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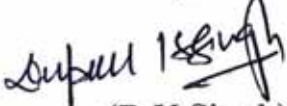

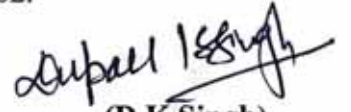

Minutes of Third Review Meeting of Chief Secretary, GNCTD to Review the Progress w.r.t Action Plans for Rejuvenation of River Yamuna and Solid Waste Management in Delhi w.r.t NGT Cases OA. No. 21/2023 & OA. No. 606/2018 held on 16.06.2023 at 03:00 PM in the Conference Room at 5th Floor, Delhi Secretariat.

The list of participants is at Annexure – “A”

Spl. Secretary (Env.) cum Member Secretary, DPCC, made a detailed presentation on following Agenda Points related to Rejuvenation of River Yamuna and after detailed discussions following decisions were taken:

1. Location of 40 DSTPs - Feasibility of merging of DSTPs

Map showing location of 40 DSTPs of DJB in Delhi was shown. Representative of DJB informed that out of 40 DSTPs, land has been allotted in respect of 34 DSTPs. In rest of 06 DSTPs land is yet to be allotted by DDA [Rangpuri, Chattarpur Extension & Maidan Garhi (Rajpur Khurd)] and Revenue Department [Nayabans, Tajpur Khurd & Tikri Kalan].

Chief Secretary enquired about the possibility of merging of DSTPs to minimise the requirement of land and delay in construction of DSTPs. Representative of DJB informed that DSTPs at Chattarpur Extension and Maidan Garhi (Rajpur Khurd) can be merged. DDA agreed to provide the land for same. It was informed that DSTPs at Nayabans and Rangpuri are quite far from each other in different districts and therefore, merging of these DSTPs is not feasible. It was also informed that for DSTP at Nayabans 13,000 Sq.mt land is required however only 1900 Sq.mt land has been provided by Revenue Department therefore merging of DSTPs at Nayabans & Khera Khurd is not feasible.

Regarding land to be provided by Revenue Department for DSTPs at Tajpur Khurd & Tikri Kalan, DM (South West) informed that two locations are far away in different districts and therefore merging the two DSTPs is not feasible. High Court cases are pending in these two DSTPs and next date of hearing is 14.07.2023. Engineer in Chief, PWD informed that PWD is having vacant land of about 27,000 Sq.mt at Tikri Kalan which can be taken by DJB for construction of DSTPs.

Chief Secretary directed Revenue Department to find alternate land for DSTPs proposed at Tajpur Khurd, Tikri Kalan & Nayabans and DDA to expedite allotment of land for DSTP at Rangpuri. DJB to pursue PWD for taking over land at Tikri Kalan and submit report within a week.

(Action: DDA, Revenue Deptt., DJB & PWD)

2. Land Issues Related to SPS

It was informed there are land issues in respect of 05 SPS out of which 04 pertain to DDA and one pertains to Revenue Department. Out of 04 SPS for which land is to be allotted by DDA, in case of two SPS (1st one Adjoining to Maharishi Valmiki Hospital, Pooth Khurd Village / Sultanpur Dabas village and 2nd one at Vijay Colony near Bawana Chowk / behind Rajiv Gandhi Stadium Bawana village) alternative land is to be allotted by DDA to DJB.

In two cases (Salahpur Khera and Shahbad Mohammadpur) development of water bodies along with construction of DSTP is to be taken up by DJB however, water bodies are yet to be handed over by DDA to DJB. In rest of one case of SPS at Milan Garden Lift Station, land is yet to be acquired by Revenue Department.

Chief Secretary directed DDA, Revenue Department & DJB to expedite the matter regarding allotment / handing over of land to DJB.

(Action: DDA, Revenue Deptt. & DJB)

3. Funding for Okhla STPs (124 MGD) :

Representative of DJB informed that there is issue of release of funds of about Rs. 300 Crores [due to difference in cost estimated in 2017 (about Rs. 665 Crores) and awarded in 2019 (about Rs. 998 Crores)] from NMCG for Okhla STP which may delay the project. Representative of NMCG has informed in the meeting of High Level Committee on 09.06.2023 that said amount asked by DJB was in excess of the sanctioned amount by NMCG for the Okhla STP for which prior approval was required however not taken by DJB. It was further informed that the matter has been taken up and under process.

Chief Secretary directed DJB to fix a meeting with NMCG / Ministry of Jal Shakti to resolve the issue of release of funds for Okhla STP.

(Action: DJB)

4. Interconnection of Storm Water Drains into Sewers :

Representative of MCD informed that out of 539 points of faulty interconnection from storm water drains to DJB Sewers reported by DJB, 308 drains have been marked to MCD. Out of 308 Drains, 164 Drains have been disconnected and 33 Drains are to be disconnected by MCD. Action Plan has been prepared by MCD for 12 Drains. 51 Drains pertain to PWD/ IFCD/ DSIIDC. 04 Drains are not traceable. In case of 44 Drains disconnection not feasible and in rest of 12 Drains survey is being done by MCD. Representative of PWD informed that out of 12 Drains marked to PWD only 04 Drains to pertain to them and they will take necessary action for plugging their drains.

Chief Secretary directed Drain Owning Agencies (MCD, PWD, DSIIDC & IFCD) to prepare list of their storm water drains which are still connected with the Sewerage System of DJB in consultation with DJB and take urgent necessary action for disconnection / plugging of such drains.

(Action: MCD, PWD, DSIIDC, IF&CD & DJB)

5. Sewerage Network in 161 Unauthorized Colonies in which case NOC is awaited from Forest Department/ O-Zone in Unauthorized colonies(1799)

It was informed that out of 161 unauthorized colonies, 114 are on forest land, 05 on ASI land, 04 on O-Zone, 26 are not traceable, 12 cases sewerage network is not feasible. Pr. Secretary (Env.) informed that alignment of 114 unauthorised colonies is yet to be provided by DJB after survey of these colonies. In the meeting of High Level Committee held on 09.06.2023 it was decided that DDA will check from the Delhi Master Plan regarding permissibility of 04 unauthorised colonies falling under O-Zone and DJB & Forest Department to resolve the matter at the earliest.

Chief Secretary directed that DJB will prepare the list of 114 unauthorized colonies after survey & locate the same on map after superimposing type of forest in which these unauthorised colonies fall and provide list to Forest Department, GNCTD for getting NOC. Forest Department will explore the possibility of de-reservation of forest land for issuing NOC to DJB. Sh. Vikram Singh, Chief Engineer, DJB will be the nodal officer for the said work.

(Action: DJB & Forest Deptt.)

6. Handing over of 11 CETPs (DJB or DSIIDC)

It was informed that a meeting was taken by the Chief Secretary wherein it was decided that CETPs will be taken over by the Industries Department and will be handed over to DSIIDC for their management however formal approval to handover the CETPs to DSIIDC is awaited. It was also informed that recently a meeting has also been taken by the Hon'ble Minister of Industries, Govt. of NCT of Delhi wherein it has been decided that CETPs will be handed over to DJB for their up-gradation and Operation & Maintenance.

Chief Secretary directed DJB & Industries Department to pursue and process the matter for decision on the above mentioned issue.

(Action: DJB & Industries Department)

Amendments in the Notification of Delhi Water Board Septage Management Regulations, 2018.

As per the order dated 27.01.2023 of Chief Secretary, a committee under chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner, Revenue Department and consisting of CEO (DJB), Commissioner (MCD) and Secretary (UD) as member cum convenor was constituted to revisit the Delhi Water Board Septage Management Regulations, 2018 to make them more effective & enforceable.

It was informed that report of the committee of the meeting held on 28.02.2023 along with proposed amendments in the existing "Delhi Water Board Septage Management Regulation 2018", was placed in the Board meeting of DJB held on 04.05.2023 and was approved by the Board. However minutes of said Board meeting is awaited. After issuance of the minutes the matter will be taken up by DJB with the UD Department for necessary amendments in the said Notification.

Chief Secretary directed DJB and UD Department, GNCTD to expedite the matter regarding Amendments in the Notification of "Delhi Water Board Septage Management Regulations, 2018."

(Action: DJB & UD Department, GNCTD)

8. JJ Clusters where connection with sewerage system of DJB is not feasible (65 JJ Clusters)

Representative of DJB informed that earlier connection of JJ Clusters with the sewerage system of DJB was not feasible in case of 65 JJ Clusters however following is the present status in these cases :

• JJ Clusters Connected / Trapped in DJB Network	- 07
• DPR prepared and sent to NMCG for installation of DSTP	- 21
• Sewer line work is in progress in the vicinity in which drains coming from JJ Clusters are proposed to be trapped	- 22
• Not feasible due to space constraints and multiple outfalls etc.	- 06
• Trapped in STP through major storm water drain/trapping work are in progress	- 08
• Site does not exist	- 01
Total	- 65

Chief Secretary directed DJB to provide list of 14 JJ Clusters (06 + 08 mentioned above) along with population and estimated sewerage generation in which cases connection with the sewerage system of DJB is not feasible and explore some technical solution for treating the sewerage generated from these colonies.

(Action: DJB)

9. Environmental Management of Najafgarh Jheel

It was informed that remedial action for rejuvenation of Najafgarh Jheel (Lake) on Delhi-Gurgaon border is required. The water body falls partly in NCT Delhi and partly in Haryana. Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 17.09.2020 EA No. 16/2019 in OA No. 153/2014 directed both Govt. of Delhi and Haryana to submit Environment Management Plan (EMP). Environmental Management Plan has been prepared and submitted to CPCB however it is yet to be notified.

Chief Secretary observed that required area proposed in the Environmental Management Plan is quite large and difficult to acquire such large area.

Chief Secretary suggested that a Committee under the Chairmanship of Pr. Secretary (Env. & Forest) may be constituted to find out realistic solutions for implementation of Environmental Management of Najafgarh Jheel and matter to be discussed in the next meeting of High Level Committee.

(Action: DM (South West) / Revenue Department)

10. Solid Waste Management in Delhi

Regarding the matter of Solid Waste Management in Delhi and compliances with the order of Chief Secretary dated 06.04.2023 and minutes of meeting of Solid Waste Monitoring Committee dated 25.04.2023, it was informed that complete information / action plans along with timelines etc. particularly ward wise information / Action Plan as per the said order is yet to be received from the Urban Local Bodies (MCD, NDMC& DCB) and other Departments.

Additional Commissioner, MCD informed that they have provided information and rest of the information/action plan etc. is being compiled/ prepared and same shall be submitted soon.

Chief Secretary directed ULBs and all other concerned departments to provide complete information / action plans along with timelines etc. as per the order of Chief Secretary dated 06.04.2023 and Action taken report w.r.t minutes of meeting of Solid Waste Monitoring Committee held on 25.04.2023 to DPCC within a week.

(Action: MCD, NDMC, DCB, UD Deptt., DDA, Revenue Deptt. & Other Deptts. mentioned in the order dated 06.04.2023)

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

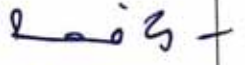
