Sub: Residential Complexes, Phase-I at Dheerpur, Delhi - Environmental Clearance regarding.

Sir,

This has reference to the application filed by you for Environmental Clearance dt. 09-01-2008 under Sub- Section (3) of Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) for the above mentioned project on the above mentioned subject submitted to Member Secretary, State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Delhi.

1. The proposal was put up for consideration by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its meetings held on 29.12.2008, 30.01.2009, 09.10.2009, 29.03.2010, 21.04.2010 & 29.07.2010.
2. A subgroup of SEAC members had also visited the project site on 24.10.2009 and the Committee thereafter had suggested change in land-use pattern for the said project area, for the conservation of existing wetlands and ecological sustainability, to Vice-Chairman DDA vide its letter no. DPCC/MS/SEAC/10/1094 dated 11.05.2010.
3. This was followed by a communication from DDA vide letter no. F.3(34)2002/MP/Pt./260 dated 16.07.2010, wherein the Committee had been informed of the accepted change in land use of Dheerpur project area. The land measuring about 20 ha has been allotted for setting up of Ambedkar University at Dheerpur and area earmarked as wetland (about 25 ha) to be maintained by the University. The Commercial area earmarked in the plan (hotel, N.H., Commercial Centre and C.C) had been retained.
4. In light of the communication received from DDA, the Committee had decided to close the file of the Dheerpur project and decided that any further development activity in the area will require fresh application for Environmental Clearance.
5. In view of above, SEIAA in its 11th meeting held on 25.10.2010 has been decided to close the file and delist the project from the list of pending projects for Environmental Clearance.
