76th Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases was held on 08.11.2024 under the Chairmanship of the Member Secretary, DPCC. The attendance sheet of members of the committee who attended the meeting is enclosed as **Annexure - "A"**.

As this was the first meeting of IIb Committee after the issuance of Order dated 18.10.2024, wherein the territorial jurisdiction regarding the processing of consent/ authorization applications was dispensed with, the issues being faced by the CFCs while processing the consent applications belonging to the other areas (other than those in their jurisdiction) were discussed. As of now the consent and authorisation applications are forwarded centrally by the Accounts cell/IT Cell to different CFCs by allotting the cases to the CFCs not having area jurisdiction wrt those applications and therefore the following issues are being faced:

- (i) In case of CTE applications, the status of the case w.r.t. closure/ refusal of previous consent(s)/ EC imposed, if any, is not be known to the CFC processing the CTE.
- (ii) In case of CTO applications, the status of the case w.r.t. grant/ refusal/ pendency of CTE or closure directions/ refusal of previous CTO/ Authorization under HWM Rules/ EC imposed /court case, if any is not known to the CFC processing the CTO.
- (iii) In case of authorization applications under HWM Rules, the status of the case w.r.t. grant/ refusal/ pendency of CTO or closure directions/ refusal of previous CTO/ EC imposed /court case, if any is not known to the CFC processing the CTO.
- (iv) Whether the compilation of data is to be kept by different CFCs as per the area jurisdiction or processing of applications wise or centrally by IT Cell?

As per the office order dated 18.10.2024, RDPC has been entrusted with preparation of SOP on the issues being faced by CFCs w.r.t. the orders. As AD, RDPC was not available in the meeting,. it was decided to refer the above issues to him for finalizing the SOP. However, for processing the applications put up in this meeting, it was decided to proceed with the cases based on the documents submitted by the applicant on OCMMS.

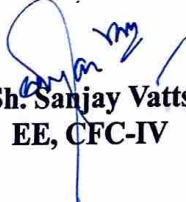
