**Minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases**

**held on 13.12.2018 & 27.12.2018**

Minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases (activities / process other than those falling under clause II(a) as per Office Order Dated 31.05.2017) headed by Member Secretary DPCC, for deciding the Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 / Registration under the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, held on 13.12.2018 and 27.12.2018 in the Conference Room of Chairman, DPCC at Delhi Secretariat, New Delhi-110002.

As per Office Order Dated 31.05.2017, Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 / Registration under the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 of the cases falling under Category II(b) [activities / process other than those falling under clause II(a) of the said order] are to be decided by the Committee headed by Member Secretary, DPCC and consisting of all SEEs & EEs of the concerned Cell.

Attendance Sheet for meeting on 13.12.2018 and 27.12.2018 are enclosed as Annexure "A" & "B" respectively.

Following are the Minutes of the Meetings:-

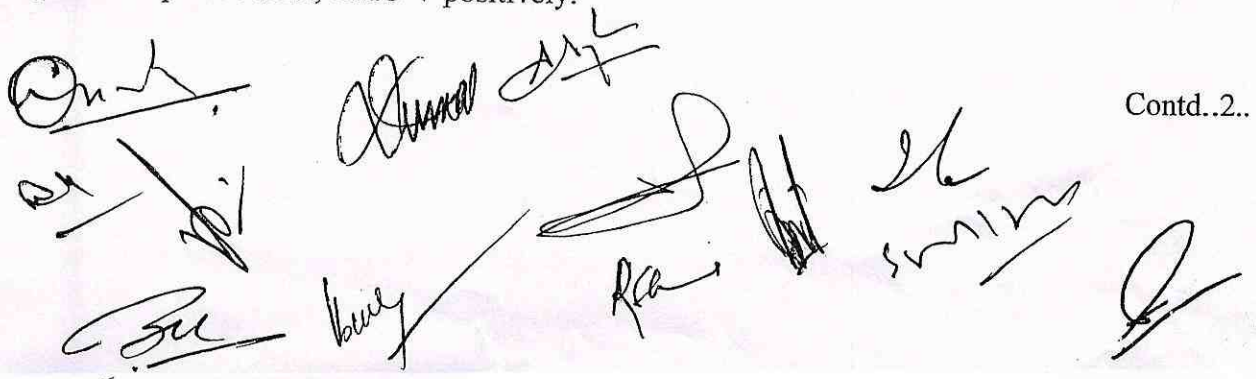
**Agenda Item No 1: All pending cases of Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate / Renewal**

During the meeting on 13.12.2018, it was apprised to Chairman of the Committee that a large number of consent applications are pending in the online software since long time. The matter was discussed in detail with all the engineers of CMCs and thereafter it was decided that CMC-V shall provide a list to all the CMCs and all CMCs shall prepare an agenda along with its recommendations/decisions of these cases and submit hardcopies of these cases to the Committee within 07 days for appropriate decisions. After perusal of the lists of 828 cases (from 01.01.2014 to 31.12.2017) and 1238 cases (from 01.01.2018 to 02.11.2018) given by all CMCs, a brief CMC wise status is placed opposite as **Annexure-C**. The meeting of the committee was held on 27.12.2018 and the Chairman of the committee has perused all these cases individually and it was decided that due to large number of consent applications, committee approved the recommendations / decisions given by the CMCs and all CMC incharges shall upload decisions in individual cases administratively using their user rights.

It was also observed that there are 283 cases are not listed in the said agenda. During discussion it was informed by concerned CMCs that they have disposed some earlier decided cases. It was decided to put up these cases (including all the left cases, if any) administratively on priority for necessary order / decision.

All CMCs are directed to issue digitally signed consent order to all units wherein decision of grant of CTE/CTO/CTO(R), has been taken within 30 days from the date of issue of the these minutes and submit compliance report to SEE, CMC-V positively.

During the meeting, various issues were also discussed and after discussion following general decisions were taken:-

- (i) It was apprised to the Committee that a decision, taken by the Committee headed by the Chairman, DPCC for II(a) category cases, w.r.t. activity of Dyeing or washing of jeans / garments or Metal Surface Treatment viz. Electroplating, Phosphating, Anodizing etc. w.r.t. water consumption, pollution potential and treatment plants installed by these small scale units. The said decisions is as under :-

*The activity of Dyeing or washing of jeans / garments or Metal Surface Treatment viz. Electroplating, Phosphating, Anodizing etc. w.r.t. water consumption, pollution potential and treatment plants installed by these small scale units were discussed in the meeting. Considering the huge water consumption and pollution potential, the Committee decided to conduct an environmental study to know the pollution potential and its treatment facilities, impact on environment and remedial measures. The study shall be conducted by third party and the co-ordination shall be done by RDPC Cell of Delhi Pollution Control Committee. The Committee further decided that consent to establish /operate/renewal shall be kept in abeyance for the units engaged in Dyeing or washing of jeans / garments or Metal Surface Treatment viz. Electroplating, Phosphating, Anodizing etc. till outcome of the environmental study.*

In this regard, no compliance report ~~submitted~~ submitted by the RDPC Cell till now. RDPC Cell be directed to take necessary action within 10 days so that these type of cases shall be considered.

- (ii) During the meeting, a decisions of the meeting taken by Hon'ble Chief Minister dated 14.12.2018 w.r.t. units operating in 22 industrial clusters notified for redevelopment areas was discussed in detail and it was decided that SEE, CMC-IV to make a policy on the issues pertaining to DPCC in consultation with SEE, CMC-II for implementation of the decisions as mentioned in the said minutes.
- (iii) It was observed that most of the cases where units are operating and applied for Consent to Establish only and not applied for Consent to Operate, Committee decided to issue show cause notice u/s 33(A) of Water Act and u/s 31(A) of Air Act and u/s 5 of EP Act (if unit is generating hazardous waste) for operating without consent to operate to all such units giving 30 days' time for compliance failing which closure directions should be issued.
- (iv) Units engaged in the activity of Mfg. of Plastic / PVC Products, consent be granted with the condition that unit shall not burn iron sieve / screen (jaali).
- (v) Consent be granted with the condition that unit shall be disposed-of its industrial waste as per SWM Rules, 2016.

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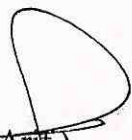
- (vi) It was also observed that where units have applied for PNG as a fuel to IGL, units be allowed time by 31.03.2019 for installation of PNG supply and consent be granted with the condition that unit shall install PNG supply on or before 31.03.2019 and submit a compliance report in this regard to DPCC.

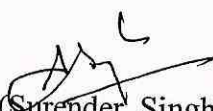
