Case No. 3

Project Name : Construction of Commercial Complex Project at Plot No. 29 and 31, CBD Shahdara, Delhi

Project Proponent : M/s. Aggarwal Plaza Pvt. Ltd.

Project Name : Construction of 108 MW Combined Cycle Power Plant
at Sector-11, Rohini.

Project Proponent : M/s. North Delhi Power Ltd. (NDPL)

All the documents submitted the project proponent was also reviewed. - i) Norms as far as distance/density criteria of population from the power plant.
- ii) Details of human population residing in and around the power plant.
- iii) Whether SEAC is satisfied with the replies or not.
- iv) Details of Disaster Management Plan.
