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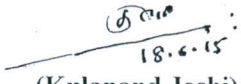

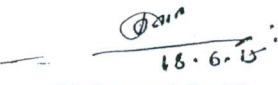

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Minutes of 60th Meeting of DPCC, Held on 16.06.2015 at 4 PM in the Conference Room of Chairman, DPCC, at 6th Level, Delhi Secretariat.

Attendance sheet is at Annexure "A".

Agenda Item No. 1: Action Taken Report of Decisions taken in 59th Meeting on 12.02.2015.

(i) Renovation of DPCC Office at 4th and 5th Floors of ISBT Building, Kashmere Gate, Delhi.

Committee Members were informed that the DTIDC has been requested by DPCC to undertake the renovation work of 4th Floor of DPCC Office located at ISBT Building Kashmere Gate, and provide the modular furniture alongwith fixture. Chairman DPCC suggested that a monthly progress report may be sought from DTIDC so that renovation work is completed in a time bound manner. Information regarding progress to be placed in next DPCC meeting.

(ii) Effluent Standards to be followed by the Hospitals having 50 beds & above.

It was informed to the Committee Members that the meeting of the Committee, constituted earlier to decide the standards could not take place so far. Chairman, DPCC desired that the meeting should be held in the coming week so that the suitable standards and guidelines could be prepared, considering the possibility of reuse of treated effluents depending upon the size / number of beds of the hospitals.

(iii) Levying of Extra Consent Fee for Application under Air & Water Acts.

The committee was informed that as per the decisions taken earlier by the committee in its meeting held on 12.02.2015, the matter was referred to the legal cell for examination. The legal Cell has given a detailed report advising that new rates of fee cannot be applied from retrospective rates. The committee members Confirmed the decision that levying of consent fee for application under Air & Water Act need not be levied from retrospective effect. After detailed deliberation and keeping in view the fact that some unit might have paid the fee from retrospective effect. It was decided that on the principle of natural justice and equity it would be appropriate to return the fee already collected. It was decided that such fee collected in the past be reimbursed within one month and details put up before DPCC in next meeting.

(iv) Engagement of Interns from National Law Universities / Colleges.

Member Secretary, DPCC apprised the Committee Members the purpose of carrying out Third Party Inspections and stated that these inspections shall help DPCC in identifying, at the first instance, the units which are not operating their ETPs/ STPs. The Committee Members appreciated the idea and approved the proposal and terms and conditions given

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in the Agenda with the condition that only Rs 1000 Rupees shall be paid against each inspection including travel expenditure. It was decided that names of the following students engaged along with necessary details shall be placed on the DPCC website. Success of the scheme or otherwise will be put up in the next for meeting review/information

Agenda Item No.2- Consent under the Air & water Acts to Water Polluting Units generating Hazardous Waste.

Member Secretary briefed the Committee Members about the constitution of three committees as per the directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal. The decisions taken by the State Level Committee headed by Secretary Environment were also brought to the kind notice of the Committee Members. Committee Members were informed that as per the directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, a list of Grossly Polluting Industries and Seriously Polluting Industries functioning in Delhi has been prepared by DPCC. Further action is being taken as per the orders of NGT.

Agenda Item No.3- Information regarding grant of Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Public Notices issued by DPCC.

The detailed status in respect of Consent application was presented before the Committee Members. It was also informed that the DPCC has issued Public Notices from time to time for compliance of various Pollution Control Laws. The Committee members appreciated the efforts made by DPCC in implementing the various pollution control measures. Information regarding every quarter to be placed in Board meeting.

Agenda item No:4 (Table Agenda No. 1) Creation of Head of Accounts: Ref-NGT directions.

Member Secretary DPCC informed the Committee Members about the orders passed Hon'ble NGT regarding imposition of penalties in various cases. It was informed that the NGT has imposed penalties against the defaulters for Leaf Burning, Rain Water Harvesting and violation of Water & Air Acts. The details of penalties collected were also brought to the kind notice of Committee members.

The Committee member suggested that a separate bank account may be created in respect of the penalties received by DPCC. Further, the Committee suggested that DPCC may come out with the plans for utilizing the amount for the protection of environment.

Agenda item No:5 (Table Agenda No.2- Status of Audit)

The status of audit for the period 2009-10 to 2013-14 was apprised to the Committee members. The Committee suggested that the audit for financial year 2014-15 may also be completed as per the existing rates. However, the tenders may be finalised in advance carrying out the audit for the financial year 2015-16 so that book writing is completed by June 2016..

Agenda item No:6 (Table Agenda No.3) Ratifying the settlement of Criminal Complaints N.103/6/12 Titled DPCC Vs. M/s. Tiatan Industries Ltd. and Others.

The Committee Members were apprised that the DPCC settled the complaint through mediation in respect of complaint filed by DPCC against M/s Titan Industries Ltd. for an amount Rs. 8, 70,000 though as per the existing policy the amount for settlement was calculated as Rs 6 Lakhs. The higher amount for settlement was claimed by DPCC in this case because the company came to DPCC for settlement only after exhausting all channels of legal remedies.

The DPCC appreciated the move / settlement at higher rate so that a proper message goes to the defaulting units for protection of the Environment.

Agenda item No:7 (Table Agenda No.4) policy of Temporary revocation.

Member Secretary DPCC briefed the Committee Members about the present policy of Temporary Revocation approved by DPCC Board. MS further informed that in appeal No 01 of 2015 titled as "Taurus International (Projects) Pvt. Ltd Vs. Delhi Pollution Control Committee", Hon'ble National Green Tribunal Principal Bench, New Delhi has passed an order on 09.06.2015 whereby the defaulting units located in Mahipalpur Area have been directed to furnish security bond for one year.

DPCC Board approved the agenda item with the condition that closure directions issued to Seriously Pollution Industries (SPI) / Grossly Pollution Industries (GPI) industries Shall not be revoked unless the units meet special conditions stipulated to ensure that no air/water pollution is caused by these units. Consolidated guidelines including the above decision be circulated to all CMCs for effective implementation.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
