A High Level Committee (HLC) has been constituted under the chairmanship of Chairman, DPCC to oversee the process of filling of DPCC's vacancies in a time bound manner vide office order dated 16.05.2025.

Vide the said order dated 16.05.2025; the said Committee is entasked to meet on fortnightly basis to continuously monitor the progress of filling of vacancies in the DPCC and to take effective steps for the said purpose. The said exercise is envisaged to be conducted with due coordination with Chief Secretary, GNCTD.

Minutes of the Meeting dated 29.05.2025

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, GNCTD to discuss the filling up of vacant posts in Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) on 29.05.2025 at 4.30 PM in Conference Room of Chief Secretary, GNCTD, Delhi Secretariat, New Delhi-110002.

At the outset, Member Secretary, DPCC welcomed all the members and briefed about orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 19.05.2025 in W.P. (C) No. 13029/1985 titled as M.C. Mehta Vs. Union of India & Ors. vide which GNCTD was directed for fill up vacancies of DPCC by the end of September, 2025. He also briefed about the present status of vacant posts in DPCC.

After detailed discussion, following decisions were taken:-

(A) Posts to be filled up by Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board (DSSSB):- 48 Posts

- (i) **Jr. Environmental Engineer (JEE) (41 Posts):** In this context, Controller of Exam (CoE), DSSSB informed that the exam (Tier-I) for the said post has been scheduled for 06.06.2025 & 08.06.2025 and thereafter Tier-II exam will be conducted. The entire process will be completed by 31st December, 2025 as per standard procedure laid down.

Member Secretary, DPCC informed that DPCC has recently filled up the Vacant Posts of Assistant Environmental Engineer (Group-A) using the list of "Non-Recommended Candidates of UPSC Engineering Service Examination (ESE), 2022" under public disclosure as per DoPT and remaining posts of Assistant Environmental Engineer (Group-A) are also being filled up using the list of "Non-Recommended Candidates of UPSC Engineering Service Examination (ESE), 2023".

To comply with the timeline given by Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 19.05.2025, it was decided to fill up Junior Environmental Engineers (41 Posts) using the list of "Non-Recommended Willing Candidates of Junior Engineer (Civil, Mechanical & Electrical) Examination 2024 conducted by Staff Selection Commission, Govt. of India.

The members were apprised about the educational and other qualifications required for direct recruitment as per Recruitment Rules for the post of Junior Environmental Engineer in DPCC as mentioned below:-

Degree in Engineering in related field from a recognized University or Institution
OR (i) 3 years Diploma in Engineering* in a related field from a recognized Board/
University or Institution; (ii) 3 years' experience in pollution control
activity/sewerage works.*

**The particular discipline(s) of engineering in which a Degree/Diploma is required
will be decided each time a vacancy is filled, depending on the actual requirements
with the approval of Chairman.*

It was apprised that requisitions were already sent to DSSSB to consider the educational qualification i.e. Civil / Environment Engineering whereas the list of Non Recommended Willing Candidates under public disclosure has the stream of Civil, Mechanical & Electrical. The educational qualifications considered by SSC are varying including Degree in respective field, three years Diploma and three year diploma with two years' experience.

Further, it was decided to consider Civil Engineering stream in the list of "Non-Recommended Willing Candidates of Junior Engineer Exam., 2024 and in case of Diploma in Civil Engineering, 03 years of working experience in Planning /Execution/Maintenance of Civil Engineer works will be considered. Following steps are to be taken up for filling up of these 41 posts of Junior Environmental Engineer:-

- Offer of appointment letter will be issued through email/whatsapp to candidates in Civil Engineering stream as per merit list (considering reservation of posts) of "Non-Recommended Willing Candidates of Junior Engineer Exam., 2024 issued by SSC giving 07 days' time for submitting their acceptance along with requisite documents. In case, no acceptance is received within stipulated time or no suitable candidate is found matching eligibly criteria for the post, next candidates will be considered till filling up of all the posts.

- After receiving acceptance, medical examination will be conducted by GNCTD approved hospital.
- Appointment letter will be issued to suitable candidate giving 15 days for joining after getting medical examination report.
- No extension will be granted to the candidate at any stage.

One time relaxation may be sought from Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, GNCTD for above procedure.

- (ii) **Senior Laboratory Assistant (03 Posts):** In this context, Controller of Exam (CoE), DSSSB informed that the entire process will be completed by 31st March, 2026 as per standard procedure laid down.

It was decided to fill up these posts through Education Department, GNCTD on diverted capacity. If not available, these posts will be filled up through Deputation (including Short Term Contract) for Govt. Officials or Short Term Contract for retired persons from Govt. Organizations having age upto 62 till joining of the candidates from DSSSB instead of method of recruitment prescribed in their respective RRs by issuing separate public advertisement.

- (iii) **Legal Assistant (04 Posts):-** In this context, Controller of Exam (CoE), DSSSB informed that the entire process will be completed by 31st March, 2026 as per standard procedure laid down.

It was decided to fill up these posts through Law Department, GNCTD on diverted capacity. If not available, these posts will be filled up through Deputation (including Short Term Contract) for Govt. Officials or Short Term Contract for retired persons from Govt. Organizations having age upto 62 till joining of the candidates from DSSSB instead of method of recruitment prescribed in their respective RRs by issuing separate public advertisement.

(B) Posts to be filled by DPCC (46 Posts):-

- (i) **Assistant Environmental Engineer (09 Posts):** These posts have not been filled up through "Non-Recommended Candidates from Engineering Service Examination (ESE), 2023 conducted by UPSC due to non-availability of Delhi OBC candidate.
- (ii) **Deputation Posts (19 Posts):** Despite of advertisements floated in nationalized newspapers five times, no suitable candidates were found.



- (iii) **Vacancies which arose in May, 2025 (18 Posts):** These vacancies arose recently in May, 2025.

These above posts have different types of method of recruitment in their respective Recruitment Rules (RRs). It was decided to fill up these posts through Deputation (including Short Term Contract) for Govt. Officials or Short Term Contract for retired persons from Govt. Organizations having age upto 62 (till joining of regular employees) instead of method of recruitment prescribed in their respective RRs by issuing separate public advertisement.

One time relaxation may be sought from Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, GNCTD for above procedure.
