 33(A) of Water Act, issued to the unit on 29.01.2015 and granted Consent to Operate.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
