Prof. S.K. Gupta and Prof A. K. Nema could not attend the meeting since they were preoccupied in some urgent work.

29th Meeting of the aforementioned Committee was held on 19.08.2015 in respect of pending cases of CMC III upto 31.05.2015.

Following are the Minutes of the Meeting:-

Agenda Item No 1: Pending Consent to Establish cases under Orange Category pertaining to CMC III (01 Case).

Decision was taken online in one Case of **M/s Puri Buildwell Pvt. Ltd.**, C - 9 /13, Sector 7, Rohini, Delhi -85 and Consent to Establish was granted in this case. Software generated sheet in respect of this case is enclosed as Annexure-I.

It was informed by the concerned Engineers of CMC III that there is no pending case of Consent to Operate / Renewal upto 31.05.2015 pertaining to CMC III.

If there is any case left out of the aforementioned period, the same shall be put up administratively for further necessary action.

During the meeting following 4 cases of Stainless Steel Pickling of Wazirpur Industrial Area were also considered in view of Show Cause Notice issued for Revocation/Withdrawal of Consent u/s 27(2) of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and u/s 21(4) of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and cancellation of Authorisation under rule 6 of Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 and for Closure u/s 33(A) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and u/s 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as amended to date on 14.05.2015 :

1. M/s Jay Kay Enterprises, A-127, Wazirpur Industrial Area, Delhi -110052.
2. M/s Sagar Steel, A-14, Wazirpur Industrial Area, Delhi-110052.
3. M/s Kasturi Steel Industries, A-65, Wazirpur Industrial Area, Delhi-110052.
4. M/s Aggarwal Industries, A-95/5, Wazirpur Industrial Area, Delhi-110052.

It was apprised in the meeting that these units were having valid Consent and Authorization from DPCC and Show Cause notices were issued on the ground of using bore well without permission, not taking account of spent acid / acid residue and sludge from pickling bath as per Hazardous Waste Management Rules and the practice of discharging the same in to ETP found in such units of Wazirpur Industrial Area. Subsequently, the units responded informing that they have stopped discharging the spent acid into ETP/started storing the complete Hazardous Waste including spent acid. It was further apprised that on the basis of representations received from the Associations of Wazirpur Industrial Area, a Committee under the chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC was constituted and in its meeting held on 06.07.2015, as per discussion held with the representatives of associations, certain decisions were taken including that the spent acid generated in the individual unit will be stored at CETP Society in a centralized manner and the units have to enter into an agreement for the same after authorization is granted to CETP Society by DPCC for such temporary storage. The aforesaid decisions envisages grant of Consent to the units after fulfillment of requirements indicated in minutes of the said meetings.





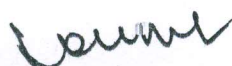
Findings of inspections dated 17.08.2015 in respect of all these four units were deliberated in the meeting and it was observed that ETPs/ECSs were found operational in three units (S.No.1,2,3) and unit mentioned at S.No.4 was found non-operational due to closure directions dated 24.07.2015 issued by DPCC as the unit was listed in the list of defaulter units forwarded by DSIIDC, which were not found connected to CETP. The inspection team further informed that all the four units have started storing the rejected spent acid/acid residues after filtration of spent liquor mixed with bottom sludge and the same was found stored at their premises in PVC containers. However these units are required to improve the containment system in the storage area as the spent acid/ acid residuals is the hazardous waste in liquid/semi-liquid form.

The committee decided that modified directions be issued to units mentioned at S.No.1,2,3 indicating the requirement of appropriate containment system and to submit the point wise compliance/ action taken report w.r.t. the decisions taken on 06.07.2015 in the meeting of the Committee constituted in view of the representations of Industrial Area Association/CETP society, within 30 days. The unit listed at S.No.4 be also informed the minutes of the Committee and requirement of appropriate containment system with the directions not to start its operation in violation of the closure directions issued and to take necessary action for compliance of decision dated 06.07.2015 taken by the committee and for adhering to the requirement of appropriate containment system for storage of spent acid/ acid residues and to submit confirmation from DSIIDC to the effect that discharge of effluent is connected to CETP within 30 days.

Grant of Authorization to Wazirpur CETP Society for Temporary Storage of Spent Acid / Acid Residues

The issue related to grant of Authorization to CETP Society by DPCC for temporary storage of spent acid/ acid residues as an outcome of periodical collection of the same from constituent units was discussed in the meeting and it was acknowledged that the CETP Society has applied for authorization to DPCC under Hazardous Waste Management Rules. As the stainless steel pickling units of Wazirpur Industrial area have been closed by DPCC in mass for want of proper handling and management of spent acid/acid residues as per Hazardous Waste Management Rules, 2008 and a Committee constituted in view of response from Wazirpur CETP Society and stainless steel pickling and re-rolling association has decided that individual units have to submit the fresh application of authorization and consent along with copy of agreement with CETP society for collection and storage of spent acid from these units. The Committee decided that although the CETP Society is constituted for running the CETP to treat the combined effluent of Industrial Area, however the temporary authorization be granted and issued by WMC-II for collection and storage of spent liquor/spent acid/ acid residue of individual constituent stainless steel pickling units with the condition to provide appropriate containment system centrally at CETP premises, in view of common cause of stainless steel pickling cluster located in Wazirpur Industrial Area.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

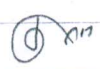
