

Minutes of the 22nd meeting of the Committee Constituted for Deciding the Consent under orange Category, held on 28.09.2007 in the Conference Room of Chairman, DPCC.

22nd meeting of the Committee constituted for deciding the Consent (under orange Category) was held on 28.09.2007 and following decisions were taken in the meeting:

Agenda 1- Court cases of WIA/SMA/SSI Ind Area

Out of 20 cases placed before the Committee, six cases could be discussed for want of time and decisions taken are annexed as **Annexure – I.**

Agenda 2- VIP/VVIP cases

All 5 cases were discussed and decisions taken are annexed as **Annexure – II.** Apart from these, a case of M/s Unitec Amusement Park which was to be decided on 27.9.07 was taken up for discussion and decided.

Agenda 3- Cases of Lawrence Road Ind Area

Case of Lawrence road were considered by CMC and despite inspection reports all the files were not available with the concerned EE/AEE of CMC. CMC felt that this was matter of grave seriousness, and shall not be tolerated under any circumstances Concerned EE/AEE must put in all efforts and ensure that the all the case files (27) must be made available to CMC on 11th October, 07 at 5 pm and then only these cases will be taken up in CMC, since the file has to be submitted to CS for his review.

Agenda 4- Cases of WIA wherein inspections were carried out by special Inspection Team

Out of 38 cases placed before the Committee, could take up only 17 cases were discussed and decisions were taken. Left over cases will be taken up on 11.10.07. Decisions taken are tabulated and annexed as **Annexure – III**. It was also decided to take up pending cases of 27.9.07 on 09.10.07.

In all cases of Wazirpur Ind Area, a standard condition of taking individual connection to conveyance system was directed by CMC, which must become part of DPCC directions to the unit without fail.
