54th Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases was held on 15.09.2023 under the Chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC.

Following decisions were taken:-

Agenda Item No 1: Decisions on all complete pending cases (as of 14.09.2023)

The cases on this agenda were discussed and decided online.

During the meeting, the following decisions were also taken in the meeting:-

- (i) In the meeting, all complete pending cases were taken up. The gist of the cases considered in today's meeting is as follows:-

- (ii) During the meeting, Chairman of the Committee was informed that out of 237 cases decided for consent in the earlier meeting consent order has been issued in 233 cases

Pending cases list enclosed MS. directed that the decision of the meeting must be implemented immediately. The delay in the implementation of the decision of the meeting shall be viewed seriously. It was decided that agenda-1 of each meeting shall be ATR of the previous meeting.

(iii) The Committee has decided to take up all cases that fall under the RESDH Sector in industrial areas and generating hazardous waste (excluding generation of hazardous waste from water polluting units) as per office order dated 13.07.2023. However, the Committee has not taken up the cases of those units which was water polluting in nature & operating in industrial/ redevelopment areas/CETP upgradation/ non-CETP upgradation as per the decision taken in previous meetings.

(iv) An office order has been issued dated 13.07.2023 to grant CTE/CTO to the industrial units that are hazardous waste generating but not water polluting in nature subject to the condition that they have a valid agreement with TSDF for treatment of hazardous waste. Decision was taken to grant CTE/CTO & HWM authorization to such units.

(v) During the meeting, it was observed that in hazardous waste-generating cases, CMCs have not placed the facts/recommendation w.r.t. authorization application before the Committee. These cases were returned to the concerned cells. The MS directed to all CMCs to include full facts & recommendations w.r.t. authorization application in ATR in all cases put up before the Committee.

(vi) During the meeting, CMC-III has apprised the Committee about the minutes of the meeting chaired by ACS (Industries), Govt. of NCT of Delhi dated 30.08.2023 regarding units operating in Redevelopment Areas of Delhi.

It was decided to keep the applications of redevelopment areas in abeyance till the decision is obtained from the Department of Industries, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. Further, it was discussed with the Industry Dept. officers^{who} apprised that the essence of the minutes was not to permit any polluting unit/ non-confirming unit in redevelopment areas and not allow any unit in non-conforming area as per MPD 2021. It was also told that DSIIDC^{has} started the process of preparation of the redevelopment plan in accordance with Delhi master plan. The decision of cabinet meeting held on 22.08.2023 was also considered. In view of above existing facts and status it was decided that all such applications (redevelopment areas) in which online decisions for kept in abeyance be brought again before the Committee in the next meeting.

(vii) During the meeting, it was decided to issue a registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 after issuance of Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal) if the documents are found in order.

(viii) It was decided to put up only complete cases (including inspection findings wherever is applicable as per orders/policies) before the Committee. If any discrepancies found in consent application, the concerned EEs/AEEs / CMCs shall issue the clarification for submission of requisite documents within 03 days. If unit fails to submit the same, Show Cause Notice shall be issued giving 07 days as a final opportunity. If unit again fails to upload the requisite documents in spite of issuance of clarifications / SCNs, Committee, therefore, decided to refuse all such applications and in case of CTO / CTO (R) and issue Show Cause No33(A) of Water Act and u/s 31(A) of Air Act for operating without consent from DPCC.

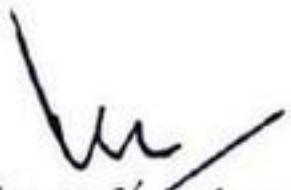
(ix) All CMCs are directed to re-check each and every document including required consent fee before issuing the Consent to Establish /Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal).

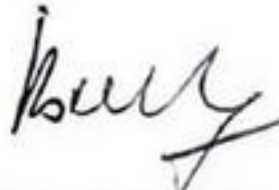
(x) During the meeting, CMC-VI has informed that a decision "Consent to Operate granted" w.r.t. M/s Dalbir Motor, Kh. No 91/25, Mundka Industrial Area, Delhi-110041 (Consent to Operate application dated 08.05.2023) was taken in the last meeting dated 28.07.2023 based on the activity mentioned in the application (Automobile Repair & Servicing (without Washing) and the order was issued. After perusal of consent order it was noticed that under the manufacturing activity "car scrap dismantling center". As on date there is no categorization on a scrap dismantling center and policy decision is awaited on issuance of consent to such units in Delhi. Therefore the Committee reviewed the decision and decided to refuse the consent.

(xi) If any Consent to Establish/ Consent to Operate application (s)/ Authorization (for the activity generating hazardous waste in the absence of proper documents / of any unit generating trade effluent discharge) in industrial areas has been granted by the Committee inadvertently, the said decision shall be reviewed. The consent application shall be kept in abeyance.

Note:- All CMCs Incharges to ensure that decisions of the Committee are conveyed/consent granted/refused to the unit within 03 days from the date of issuance of these minutes.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

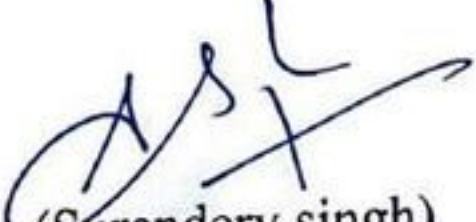
