



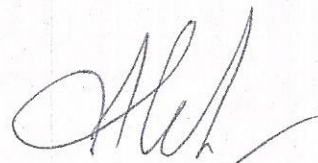

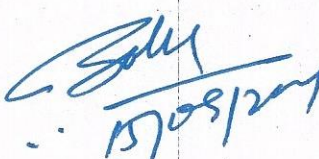

**Minutes of the 36<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases**  
**held on 04.08.2021**

Attendance Sheet for meeting on 04.08.2021 is enclosed as Annexure - A.

Following are the minutes of the meeting along with the decisions taken:-

**Agenda Item No 1: All Complete pending cases upto 03.08.2021**

The cases of this agenda were decided online. If any Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate application (s) (for the activity generating hazardous waste / generating trade effluent discharge) has been granted by the Committee inadvertently, the said decision shall be reviewed and the consent application shall be kept in abeyance.

Apart from the above, the following cases were put up administratively and decision taken on file w.r.t. refusal of consent application (s) of the said units ratified in this meeting:-

- (i) M/s Harbansh Lal Dairy Farm, B-430, 31, Gharoli Dairy Farm, Mayur Vihar, Phase-III, New Delhi-110096
- (ii) M/s Hargulal Dairy Farm, B-269, 270, Gharoli Dairy Farm, Mayur Vihar, Phase-III, New Delhi-110096
- (iii) M/s Harbansh Lal Dairy Farm, B-451, 452, Gharoli Dairy Farm, Mayur Vihar, Phase-III, New Delhi-110096
- (iv) M/s Bhopal Dairy Farm, B-379, 380, 381, Gharoli Dairy Farm, Mayur Vihar, Phase-III, New Delhi-110096
- (v) M/s Kiran Dairy Farm, B-382, 383, 384, 385, 386, Gharoli Dairy Farm, Mayur Vihar, New Delhi-110096

During the meeting, the following decisions were also taken in the meeting:-

- (i) During the meeting, directions dated 02.07.2021 was discussed. Vide the said directions; the DG sets of capacity 125 KVA and more are required to retrofit with the



suitable pollution control system(s) to reduce Particulate Matter or to convert to PNG mode fuel.

It was decided to incorporate the following condition while issuing consent:-

“ In case the consentee unit has any D.G. Set with a capacity of 125 KVA or more, it shall comply with the directions issued by DPCC on 02.07.2021. The DG set(s) are required to be retrofitted with the suitable pollution control system(s) to reduce Particulate Matter or to convert to PNG mode fuel”

- (ii) During the meeting, it was apprised that units engaged in the activity of white category operating in industrial areas / redevelopment areas get the consent automatically by the online software, however, the units applying outside the industrial / redevelopment areas show in the portal of concerned CMC Incharge. There is no office order in this regard, therefore, file be put up administratively by CMC-VI with clear SOP for considering such type of cases for issuance of an office order.
- (iii) In case where Consent to Operate has been issued / approved but Consent to Establish has not been considered, in such cases, Committee decided to issue Consent to Establish.
- (iv) In case of hazardous waste generating units, it was decided to keep these cases in abeyance till the TSDF facility in Delhi gets CTO from DPCC. SEE, WMC-II was also consulted and it was told by him that the facility is likely to be operationalized soon.
- (v) In case of water polluting units, it was unanimously decided to keep these cases also in abeyance till the decision on advice of advocate in CETP up-gradation matter is taken.



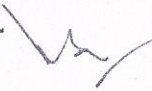
- (vi) Since inspections of the hazardous waste generating unit(s) could not be conducted in time bound manner due to which decision on such applications are pending in want of inspection. Therefore, committee decided to grant **Consent to Operate (Renewal)** to the units those are generating incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste with the condition that unit shall make an agreement with the authorized operators for collecting / disposal of incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste. Subsequently, inspection be conducted. Authorization under HWM Rules be kept in abeyance in view of directions of CPCB in certain types of wastes generated.
- (vii) During the meeting, it was decided to issue registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 after issuance of Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal) if the documents are found in order.
- (viii) It was decided to put up only complete cases (including inspection findings wherever is applicable as per orders/policies) before the Committee. If any discrepancies found in consent application, the concerned EEs/AEEs of concerned CMCs shall issue the clarification for submission of requisite documents within 03 days. If unit fails to submit the same, Show Cause Notice shall be issued giving 07 days as a final opportunity. If unit again fails to upload the requisite documents in spite of issuance of clarifications / SCNs, Committee, therefore, decided to refuse all such applications and in case of CTO / CTO (R) and issue Show Cause Notice u/s 33(A) of Water Act and u/s 31(A) of Air Act for operating without consent from DPCC.
- (ix) It was apprised to the Chairman of the Committee that some of the units have applied for Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate / Consent to Operate (Renewal) after imposition of Environmental Compensation (EC). Committee deliberated the issue and it was decided that unit shall deposit Environmental Compensation (EC) and thereafter Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate / Consent to Operate (Renewal) be issued.
- (x) It was observed that in some of the cases, ATR was not prepared properly and concerned Cell did not provide its recommendations. Chairman of the Committee directed that the concerned Cell will prepare ATR and give clear recommendations.

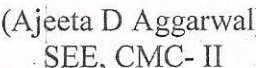


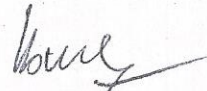

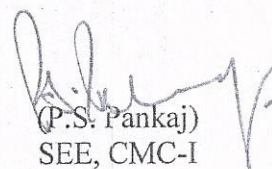
The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

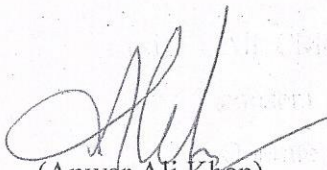
