Following General Decisions were taken by the Committee :

(i) Presently, Restaurants/Eating Houses/Dhabas and other such establishments (with minimum seating capacity of 36) are required to install Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) including proper Oil and Grease Trap and submit Adequacy Report for the Effluent Treatment Plant from any of the Empanelled Consultants of DPCC and Effluent Analysis Report from any of the Empanelled Laboratories of DPCC. However, considering delay in obtaining the Adequacy Report for their installed ETPs from Empanelled Consultants, the Committee decided to exempt Restaurants/Eating Houses/Dhabas and other such establishments having seating capacity less than 100 seats from submission of Adequacy Report for their ETPs along with Consent to Operate / Renewal applications. However, such units shall be required to submit the details of ETP including capacity of ETP, size / dimensions of the constituent units, type and mode of treatment, chemical dosing system including quantities of chemicals used (if any), quantity of sludge generation and its disposal, flow meters details, copy of logbook of for operation & maintenance of ETP, details of persons responsible for operation of ETP along with supporting photographs and also submit Effluent Analysis Report of ETP from any of the Empanelled Laboratories of DPCC. Enquiry Counter/IT Cell of DPCC may take necessary action in this regard w.e.f the date of issue of these minutes. 5 to 10 % of such cases shall be inspected based on random selection of the cases by the Member Secretary, DPCC.

(ii) In view of the judgment of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal dated 13.01.2015 in O.A. No. 6 of 2012 and 300 of 2013 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs. UOI & Ors and various directions of National Green Tribunal in O.A. No. 196 of 2014 in the matter of Krishna Kant Singh and Anr Vs National Ganga River Basin Authority & Ors on the matter of 'Prevention & Control of Pollution of River Ganga and its Tributaries and 33 Sectors of Seriously Polluting Industries (SPI) identified by Principal Committee constituted by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal and operating in Industrial Areas / Redevelopment Areas which are not having Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs), the Committee decided that a separate note shall be put up by the SEE (WMC II) in consultation with Director (Env) & Legal Cell of DPCC.

(iii) All such units of this meeting which are extracting / drawing ground water through Borewells however have not submitted the details / permission for extracting / drawing ground water shall be asked to submit details of use/ extraction / drawl of ground water through Borewell(s), if any, and submit copy of permission from Delhi Jal Board / NDMC / Central Ground Water Authority, in this regard within 15 days, failing which Consent shall be refused/revoked and concerned Dy. Commissioner shall be asked to take necessary action w.r.t Notification dated 12.07.2010 for ground water. Such units can be asked to use treated water from existing CETPs and STPs in view of the orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal.

(iv) Concerned CMCs/EIA Cell to prepare list of all the pending inspections and put up along with timeframe to complete the inspection.

(v) Wherever inspection has been decided, the same shall be conducted by the concerned Cell and file be put up administratively for further necessary action within 15 days.

(vi) For monitoring the follow up action w.r.t. Show Cause Notices / Directions for Closure etc. issued, IT Cell of DPCC to take necessary action for development of required software.

(vii) If there is any case left out of the aforementioned period, the same shall be put up administratively for further necessary action.

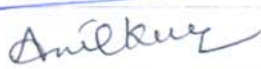
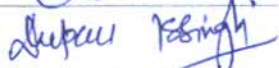
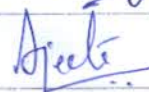
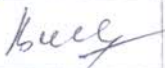
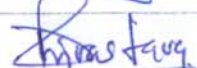
