Minutes of the 1st Meeting of the Committee constituted vide office order dated 22.09.2014 and headed by Chairman, DPCC, for deciding applications of Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Waste Rules, for the cases of Orange Category of Industries / Units [Category 2(c)], held on 05.01.2015 , in the conference room of Chairman, DPCC , at Delhi Secretariat.

Attendance sheet is enclosed.

Vide Office Order dated **22.09.2014** a Committee has been constituted to decide 2(c) category cases [Consent and Authorization of Orange Category units].

1st Meeting of the aforementioned Committee was held on 05.01.2015 and decisions were taken online.

At the outset Chairman was briefed about the cases and it was informed that most of the cases are of Restaurants/Hotels, Automobile Service Stations, Dal/Flour Mills alongwith requirements in such cases .

It was decided that cases shall be decided on general guidelines/ requirements e.g.

- (i) In case of Restaurants/Hotels, Adequacy Report and Effluent Analysis Report for ETP/STP and required licenses (from Local Municipal Authority and Delhi Police).
- (ii) In case of Automobile Service Stations, Adequacy Report and Effluent Analysis Report for ETP and conformity w.r.t. MPD (particularly in case unit is not located in approved industrial area).
- (iii) In case of Dal/Flour Mills, Adequacy Report and Emission / Stack Monitoring Report for ECS.
- (iv) In case of Hazardous Waste Generating Units e.g. Automobile Service Stations and Printing (with Trade Effluent Discharge), the application under Hazardous Waste Rules shall also be decided while granting Consent to Operate/ Consent to Operate (Renewal).
- (v) Regarding units having Borewells /Drawing Ground Water , following decisions taken in earlier meeting of 2(d) category cases held on 31.10.2014 shall be followed :

(a) Consent shall be granted to the units having Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and reusing / recycling the treated effluent with condition that the unit shall comply with the Notification dated 12.07.2010 for ground water and submit permission for extraction/drawl of ground water from Delhi Jal Board / NDMC/ Central Ground Water Authority, within 3 months.

(b) All such units which are extracting / drawing ground water through Borewells however have not submitted the details / permission for extracting / drawing ground water shall be asked to submit details of use/ extraction / drawl of ground water through Borewell(s), if any, and submit copy of permission from Delhi Jal Board / NDMC / Central Ground Water Authority, in this regard within 15 days, failing which Consent shall be refused/revoked and concerned Dy. Commissioner shall be asked to take necessary action w.r.t Notification dated 12.07.2010 for ground water.

Agenda Item No 2: Pending Consent to Operate and Consent to Operate(Renewal) cases under Orange Category pertaining to Consent Management Cell of the Period 01.07.2014 to 20.12.2014

During the meeting it revealed that one case of M/s DCAS JCO Club, A Block Amber Vithi, Defence Colony, Delhi [ID No. 9306 , CTO , Dated 27.10.2014] is figuring twice in the Agenda Item No. 2 and therefore it was decided that IT Cell be asked to delete the duplicate entry .

Online Decisions taken in 203 cases are at Annexure II.

Wherever inspection has been decided in this meeting, the same shall be conducted by the concerned Cell within 15 days.

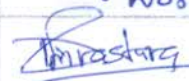
Case of M/s Autowise Service Station, PP-38 A, Gali No. 10, Anand Parbat Industrial Area, Delhi -05 [ID No. 8468 , CTR , Dated 16.07.2014 , Activity – Servicing of Vehicles (with washing)] though falls in the chronology in said period however was not figuring in the Agenda Item No. 2 due to some software problem and therefore this case was decided offline and it was decided by the Committee to grant renewal of Consent to Operate under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous Waste Rules for one year period, to this Unit.

Following General Decisions were taken by the Committee :

1. DPCC shall not ask for the affidavit along with Applications for Consent under Air & Water Act, Authorization under HWM Rules etc. w.e.f. the issuance of these minutes. In lieu of Affidavit, the industries / units shall be asked to submit an undertaking with the statements as were given in the affidavit. Enquiry Counter/IT Cell of DPCC to take immediate necessary action in this regard.
2. Considering the present scenario of empanelment of consultant for issuance adequacy report for ETP/STP/ECS and delay in getting adequacy report, it was decided that in future, Enquiry Counter of DPCC shall accept consent application of the unit without insisting for adequacy report, however, in such cases unit shall be asked to submit receipt of the deposition of requisite fee to the empanelled consultant and an undertaking that adequacy report shall be submitted within 06 months from the date of submission of consent application. This shall be applicable till the streamlining of the mechanism for adequacy report/ empanelled consultant. Enquiry Counter/IT Cell of DPCC to take immediate necessary action in this regard.
3. Effluent / Emission/Stack /Noise Monitoring Report of approved laboratories of DPCC submitted by the units shall be valid for 06 months period from the date of issuance of the report. Enquiry Counter/IT Cell of DPCC to take immediate necessary action in this regard.
4. While granting consent to the industries / units, condition shall be imposed that unit shall submit Effluent / Emission/Stack Monitoring Report of approved laboratories of DPCC, on annual basis from the date of issue of the consent.
5. In case of Redevelopment Areas , Authorization under HWM Rules shall be granted for one year period since as per DPCC policy consent is to be granted for one year and therefore fee for Authorization shall be charged for one year only (i.e. Rs 2000). Enquiry Counter/IT Cell of DPCC to take immediate necessary action in this regard.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
