11. The Board also desired that the annual accounts of DPCC be shifted from cash basis to accrual basis. Road map with timeline for shifting from cash base to accrual-based system of accounting be brought before the Board in next meeting.

**Letter dated 03.01.2026 received from Dr Anil Gupta, Member, DPCC Board was discussed as a table agenda with the permission of the Chair.**

16. Following issues have been raised in the above letter:

**a. Withdrawal of district-wise allocation of CBWTFs:**

The Board was informed that the existing district wise distribution for CBWTFs was done by DPCC vide O.M. dated 24.02.2014 based on the decision of Advisory Committee meeting for BMW held on 18.11.2013, which was subsequently modified vide O. M. dated 15.05.2015 based on decision of Advisory Committee for BMW taken in its meeting held on 11.05.2015.

It was further informed to the Board that based on the decision taken by the BMW Committee in its meeting held on 11.06.2024 regarding removal of area demarcation, a reference was made by DPCC vide letter dated 25.11.2024 to the Chairman of the Advisory Committee for BMW management. The decision of the Advisory Committee is awaited.

**b. Software charges for Barcoding System:**

It has been stated in the aforesaid letter that different charges are being levied for software and Barcode Labels by the agencies engaged by 02 CBWTFs

of Delhi. The Board decided that matter be referred to the Advisory Committee for examination and appropriate decision.

**(Action: WMC-I)**

**c. Joint Survey in Approved Industrial Areas and Issuance of Notices to Units:**

Board took note of the observations and advised concerned officials of DPCC to examine the matter suitably for expeditious redressal of grievances raised by the compliant units by formulating a SOP for the purpose.

**d. Relief to MSMEs from Real Time Emission Monitoring System (RTEMS) and Surveillance Cameras:**

It was informed to the Board during the meeting that OCEMS are being installed in compliance of directions issued by CPCB and any relief in this regard comes in the jurisdiction of CPCB.

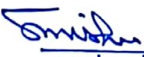
