**Subject: Minutes of 88<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases held on 04.07.2025 & continued on 07.07.2025 under the Chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC.**

88<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II (b) Category Cases was held on 04.07.2025 & continued on 07.07.2025 under the Chairmanship of the Member Secretary, DPCC. The attendance sheet of members of the committee who attended the meeting is enclosed as **Annexure - "A"**.)

As this was the first II-b meeting which was held under the Chairmanship of recently joined Member Secretary, the major decisions taken in the previous II-b meetings was apprised to him. He was also apprised that in view of the decisions taken in most of the pending policy issues viz. Bakery units, water polluting automobile service stations and units in redevelopment areas, the number of consent applications which had been put up for decisions in this committee was greater as compared to the previous ones. The following decisions were taken w.r.t. the processing of consents in II-b meetings henceforth :

1. In the meeting dated 11.02.2025 it was decided to check/demand the registered rent agreement/lease deed for the units applying after 11.02.2025. However, in view of the decision taken in the last II-a meeting dated 08.05.2025 chaired by Chairman, DPCC, it was decided to check this requirement retrospectively. To mitigate the pendency of the long pending consents (which had applied before 11.02.2025) it was decided to grant the consents to the otherwise complete applications units with the condition that the unit shall submit the registered rent agreement/lease deed within 30 days of the issuance of the consent. This condition shall form a part of terms and conditions of the consent order. IT cell shall modify the check list of documents, while applying for consent, on its OCMMS portal accordingly.
2. Till date, after refusal of the consent of a unit, for whatever reason, no further action was taken on the case. As per the pollution control acts, no industrial units in Delhi can function without the consent of the SPCB/PCC. It was, therefore, resulting in functioning of an industrial unit even though its consent has been refused. Therefore, to take the consent/operation to a logical end, it was decided to take the following actions after the consent of a unit has been refused as per the following:
  - a. In case where CTE/CTO of a non-hazardous waste generating unit has been refused the inspection shall be conducted within 30 days of the refusal of the consent.
  - b. In case where CTE of a hazardous waste generating unit has been refused the inspection shall be conducted within 30 days of the refusal of the consent.
  - c. In case where CTO of a hazardous waste generating unit has been refused, the unit shall be directed for disposing of the stored hazardous waste within 30 days and inspection shall be conducted after 30 days but before 60 days of the refusal of the consent.
3. No consent shall be issued in non-conforming areas (except the units under RESDH sector which apply through MHA portal) without checking the permission of the concerned local body/authority for establishment of the unit/activity and without inspecting the unit.
4. All CMCs and EIA cell are required to check the pendency on the dashboard of DPCC at their level regularly and take steps to dispose of the cases within 30 days of their receipt in DPCC.

5. All CMCs and EIA cell to make use of the refusal of the consent template available on OCMMS portal. IT cell is required to change the heading of "Prepare CTO/CTE certificate" to "Prepare CTE/CTO refusal certificate" which should be displayed in cases where refusal has been done.

In this meeting, a total of 161 cases were decided, the status of which is as follows :

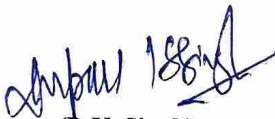
