



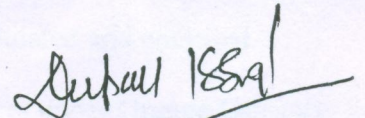

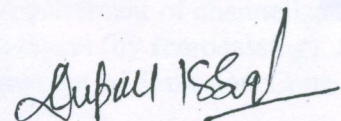

Minutes of the 1st meeting of the Committee constituted vide office order dated 06.03.2012 & headed by Chairman, DPCC, for deciding applications of Consent to Establish / Operate /Renewal under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Wastes Rules, for the cases of 'Orange Category of Potentially Highly Polluting Industries / Units[Category 2(d)], held on 19.04.2012 , in the conference room of Chairman, DPCC , at Delhi Secretariat.

Meeting of the aforementioned Committee was held on 19.04.2012 and following Agenda items, were taken up by the Committee [based on the categorization done(identification of the Category(2 (d) cases) by the Screening Committee for Orange Category Cases, in its earlier meetings held on 26.03.12 / 28.03.12 & 02.04.12.]

Following are the Minutes of the said meeting :-

Agenda Item No 1: Consent to Establish cases under Orange Category [Category 2(d)]w.e.f.06.03.2012 to 15.03.2012 & w.e.f. 05.03.2012 to 01.01.2012 (in reverse chronology)excluding the cases of redevelopment areas (8 Cases).

Decisions taken by the Committee in individual cases of this Agenda are tabulated and enclosed.

Agenda Item No 2: Consent to Operate and Consent to Operate (Renewal)cases under Orange Category [Category 2(d)]w.e.f. 06.03.2012 to 15.03.2012and w.e.f. 05.03.2012 to 01.02.2012 (in reverse chronology)excluding the cases of redevelopment areas (6 Cases).

Decisions taken by the Committee in individual cases of this Agenda are tabulated and enclosed.

Following General decisions were also taken by the Committee:

- (i) Pending Applications for Consent to Operate / Renewal under the Air & Water Acts which have expired the period of three years from the date of application, to be made infructuous by the IT Cell of DPCC, if a fresh consent application has been received from the unit.
- (ii) Pending Applications for Consent to Operate / Renewal under the Air & Water Acts which have expired the period of three years from the date of application , however no fresh consent application has been received from the unit, are also to be made infructuous by the IT Cell of DPCC. However individual letters are to be generated by the IT Cell for issuance to the unit by concerned Consent Management Cell after preparation of the list of such units after scrutiny and after taking approval. These units shall be asked to apply afresh for Consent giving 30 days time.
- (iii) Pending Applications for Authorization under Hazardous Waste Rules received without fee are also to be made infructuous and individual letters to be issued to the unit if not applied afresh to DPCC alongwith requisite fee for authorization.
- (iv) It was observed by the Committee that some cases brought for the meeting , have been categorized by the Screening Committee as of Category 2(d) considering requirement of channelization system and monitoring report for e.g. Electroplating, Plastic Granules /Dana (by reprocessing). Such cases where channelization of emissions is involved without requirement of Emission Control System, are not to be categorized as of Category 2(d) cases.
- (v) It was decided that all cases where Environmental Clearance is required , are to be brought before this Committee irrespective of their categorization .

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
