If there is any case left out of the aforementioned period, the same shall be put up administratively for further necessary action.

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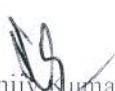

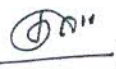
General Decision taken:-

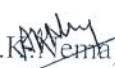
1. In view of the decisions taken by State Level Committee (SLC) headed by Secretary (Environment), Govt. of NCT of Delhi, constituted by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in Original Application No. 196/2014 titled as "Krishna Kant Singh & Anr. Vs National Ganga River Basin Authority & Ors. regarding PIL on pollution of river Ganga and its Tributaries, in its meeting held on **29.04.2015** and further decisions taken in the Meeting of Secretary (Environment) cum Chairman, DPCC on **27.05.2015** w.r.t Original Application No. 300 / 2003 before the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, titled as "Manoj Mishra Vs. Union of India & Others", the Committee decided that :
 - (i) Letter shall be issued to all the Water Polluting Industries in the Industrial Areas where CETP exists however CETP Society has defaulted in installation of the Online Monitoring System (OLMS) regarding closure of the Industry w.e.f 01.07.2015 due to lacking behind of the CETP Society in installation of OLMS by 30.06.2015, as per the Directions of Central Pollution Control Board u/s 18 (1) (b) of Water Act.
 - (ii) DPCC shall take action for closure of the units which are not connected with the Conveyance System of the Industrial Area or not connected with the CETP based on the list of such units provided by DSIIDC / Delhi Jal Board.
 - (iii) Any Unit which is not listed in the list of 493 Seriously Polluting Industries (SPI) prepared by DPCC on the basis of online Consent records of DPCC, shall be treated as illegal and the information received from DSIIDC, DJB and CETP Societies or from other Departments, in this regard shall be used by DPCC for taking necessary action for closure of such Industries / Units.
 - (iv) DPCC shall also inspect all 493 Seriously Polluting Industries (SPIs) and will take action against defaulter units.
 - (v) DPCC shall issue a Public Notice with List of 493 Seriously Polluting Industries (SPI) to obtain information of illegal operation of Seriously Polluting Industries (SPI) in NCT of Delhi.
 - (vi) None of the Water Polluting Industry shall be allowed to operate without Consent of DPCC especially 33 category of Seriously Polluting Industries (SPI) in Approved Industrial Areas / Redevelopment Areas.
2. Cases of Consent Applications received from the Units in Redevelopment Areas were deferred by the Committee and it was decided that Member Secretary, DPCC in consultation with the SEEs of CMCs shall decide the required Documents w.r.t its location within the Boundary of the Redevelopment Areas and proof of Conformity of the unit etc..
3. Cases of Consent Applications received from the Units in Bawana and Narela Industrial Areas shall be checked from the list provided by DSIIDC regarding relocation of the units from Non Conforming areas and thereafter such cases shall be put administratively.
4. List of Units provided by DSIIDC regarding relocation of the units from Non Conforming areas may be used for the purpose of random checking of some of the Water / Air Polluting units.

5. Whenever inspection is carried out and deficiencies are observed the file shall be submitted for issuance of Show Cause Notice etc. within 10 days from the date of inspection.
6. Dr A.K.Nema , Prof IIT Delhi to suggest the Effluent Treatment System for the waste water generated from the Party Lawns /Farm Houses particularly during the occasional huge gatherings/marriages etc.

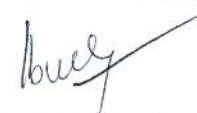

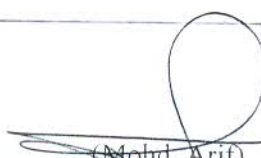

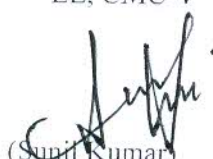
