

55th Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases was held on 24.11.2023 under the Chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC.

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Following decisions were taken:-

Agenda Item No 1: Decisions on all complete pending cases (as of 24.11.2023)

The cases on this agenda were discussed and decided online.

During the meeting, the following decisions were also taken in the meeting:-

- (i) In the meeting, all complete pending cases were taken up. The gist of the cases considered in today's meeting is as follows:-

(ii) The committee has decided all complete cases as per ATR sent by CMCs to the committee. However, the Committee has not taken up the cases of those units which were water polluting in nature & operating in industrial/ redevelopment areas/CETP upgradation/ non-CETP upgradation as per the decision taken in previous meetings. These cases kept in abeyance.

(iii) As per office order dated 13.07.2023 decision was taken to grant CTE/CTO to the eligible industrial units that are hazardous waste generating but not water polluting in nature subject to the condition that they have a valid agreement with TSDF for treatment of hazardous waste. Decision was taken to grant CTE/CTO & HWM authorization to such eligible units.

(iv) During the meeting, it was observed that in hazardous waste-generating cases, CMCs have not placed the facts/recommendation w.r.t. authorization application before the Committee. These cases were returned to the concerned cells. The MS directed to all CMCs to include full facts & recommendations w.r.t. authorization application in ATR in all cases put up before the Committee.

(v) During the meeting, CMC-III has apprised the Committee about the minutes of the meeting chaired by ACS (Industries), Govt. of NCT of Delhi dated 30.08.2023 regarding units operating in Redevelopment Areas of Delhi. It was decided to keep all applications of redevelopment areas in abeyance till the decision is obtained from the Department of Industries, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

(vi) Authorisation under HW Rules be issued in the cases wherein the consent to operate was issued earlier but the application for authorisation is pending. Similar action be taken in the cases where the unit has obtained CTO in auto-renewal route. Before issuing authorisation in such cases, concerned CMC should check the agreement with the TSDF for HW treatment and disposal. Authorisation under HWM Rules be rejected in the cases wherein the application for CTO has been rejected by the II (b) Committee.

(vii) During the meeting, it was decided to issue a registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 after issuance of Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal) if the documents are found in order.

(viii) All CMCs are directed to re-check each and every document including required consent fee before issuing the Consent to Establish /Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal).

(ix) CMC-V has informed the unit namely "M/s A to Z Vehicle Scrap Private Limited Plot No.31, Gali No. 2 Rajasthani Udyog Nagar Industrial Area, Delhi-110033" has applied for consent (CTE & CTO) on 15.12.2022 having application number 8919794 (CTO (new)Orange) & application number 8916247 (CTE(new) Orange) having activity shredding center (can include white goods / other scrap also) /vehicle scrap. In ATR it was inadvertently recommended to grant consent. Based on recommendation the committee has granted consent. However, there is no policy in DPCC regarding grant of consent (CTE & CTO) to vehicle scrap units. A policy note is under submission in this regard and no CTE &

CTO is granted by any CMC. Therefore, the decision to grant CTE/CTO is reviewed and CTE/CTO be rejected.

(x) CMC-II has informed the unit namely M/s T-1 Roadies Private Limited WZ-168, Block A, Najafgarh Road, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi 110059 110020 has applied for Consent to Establish on 09 07.2021 having application no. (CTE 6041879) having activity Automobile Repair and Servicing (without washing). In ATR it was inadvertently mentioned to grant consent. Based on recommendation the committee has granted consent. Now it is known that unit fall in non-confirming area. Therefore consent may be rejected.

Note:- All CMCs Incharges to ensure that decisions of the Committee are conveyed/consent granted/refused to the unit within 03 days from the date of issuance of these minutes.
