42nd Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases was held on 09.03.2022 under the Chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC.

Following are the minutes of the meeting along with the decisions taken:-

Agenda Item No 1: Decisions on all complete pending cases upto 08.03.2022

The cases on this agenda were discussed and decided online.

During the meeting, the following decisions were also taken in the meeting:-

- (i) In earlier meetings, IT Cell was asked to prepare a report in OCMMS from which we can get the breakup of the decisions taken during the meeting e.g. issuance of consent, refusal / infructuous of consent application etc. IT Cell has not prepared the report till now. Chairman of the Committee has shown his displeasure and directed that IT Cell shall make provision in the software immediately so that after meeting; we can get the above said desired information. Apart from it, Chairman of the Committee has directed to do the same manually. The gist of the cases considered today's meeting are as follows :-

- (ii) During the meeting, it was apprised to the Chairman of the Committee that DPCC has not issued Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate to the water polluting units in industrial areas having CETPs and hazardous waste generating units in view of order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) dated 20.02.2020 in O.A. No 159/2013 in the matter of All India Lokadhikar Sangathan Vs. GNCTD, in respect of Stainless Steel Pickling units i.e. till establishment of

TSDF and up-gradation of CETP no new industry be permitted in the industrial areas.

Recently, DPCC has issued Consent to Operate under Water / Air Acts and Authorization under HWM Rules, 2016 to M/s Tamil Nadu Waste Monument Limited at Bawana, Delhi on 04.03.2022 for the activity of TSDF.

It was decided to take a legal opinion w.r.t issuance of consent to water polluting units in industrial areas where CETPs exist or does not exist and generation of hazardous waste / issue and place the matter before upcoming II(a) category meeting chaired by Chairman, DPCC.

Till then, Chairman of the Committee has decided to explore with IT cell to block the provision for water polluting industries in industrial / redevelopment areas to apply online in OCMMS.

- (iii) It was informed to the Committee that during the survey of redevelopment areas by M/s Jamia Milia University it was found that some of the units in adjoining residential areas have obtained white category registration certificate through Auto-generation mode. After obtaining the certificate, they have secured electricity connection from BSES and MCD license. Therefore, it was decided that IT cell may work out some check and balance for prohibiting such units to apply for white category Consent certificate. Further, letter be written to BSES to verifying their white category certificate before issuing electricity connection.
- (iv) The Committee decided to grant **Consent to Operate (Renewal)** to the units those are generating incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste with the condition that unit shall make an agreement with the authorized operators for collecting / disposal of incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste. Subsequently, inspection be conducted. Authorization under HWM Rules be kept in abeyance in view of directions of CPCB in certain types of wastes generated.
- (v) During the meeting, it was decided to issue registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 after issuance of Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal) if the documents are found in order.
- (vi) It was decided to put up only complete cases (including inspection findings wherever is applicable as per orders/policies) before the Committee. If any discrepancies found in consent application, the concerned EEs/AEEs of concerned CMCs shall issue the clarification for submission of requisite documents within

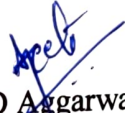
03 days. If unit fails to submit the same, Show Cause Notice shall be issued giving 07 days as a final opportunity. If unit again fails to upload the requisite documents in spite of issuance of clarifications / SCNs, Committee, therefore, decided to refuse all such applications and in case of CTO / CTO (R) and issue Show Cause Notice u/s 33(A) of Water Act and u/s 31(A) of Air Act for operating without consent from DPCC.

- (vii) It was apprised to the Chairman of the Committee that some of the units have applied for Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate / Consent to Operate (Renewal) after imposition of Environmental Compensation (EC). Committee deliberated the issue and it was decided that unit shall deposit Environmental Compensation (EC) and thereafter Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate / Consent to Operate (Renewal) be issued.
- (viii) All CMCs are directed to re-check each and every documents including required consent fee before issuing the Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate / Consent to Operate (Renewal).
- (ix) If any Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate application (s) (for the activity generating hazardous waste / generating trade effluent discharge) in industrial areas has been granted by the Committee inadvertently, the said decision shall be reviewed and the consent application shall be kept in abeyance.

Note:-All CMCs Incharges to ensure that decisions of the Committee are conveyed/consent granted/refused to the unit within 03 days from the date of issuance of this minutes.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

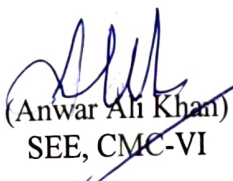
