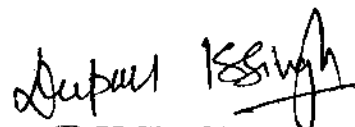

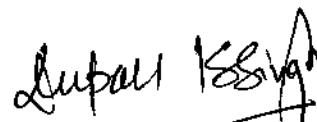

Consent Management Cell- II**

Minutes of the 1st Meeting of the Committee for II (b) category cases, headed by Member Secretary, DPCC and constituted vide office order dated 12.04.2016, for deciding Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Waste Rules, held on 06.05.2016, in the conference room of Chairman, DPCC, at Delhi Secretariat, IP Estate, Delhi.

Attendance Sheet is enclosed as Annexure "A".

Vide Office Order dated 12.04.2016 a Committee headed by Member Secretary, DPCC, has been constituted to decide II (b) category cases [Consent and Authorization of Orange Category units].

1st Meeting of the said Committee was held on 06.05.2016 for the cases of Hotels & Restaurants of Mahipalpur Area.

Following are the Minutes of the Meeting:-

Agenda Item No 1: Cases of Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate of Hotels & Restaurants of Mahipalpur Area

The cases were briefed by the officials of concerned CMC-IV .

Minutes of the 14th meeting {2(c) category} held on 15.03.2016 in respect of Hotels & Restaurants of Mahipalpur, were shown to the and it was decided to take decisions on the same line as done in the meeting held on 15.03.2016.

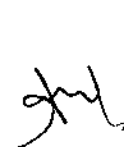
It was also apprised to the Committee, that the name and address of the hotels/Restaurants/Eating Houses in Mahipalpur and adjoining areas, were received in two phases in DPCC. The details in this regard are as follows :

A. Initially an appeal was filed in Hon'ble national Green Tribunal bearing no.1 of 2015 in the matter of Taurus International (projects) Pvt. Ltd., Vs Delhi Pollution Control Committee. In this case, Hon'ble NGT has directed to inspect all the restaurants/guest houses/hotels operating in Mahipalpur and adjoining areas and during inspection, it was found that 80 numbers of restaurants/guest houses/hotels were in operation and actions were taken accordingly.

The decisions taken in the 14th meeting {2(c) category} held on 15.03.2016 in case of 80 restaurants/guest houses/hotels are reproduced as follows:

- 18 nos. units which fulfil the eligibility conditions under the law administrated by DPCC, including possessing the permission to extract ground water/have DJB water connection bill are granted to Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate.
- 02 units which ,apart from fulfilling other eligibility conditions have deposited requisite amount for regular water connection with Delhi Jal Board, are granted provisional consent for six months with the conditions that unit will either submit the permission for extraction of ground water from Central Ground Water Authority or valid bill of water connection from DJB.
- 14 units have been reported closed. A re-verification may be done and their present activity should be ascertained.
- The other remaining units (46 nos.) which have not submitted the requisite documents be given joint personal hearing.

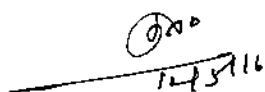
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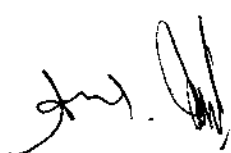
As per decision taken in the said meeting on 15.03.2016, a joint personal hearing was also given to 46 nos. restaurants/guest houses/hotels on 26.04.2016 and all the unit's owners were requested to submit the required documents by 08.05.2016. Out of these 46 restaurants/guest houses/hotels, 13 nos. restaurants/guest houses/hotels, have not submitted the required documents.

In respect of these 46 restaurants/guest houses/hotels the following decisions were taken :

1. The two (02) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, who have submitted regular water connection bill of Delhi Jal Board in addition to other required documents, are granted to Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate. The list of these two units(02) is annexed as **Annexure-I**.
2. The two (02) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, who have submitted regular water connection bill of Delhi Jal Board in addition to other required documents, but have not installed Effluent Treatment Plant/ Sewage Treatment Plant as per decisions taken in 61st DPCC board meeting held on 22.03.2016, are granted provisional consent to Operate for two months to install Effluent Treatment plants/Sewage Treatment Plants within two months, failing which necessary action as per law shall be taken against these two units. The list of these two (02) units is annexed as **Annexure-II**.
3. The twenty three (23) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, who have submitted the receipt of water cess with respect to usage of water for the said activity in addition to other required documents, provisional consent to operate may be granted for six months with the conditions that unit will either submit the permission for extraction of ground water from Central Ground Water Authority or valid bill of water connection from DJB. The list of these twenty three (23) units is annexed as **Annexure-III**.
4. The six (06) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, who have submitted the receipt of water cess with respect to usage of water for the said activity in addition to other required documents, but have not installed Effluent Treatment Plant/ Sewage Treatment Plant as per decisions taken in 61st DPCC board meeting held on 22.03.2016, are granted provisional consent to Operate for two months to install Effluent Treatment plants/Sewage Treatment Plants within two months, failing which necessary action as per law shall be taken against these two units. The list of these six (06) units is annexed as **Annexure-IV**.
5. The nine (09) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, who have not submitted the requisite documents which were to be filed with the application for Consent to Establish and Consent Operate including permission of ground water extraction or regular DJB water connection bill/water cess receipt, a letter may be sent to all these nine restaurants/guest houses/hotels, to submit the required documents within 10 days of the issue of the letter, failing which necessary action as per law shall be taken including closure of the unit. The list of these nine units is annexed as **Annexure-V**.
6. The four (04) numbers of restaurants/guest houses/hotels, to whom closure directions were sent on 05.05.2015 and 07.05.2015, but till date no compliance is received from the concerned agencies i.e. SDM, BSES and DJB, a letter be sent to the concerned SDM, BSES and DJB, to submit the action taken report within 15 days. Among these 4 units, one unit namely M/s. Hotel Airport Breeze, decisions has already been taken in the meeting held on 15.03.2016. The list of these 04 restaurants/guest houses/hotels, is annexed as **Annexure-VI**.
7. Apart from above, Consent Management Committee was also apprised that in the meeting held on 15.03.2016, decision of grant of Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate, taken in respect of one(01) hotel namely M/s. Good Luck, A-103, Road no.4, Mahipalpur Extension, New Delhi - 37, needs to be reviewed as this hotel has not submitted the valid permission for extraction of ground water/regular water connection bill of DJB and also not installed ETP/STP. In this case, provisional consent is granted for two months to install Effluent Treatment Plant/ Sewage Treatment Plant as per decisions taken in 61st DPCC board meeting held on 22.03.2016 and will either submit the permission for extraction of ground water from Central Ground Water Authority or valid bill of water connection from DJB.

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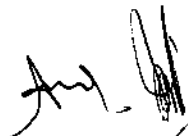

B. In the second phase, a list of thirty six (36) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, was also sent by Delhi Police and Sakshi Bindra. In this case action was initiated **against 24 restaurants /guest houses/hotels only** and the action was taken in the concerned file by putting administratively. In the file, it was directed by Chairman-cum-Member Secretary, DPCC, that decisions taken in the file be ratified in the meeting of Consent Management Committee. The following decisions taken in the concerned file are reproduced for ratification:

- i. Four (04) restaurants/guest houses/hotels namely (i). M/s. Anshuman Guest House, (ii) M/s. Solti Guest House, (iii) M/s. Yes International Guest house/Hotel Welcome/Lovely, (iv). M/s. Hotel Gaurav Continental, directions for closure were sent to all these four (04) restaurants/guest houses/hotels on 04.11.2015 and action taken report from the concerned officials are yet to be received. The list of these four restaurants/guest houses/hotels is annexed as **Annexure- VII**.
 - ii. Two (02) restaurants/guest houses/hotels namely (i). M/s. Urmil Guest House, (ii). Vasant Guest House, have closed their hotel/restaurants/guest houses and further action against these two restaurants/guest houses/hotels has been stopped. The list of these two restaurants/guest houses/hotels is annexed as **Annexure- VIII**.
 - iii. Five (05) restaurants/guest houses/hotels who have applied for Consent to Establish but did not applied for Consent to Operate till date in spite of modified directions, hence directions for closure under section 33(A) of Water Act and under section 31(A) of Air Act and refusal of consent to Establish may be sent to these five units. The list of these five (05) restaurants/guest houses/hotels is annexed as **Annexure- IX**.
 - iv. Five (05) restaurants/guest houses and have applied for consent to establish and consent to operate. Among these 5 restaurants/guest houses, the three (03) restaurants/guest houses have also submitted the DJB water connection bill in addition to other documents, provisional Consent to Operate are granted to these three units, as done in other similar cases of Mahipalpur during CMC meeting held on 15.03.2016. The list of these three units is annexed as **Annexure-X**. In the remaining two (02) restaurants/guest houses/hotels, directions for closure under section 33(A) of Water Act and under section 31(A) of Air Act and refusal of consent to Establish and consent to Operate may be sent to these 2 restaurants/guest houses as these two restaurants/guest houses/hotels have not submitted the valid permission for extraction of ground water/valid water connection bill of DJB. The list of these two restaurants/guest houses/hotels is annexed as **Annexure-XI**.
 - v. Seven (07) restaurants/guest houses have not applied neither for Consent to Establish nor Consent to Operate till date in spite of modified directions, hence directions for closure under section 33(A) of Water Act and under section 31(A) of Air Act may be sent to these 7 restaurants/guest houses. The list of these seven (07) restaurants/guest houses/hotels is annexed as **Annexure-XII**.
 - vi. One (01) guest house which has neither appeared for personal hearing nor applied for consent to Establish and Consent to Operate till date, hence directions for closure under section 33(A) of Water Act and under section 31(A) of Air Act may be sent to this unit. The list of this one (01) guest house is annexed as **Annexure-XIII**.
- C. The Consent Management Committee, have also desired to know about the status of the 15 restaurants/guest houses/hotels existing in the list of 24 restaurants/guest houses/hotels given by Delhi Police and Sakshi Bindra, to whom closure directions under section 33(A) of Water Act and under Section 31(A) of Air Act, were sent on 27.04.2016. In this regard, Consent Management Committee was apprised that these 15 restaurants/guest houses/hotels, have not submitted the required complete documents, which were to be submitted in Delhi Pollution Control Committee. This issue was discussed in detail in the meeting of Consent Management Committee and in view of the discussion, it was decided that the closure direction issued to these 15 restaurants/guest houses/hotels, may be kept in abeyance for two months so that these 15 restaurants/guest houses/hotels, may complete all the formalities and a letter may be sent to submit the required documents within two months.

Table Agenda Item No 1:- 08 Cases which have changed activity from SPI to Non-SPI/ Green Category of CMC-V.

The cases were briefed by the officials of concerned CMC-V and it was informed that these units were issued closure directions as were found engaged in SPI activities (Water Polluting Activities) in Approved Industrial Areas. Subsequently, these units have informed that they have closed water polluting activity and have applied for consent under Green / Orange category which is non water polluting.

Decisions taken by the Committee in respect of these cases are at Annexure-XIV.

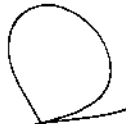
Table Agenda Item No 2:- Cases of Bawana & Narela Industrial Areas to whom revocation of closure directions issued temporarily for 15 days.

The cases were briefed by the officials of concerned CMC-V. As per DSIIDC list, closure directions issued on 24.07.2015 to those units who were not connected to CETP. Subsequently, DSIIDC has informed that units have connected to CETP. These units have also applied for Consent to Establish/Operate. There are 35 cases in Bawana Industrial Area and 19 cases in Narela Industrial Area.

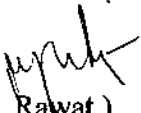
Decisions taken by the Committee in respect of these cases are at Annexure-XV.
