



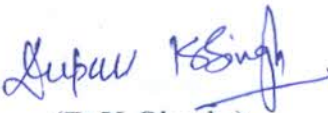

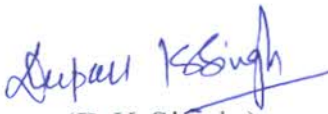

Minutes of the 60th Meeting of Screening Committee for Consent Cases Under Orange Category held on 19.09.2014

Attendance Sheet is enclosed as Annexure "A"

60th Meeting of the Screening Committee for Consent Cases under Orange Category under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Wastes Rules was held on **19.09.2014**.

Consent to Establish & Consent to Operate /Renewal cases of **August , 2014** were to be taken up by the Screening Committee in this meeting however the **Committee could take up cases of Consent to Establish only, due to paucity of time and non working of the Internet and therefore it was decided to take up the cases of Consent to Operate/Renewal of August ,2014 in the next meeting of the Screening Committee.**

Minutes of the said meeting are as follows:-

The Screening Committee segregated the cases under the category 2(b), 2(c) & 2(d) and gave decisions / recommendations in accordance with the office order dated **30.07.2014**.

Agenda Item No.1 : Cases of Consent to Operate /Renewal of the period 01.08.2014 to 31.08.2014 (122 Cases)

- (i) **108 cases** were decided as of 2(b) category and decisions were taken online (Refer **Agenda No 1- Annexure I**).
- (ii) **02 Cases** were recommended as of 2(c) category and recommendations were updated online for further decision to be taken by the Committee for 2(c) category cases headed by Member Secretary, DPCC (Refer **Agenda No 1- Annexure II**).
- (iii) **02 Cases** were recommended as of 2(d) category and recommendations were updated online. These cases are to be placed before the Committee for 2(d) category cases headed by Chairman, DPCC(Refer **Agenda No 1- Annexure III**).

Consent to Operate (Renewal) cases of following 4 units though fall in the chronology in the above mentioned period however were **not entered by the IT Cell of DPCC due to some issues involved and therefore** could not be taken up by the committee in the meeting:

It was decided that IT Cell/ concerned zone to take necessary action w.r.t entry of these cases and put up administratively for further necessary action in these cases.

Agenda Item No. 2: Consent to Operate (Renewal) case of M/s Food World , C-104, Phase -I, Okhla Industrial Area, Delhi -20 (ID No. 8821, CTR Dated 22.08.2014)

This case was taken as separate Agenda Item for off line decision since Effluent Analysis Report submitted by the unit on 11.09.2014 after the receipt of the Consent Application on 22.08.2014 could not be entered by IT Cell since presently there is no provision in the existing software to enter the report of DPCC laboratory (dated 29.08.2014) after receipt of the consent application.

The Committee categorized this case as of 2(b) category and decided to grant Renewal of Consent to Operate.

Agenda Item No. 3: Application for Renewal of Authorization under HWM Rules of M/s Hundred Percent Filling and Service Station, LSC Sector 9, opposite NHAI, Dwarka, Delhi- (ID No. 8694, Dated 07.08.2014)

This case was taken as separate Agenda Item for off line decision since the unit is having valid consent to operate (valid upto 30.07.2018) and have applied for Renewal of Authorization under HWM Rules, on 07.08.2014. In this case it was decided to put file administratively for decision on the Authorization .

Agenda Item No. 4 : Consent to Operate (Renewal) case of M/s S.G. Engineers , H-48, Udyog Nagar Industrial Area, Delhi -41 (ID No. 7082, CTR Dated 04.03.2014)

This case was taken in the meeting of screening Committee as per the remarks of Member Secretary DPCC dated 19.09.2014 on the representation received from the Proprietor of the Unit on 19.09.2014 (Copy of the letter enclosed).

The unit in response to the Show Cause Notice for refusal of Consent issued on 02.06.2014, has submitted a fresh Adequacy Report of Effluent Treatment Plant along with Effluent and Emission Analysis Reports. The Committee categorized this case as of 2(b) category and decided to grant Renewal of Consent to Operate.
