This has reference to your application submitted on 30.12.2013 for seeking Environmental Clearance under Environmental Impact Assessment Notification dated 14.09.2006 amended as on date for the project mentioned in the subject above. The proposal was considered in the meetings of SEAC held on 28.07.2015 & 12.12.2015 on the basis of the application & documents submitted by you.

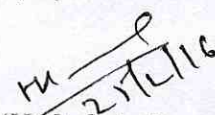
SEAC in its meeting dated 28.07.2015 recommended to delist the project in view of fact that project proponent approached to MOEF&CC, GOI for EC on 20.03.2015 and again on 11.05.2015 and query for shortcoming have been issued and the representative of the project proponent vide their letter dated 27.07.2015 requested not to consider the project for appraisal since they have approached MOEF&CC, GOI & CC as per option available after expiry of the tenure of erstwhile SEAC/SEIAA, Delhi.

SEIAA in its 26th meeting held on 26.10.2015 decided to refer the case back to SEAC for examining the applicability of moratorium due to CEPI at the existing location of this project.

The SEAC in its 74th meeting held on 12.12.2015 recommended that in view of fact that fresh application submitted by the project on 03.11.2015, the old application under consideration be delisted. Regarding CEPI the matter be examined by legal cell, DPCC specifically w.r.t. applicability of CEPI on the project under consideration and who has to deal such application (SEIAA or MoEF&CC) in case CEPI applies.

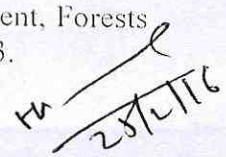
SEIAA in its 28th meeting held on 14.01.2016 took account of the discussions and recommendations of SEAC in its meetings held on 12.12.2015 and decided to approve the recommendations of SEAC.

Now, therefore, above said project is hereby delisted from the list of pending projects for Environmental Clearance with immediate effect.
