Minutes of the 21st Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases

held on 15.06.2019, 17.06.2019 to 20.06.2019

Attendance Sheet for meeting on 15.06.2019, 17.06.2019 to 20.06.2019 are enclosed as Annexure "A", 'B', 'C', 'D' & 'E'.

Following are the Minutes of the Meetings:-

Agenda Item No 1: All cases of Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate / Renewal from 01.02.2019 onwards.

During the meeting, cases of Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate / Renewal from 01.02.2019 to 31.03.2019, were decided online. Due to paucity of time, it was decided to take up the remaining cases in the next CMC meeting.

During the meeting, it was observed that there was no provision in the new online software developed by NIC to take print out the agenda and minutes of the meeting. IT Cell was directed to make a provision to obtain print out the agenda and minutes of the committee. It was also observed that that new online software developed by NIC is lacking in respect of many fields and thus many difficulties are being faced by CMC officials in deciding the cases and the same were apprised to the representative of NIC during meeting and asked to rectify on urgent basis. IT Cell to take up the matter on priority.

During the meeting, various issues were also discussed and after discussions, the following are the record of discussion:-

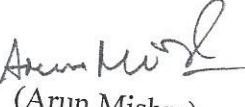
- (i) It was observed by the committee that in many cases, existing / operating units have applied only for consent to establish. Hence, it was decided that show cause notice u/s 33(A) of Water Act and u/s 31(A) of Air Act may be issued to these units for operating without consent to operate.
- (ii) It was observed that in many cases of consent to operate, the status of consent to establish was not reflected. Hence, it was decided in such cases, consent to operate and consent to establish will be granted at the same time.
- (iii) It was noticed that cases of hazardous waste generating units wherein inspection is to be conducted before placing the case in the committee is not being done resulting in the delay in decisions. Hence, all CMCs were ~~are~~ directed to inspect all such units before placing these cases in front of the committee.

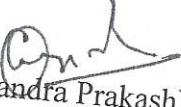
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- (iv) It was observed that in most of the cases, checklist was not prepared properly and concerned cell did not provide its recommendations. Hence, it was directed by chairman of the committee that the concerned cell will prepare checklist and give proper recommendations.
- (v) It was also observed that lot of modifications / updations are required in the online software as during meeting it was noticed that all the documents attached with the applications were not visible. Due to which it was difficult to decide the applications for consent to establish and consent to operate. Therefore, committee decided that if there is any deficiency in the consent application(s), concerned cell will raise a clarification online immediately giving 15 days time for rectification of deficiencies so that the complete application may be placed before the committee for appropriate decision.
- (vi) All CMCs were directed to check each and every documents including required consent fee before issuing the consent to establish and consent to operate.
- (vii) All CMCs were directed to comply with the decisions of the committee within 07 days from the date of issue of these minutes and submit a compliance report to MS, DPCC through Incharge, CMC-V positively.

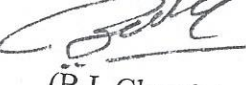
The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
