Minutes of the 19<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases (activities / process other than those falling under clause II(a) as per Office Order Dated 31.05.2017) headed by Member Secretary DPCC, for deciding the Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 / Registration under the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, held on 01.02.2019, 06.02.2019, 07.02.2019 in the Conference Room of Chairman, DPCC at Delhi Secretariat, New Delhi-110002 and on 11.02.2019 in the Conference room of DPCC at 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, ISBT Building, Kashmere Gate, Delhi-110006.

As per Office Order Dated 31.05.2017, Consent under the Air & Water Acts and Authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 / Registration under the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 of the cases falling under Category II(b) [activities / process other than those falling under clause II(a) of the said order] are to be decided by the Committee headed by Member Secretary, DPCC and consisting of all SEEs & EEs of the concerned Cell.

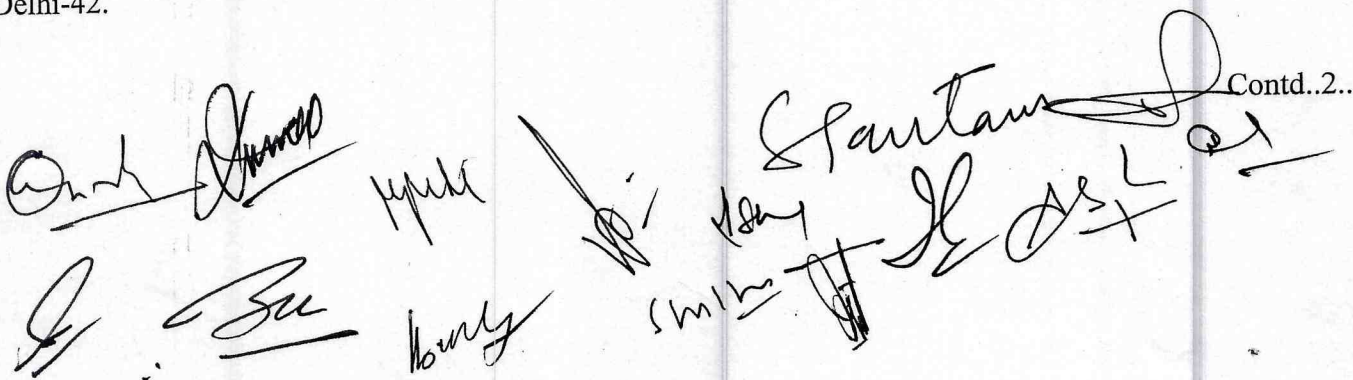
**Agenda Item No 1: All pending cases of Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate / Renewal from 02.11.2018 to 31.01.2019**

M/s Mangla Metal Pvt. Ltd., 49/14, Gali No 15, Samaipur Redevelopment Area, Delhi-42 (Consent to Operate Dated 21-02-2014 for the activity of Mfg. of Plastic Containers without Printing)

The case of the unit is subjudice before Hon'ble High Court in WP (C) No. 10373/2018. Hon'ble Court directed DDA / Govt. of NCT of Delhi to issue map clearly demarcating the area which has been notified as an industrial area.

Unit has submitted a copy of boundary map of samaipur redevelopment area issued by DDA wherein unit has marked its location within boundary of redevelopment area and also submitted an undertaking stating that its unit is located within boundary of redevelopment area. In view of this, consent to operate is granted to the unit M/s Mangla Metal Pvt. Ltd., 49/14, Gali No 15, Samaipur Redevelopment Area, Delhi-42.

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It was the first meeting taken in the new online software developed by NIC. During the meeting, it was observed that new online software developed by NIC is lacking in respect of many fields and thus many difficulties are arisen in deciding the cases and the same were apprised to the representative of NIC during meeting and asked to rectify on urgent basis. Most of the cases were considered by the Committee and in spite of this, a large number of consent applications has not been considered by the Committee due to software problem. In left over cases, Chairman of the Committee has decided the following decisions:-

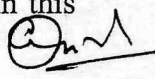
- (i) To grant consent to all the units who have submitted all the requisite documents including consent fee, inspection etc.
- (ii) Issue Show Cause Notice for refusal of consent for non-submission of requisite documents including consent fee, if unit submits the same and found satisfactory, consent be granted. If unit does not submit the same within 30 days, consent be refused.

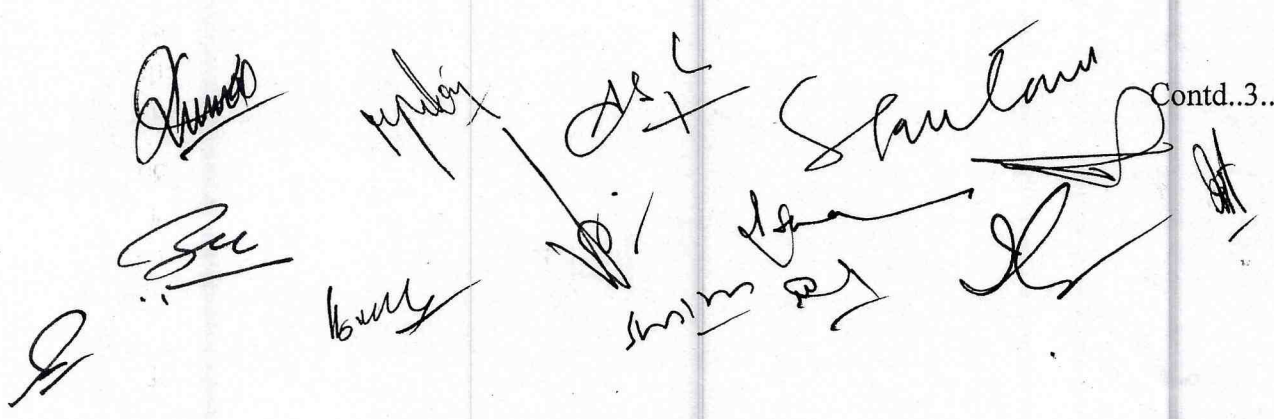
All the cases, which have been considered by the Committee, have been forwarded to the concerned Incharge / Sr. Environmental Engineer for implementation of the decision of the committee. Some of the cases could not be forwarded due to software problem, SEE (IT) is hereby directed to rectify the error and forward such cases to concerned SEE for further necessary action. SEE (IT) is also hereby directed to make a provision to get the minutes of the meeting in pdf form so that same may be uploaded in the DPCC website for view in public domain.

All CMCs are directed to issue digitally signed consent order to all units wherein decision of grant of CTE/CTO/CTO(R), has been taken within 30 days from the date of issue of the these minutes and submit compliance report to MS, DPCC through SEE, CMC-V positively.

During the meeting, various issues were also discussed and after discussion following general decisions were taken:-

- (i) The order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) dated 16.01.2019 in O.A. No, 606/2018 regarding Polluters Pay Principle discussed in detail and it was decided that environmental damages be imposed on the defaulters units causing air, water and hazardous pollution and operating without valid consent. Accordingly, Incharge, CMC-II shall <sup>CMC-II</sup> prepare a policy in this regard within 07 days and submit the same to the Chairman of the Committee.





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- (ii) It was apprised to the Committee that recently, DPCC has uploaded the maps of redevelopment areas in the DPCC website. After visiting the website, it was observed that the uploaded maps are not having clearly boundary of the said area. Chairman of the Committee decided that maps of redevelopment areas are uploaded afresh clearly mentioning the boundary of the area mentioning that "the map has been given by Industry Department" and the same will be self-attested with stamp by the concerned EE so that unit can be able to locate its boundary. All SEEs will provide the fresh maps to SEE (IT) for uploading the same to the DPCC website.
- (iii) It was apprised to the Committee that there is an ambiguity whether unit shall submit hardcopy of its consent applications along with requisite documents to DPCC as asked earlier. During the meeting, it was decided that if unit submits its application by e-sign mode then no hardcopy is required however unit submits its application without e-sign mode then unit is required to send its hardcopy of consent application along with requisite documents by post to DPCC within 15 days as per earlier practice. SEE, IT is hereby directed to take necessary action in this regard as asked earlier in the old online software.
- (iv) It was apprised to the Committee that a decision, taken by the Committee headed by the Chairman, DPCC for II(a) category cases, w.r.t. activity of Dyeing or washing of jeans / garments or Metal Surface Treatment viz. Electroplating, Phosphating, Anodizing etc. w.r.t. water consumption, pollution potential and treatment plants installed by these small scale units. The said decisions is as under :-

*The activity of Dyeing or washing of jeans / garments or Metal Surface Treatment viz. Electroplating, Phosphating, Anodizing etc. w.r.t. water consumption, pollution potential and treatment plants installed by these small scale units were discussed in the meeting. Considering the huge water consumption and pollution potential, the Committee decided to conduct an environmental study to know the pollution potential and its treatment facilities, impact on environment and remedial measures. The study shall be conducted by third party and the co-ordination shall be done by RDPC Cell of Delhi Pollution Control Committee. The Committee further decided that consent to establish /operate/renewal shall be kept in abeyance for the units engaged in Dyeing or washing of jeans / garments or Metal Surface Treatment viz. Electroplating, Phosphating, Anodizing etc. till outcome of the environmental study.*

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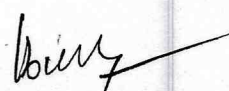

In this regard, compliance report was sought from RDPC Cell vide earlier decision of the committee for II(b) category cases. However, compliance report is still awaited from RDPC Cell till date. RDPC Cell is directed to take necessary action within 07 days. In the meantime, it is decided to grant consent with the condition that unit shall bound to comply with the outcome of the environmental study.

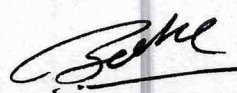
The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

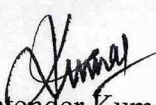
