



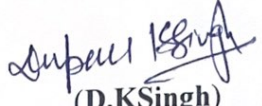

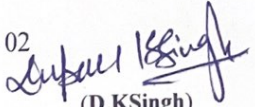

**Review Meeting of the Chief Secretary, Convener of High Level Committee (HLC) constituted by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal vide order dated 09.01.2023 in OA.No. 21/2023 in the matter of "Ashwani Yadav Vs. Govt. of NCT of Delhi" held in the Chief Secretary's Conference Room, Delhi Secretariat on 10.03.2023 at 02: 00 PM.**

The list of participants is Annexed.

The meeting was attended by the Secretaries / HODs of various Departments of GNCTD including Divisional Commissioner(Revenue Department), Chairman,DPCC,GNCTD,Pr.Secy.(Env), Development Commissioner, GNCTD, Addl. Chief Secretary (Industries), Commissioner, MCD, CEO, DJB along with Member (Drainage), MD (DSIIDC), Spl. Secy. cum Member Secretary, DPCC and other senior officers from various Departments including DDA.

Member Secretary, DPCC appraised the update on action plans due by February and March, 2023 and progress made since the second meeting of High Level Committee on 14.02.2023 by concerned departments.

The progress made was discussed and following decisions were taken :

**1. Construction of 40 New DSTPs: 11 DSTPs - 12 Months after allocation of Land/ Land to be finalized in a fortnight by DDA / Revenue (Order Para No. 3.1.2):**

Chief Secretary informed that land allocation issues were discussed in another meeting held on 10.03.2023 wherein following decisions have been taken :

- (i) DDA to allot land in all pending cases by March, 2023.
- (ii) Revenue Department to explore Gram Sabha Land in place of private land.
- (iii) DUSIB to handover land to DJB immediately and payment issue will be resolved as per approval of DUSIB subsequently.
- (iv) Police Land matter will be taken up with Commissioner Police during coming meeting on Monday.

**2. DJB shall construct 10 MGD STP to trap the remaining flow in the Delhi Gate Drain within 12 months and matter of allotment of land shall be resolved by all concerned by 31.01.2023 (Order Para No. 3.2.1**

DO letter to MoHUA be sent for allocation of land expeditiously (Action : DPCC)

**3. Physical Inspection of non-recorded Sub Drains of 18 Major Drains by Drain owning agencies: PWD, MCD, DDA, IFCD, DSIIDC etc. (Order Para No. 3.2.2 (iv)):**

It was informed that inspection has been completed by I&FCD and 138 unrecorded outlets (Private Pipes) found discharging into Najafgarh drain (63 Nos), Supplementary drain (71 Nos) & Shahdara drain (63 Nos). Chief Secretary directed that a joint inspection by I&FCD and DJB to be carried out in the next one week and submit drain-wise feasible solutions in regard to actions to be taken. A template may also be prepared and Revenue Department may be asked to inspect and submit the report with photographs in a week.

(Action :DJB and I&FCD)

**4. Performance Audit of completely trapped 11 major drains and all sub-drains :**

4. a DJB to undertake the Performance Audit of completely trapped 11 major drains and all sub-drains through an independent agency: (Order Para No. 3.2.3):

DJB informed that cost of audit is more than 50 lakhs therefore case has been sent to Chairman, DJB for approval. Chief Secretary directed to empower organizations involved in Yamuna Action Plan through enhanced financial powers at various levels for smooth flow of work.

(Action : DJB)

4.b. A multidisciplinary team of DJB, MCD, I & FCD to undertake internal audit (Order Para No.3.2.3) :  
The proposal of multi-disciplinary teams may be dropped and audit shall be done by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party already been engaged for performance audit.

**5. Septage Management Regulations 2018: A Committee under chairmanship of Div. Comm, Rev. Dept and consisting of CEO, DJB, Comm. MCD as member and Secy. UD as member cum-convenor, to revisit the Delhi Water Board Septage Management Regulations 2018 to make them more effective & enforceable.”: (Order Para No. 3.5):**

The Committee has finalized the report, which needs to be taken forward by Secretary, (UD).

(Action: Secretary,UD)

Divisional Commissioner suggested that powers of imposing Environmental Compensation in view of NGT matters may be delegated to DJB by DPCC. DPCC may also utilize power of imposing Environmental Compensation on defaulters.

**6. Resolution of Land Issues:**

DDA informed that progress has been updated on e-Samiksha. Only 8-9 land related issues remains unresolved whose coordinates may be analyzed by DPCC with the help of GSDL.

(Action: DPCC)

**7. Company of Territorial Army to be provided by NMCG : (Order Para No 4.3):**

One platoon is stationed in Delhi. Accommodation for remaining platoons is yet to be allocated. Pagoda tents of DUSIB may be explored by I&FCD for Territorial Army.

(Action : I&FCD)

**8. Development of Bio-diversity Park by NMCG: “DDA to identify and allot a piece of land at River Yamuna Flood Plains to NMCG for development of a bio-diversity park by NMCG.”(Order Para No. 4.4):**

DDA informed that NMCG is requesting for Ghat instead of Biodiversity Park, which is available on Asita East. DDA shall communicate the same clearly to NMCG.

(Action :DDA)

Regarding Action Points with timeline of March, 2023, DJB informed that all works are in progress and will be completed within the timelines.

Regarding development of web page by DPCC for Rejuvenation of River Yamuna, Chief Secretary desired to modify the design to make it more appealing.

(Action : DPCC)

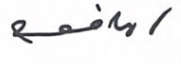
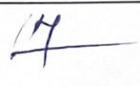
The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
