Apart from not applying for authorisation in 1989, the firm has not applied for consent to establish under water Act in 1974. This is highly irregular. However, since DPCC has existing procedure to deal with such application and keeping a PSU in mind, we may issue consent to operate with necessary condonation fee

						and with clear remarks that the reputed organisation like HPCL should follow procedure & apply in time.
