51th Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases was held on 12.04.2023 under the Chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC.

Following decisions were taken:-

Agenda Item No 1: Decisions on all complete pending cases

The cases on this agenda were discussed and decided online.

During the meeting, the following decisions were also taken in the meeting:-

- (i) In the meeting, all complete pending cases were taken up. The gist of the cases considered today's meeting are as follows :-

1	Consent to Establish/ Operate/Operate (Renewal) granted.	198
2	Consent to Establish/ Operate/Operate (Renewal) refused / rejected / infructuous as unit has not submitted the requisite documents within stipulated time.	46
3	Applications for Consent to Establish/ Operate/Operate (Renewal) are kept in abeyance due to water polluting / hazardous waste generating activities etc.	67

- (ii) The committee took the similar decision as taken in earlier meetings to grant CTE/CTO to Strategic importance establishments such as Indian oil, Hindustan petroleum etc., which are hazardous in nature, but kept Hazardous Waste application in abeyance till policy decision on HWM-case.

- (iii) The committee noted that some activities pertaining to Hazardous waste generation have been categorized under green category i.e., 'Manufacturing of Footwear Uppers using Adhesive' and 'Varnish Coating without Furnace'. As these units have potential to generate HW waste and may be considered for categorizing under orange category. The matter may be referred to

- categorization Committee to review categorization of such activities After proper categorization this matter may be put up in the next meeting.
- (iv) The committee has kept some cases in abeyance on which EDC has been imposed till the EDC policy is finalized. Cell incharge put up these cases again with clear recommendation
 - (v) The Committee has not taken up the cases of those units which were either water polluting or generating hazardous waste operating in industrial/ redevelopment areas/CETP upgradation/ non CETP upgradation as per the decision taken in previous meetings.
 - (vi) The Committee decided to grant **Consent to Operate (Renewal)** to the units those are generating incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste with the condition that unit shall make an agreement with the authorized operators for collecting / disposal of incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste. Subsequently, inspection be conducted. Authorization under HWM Rules be kept in abeyance in view of directions of CPCB in certain types of wastes generated.
 - (vii) During the meeting, it was decided to issue registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 after issuance of Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal) if the documents are found in order.
 - (viii) All CMCs are directed to re-check each and every documents including required consent fee before issuing the Consent to Establish /Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal).
 - (ix) If any Consent to Establish/ Consent to Operate application (s) (for the activity generating hazardous waste / generating trade effluent discharge) in industrial areas has been granted by the Committee inadvertently, the said decision shall be reviewed and the consent application shall be kept in abeyance.

Note:-All CMCs Incharges to ensure that decisions of the Committee are conveyed/consent granted/refused to the unit within 03 days from the date of issuance of this minutes.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

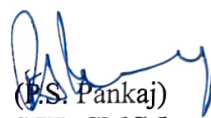

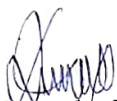

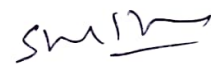
